

## Pharmacy Council (Fees) Notice 2019

Pursuant to sections 130 to 133 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003, the following notice is given.

This notice is effective from **22 February 2019** and revokes and replaces all previous Pharmacy Council (previously listed as the Pharmacy Council of New Zealand) fees notices.

### Notice

1. **Title and commencement** —This notice may be cited as the Pharmacy Council (Fees) Notice 2019 and shall come into force on **22 February 2019**.
2. **Fees**—The Pharmacy Council sets the following fees, payable to the Council, specified in the attached Schedule.
