

Land Transfer Act 2017—Specification of How Notices May Be Given to the Registrar-General of Land

Section 222(1) of the Land Transfer Act 2017 allows the Registrar-General of Land (“Registrar”) to specify how a notice required or permitted by the Act to be given to the Registrar may be given.

I specify that a notice may be given:

- by emailing it to customersupport@linz.govt.nz; or
- by sending or delivering it from an electronic workspace facility.

This specification replaces the notice titled “Statutory Specification – Land Transfer Act 1952” specifying facsimile addresses for notices to be given under sections 145(1) and 145A(3) of the Land Transfer Act 1952 published in the [New Zealand Gazette, 21 August 2008, No. 131, page 3406](#).

This notice takes effect from **Monday 12 November 2018**.
