

Notice of Amendment Under the Veterans' Support Act 2014 to 44 Statements of Principles

1. Pursuant to section 24 of the Veterans' Support Act 2014, the Minister for Veterans gives notice of the amendment of 44 Statements of Principles under the Veterans' Support Regulations 2014.
2. The amendments take effect on the date of the publication of this notice.

motor neurone disease (88/2018 to be read as compiled with 67/2013 Reasonable hypothesis version only)

SOP 87/2018 revising the definition of terms "category 1B stressor"; "eyewitness" and inserting a new definition of "corpse" is applied to and to be read as compiled with:

adjustment disorder (23/2016 & 24/2016)

alcohol use disorder (48/2017 & 49/2017)

substance use disorder (59/2017 & 60/2017)

suicide and attempted suicide (65/2016 & 66/2016)
