 - (b) to specify the other conditions in relation to the fee and course costs maxima policy, as set out in Schedule 2 below, that the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) must attach to student achievement component funding in 2008.

4. Call for submissions—Any tertiary education organisation and any other person, body or organisation having an interest in the matter is invited to make a submission on the proposed fee and course costs maxima and other proposed conditions set out in this notice.

Schedule 2

Other Proposed Conditions to be Attached to Student Achievement Component Funding Paid by the Tertiary Education Commission to Tertiary Education Organisations

General

- 1. These conditions apply to fees and course costs for all provider types: Tertiary education institutions (TEIs), private training establishments (PTEs) and other tertiary education providers (OTEPs).
- 2. Fees for all courses that are above the fee and course costs maxima in 2008 should not increase above 2007 levels, but are not required to reduce to the relevant maximum.
- 3. The fee and course costs in relation to a particular course of study or training will be subject to these conditions if:
 - (a) the tertiary education organisation is the sole source of the item to which the cost relates;
 - (b) all students enrolled in the relevant course of study or training are required to pay the fee or course costs; and
 - (c) the charge meets the guidelines for borrowing under the compulsory fees component of the student loan scheme.
- 4. The following items are included in the maxima: Tuition fees, compulsory charges, examination fees, other charges associated with a programme of study, material charges, cost of field trips and any compulsory purchase of equipment or books through the organisation.

Annual Fee Movement Limit (AFML)

- 5. Fee movements in 2008 at a course level are limited to 5% for certificate, diploma, degree-level and short award courses that receive student achievement component funding.
- 6. If the application of the annual fee movement limit (AFML) on fee and course costs allows for an increase above the relevant maxima in 2008, then the provider can only increase up to the level of the maxima.

Low or Zero Fee Courses

7. If the fee and course costs for a course are less than \$444.44 (GST excl.) per equivalent full-time student (EFTS) in 2007, then for 2008, the provider can increase the fee to up to \$444.44 (GST excl.) per EFTS, or can increase the fee for the course by 5%, whichever is the greater.

Postgraduate Qualifications and Courses

- 8. Postgraduate courses are excluded from the fee and course costs maxima.
- 9. Postgraduate fee and course costs can be increased by \$444.44 (GST excl.) per EFTS in 2008.
- 10. Professional masters programmes (eg MBAs) are exempt from the postgraduate fee increase limit, and are not subject to any limit on fee increases.

Exemptions for Exceptional Circumstances

- 11. Only TEIs may apply, on the basis of exceptional circumstances, for exemptions in 2008 from the AFML of 5%, to allow for up to an additional 5%. An AFML exemption may allow fees to increase over the relevant fee and course costs maxima. In subsequent years, these fees will be subject to the policy for fees over the maxima.
- 12. TEIs and PTEs may apply, on the basis of exceptional circumstances, for exemptions in 2008 to:
 - (a) the restriction on increasing fee and course costs to the level of the fee and course cost maxima; and
 - (b) the limit on postgraduate fee increases.
- 13. In considering "exceptional circumstances" exemptions, the TEC will use the following principles:
 - (a) The cost of providing the course(s) is not being met by the income from the course(s);
 - (b) the organisation is unable to cross-subsidise the course(s) from its total financial surplus while remaining financially viable; and
 - (c) not increasing fees and course costs would compromise progress towards the achievement of the Tertiary Education Strategy 2007/12, the Statement of Tertiary Education Priorities 2008/10, or other critical elements of the tertiary reforms.
- 14. An application for exemption will be assessed for the overall balance of the principles above. It is not sufficient to satisfy one principle, but it is not necessary to satisfy all principles to gain an exemption.

Sanctions

15. Where the TEC finds that a tertiary education provider is not complying with the conditions set out in this notice, it can withdraw student achievement component funding for that course. This sanction will only be exercised as a final resort, and the TEC will work with the provider to rectify any non-compliance in the first instance.

Note: Effect of this Notice

These notes do not form part of this notice, but are intended to indicate its general effect.

- A. Section 159ZA(2) of the Education Act 1989 ("the Act") provides that the Minister, when determining the design of a funding mechanism, may specify the conditions that the TEC must attach to funding provided under the mechanism, including conditions that limit the fees that an organisation may charge domestic students.
- B. Under section 159ZA(6) of the Act, the Minister may not specify conditions setting limits on fees until two months after the date of publication of a notice in the *New Zealand Gazette* that:
 - (i) states that the Minister proposes to specify such conditions; and
 - (ii) sets out the proposed conditions; and
 - (iii) invites submissions on the proposed conditions; and
 - (iv) specifies the date by which submissions must be received, which must be a date no more than 21 days after the date of the *New Zealand Gazette* notice.
- C. The conditions setting limits on fees subsequently specified by the Minister in accordance with section 159zA(2) of the Act will be attached as conditions on the use of funding payable by the Tertiary Education Commission to an organisation under sections 159zC and 159zD of the Act.
- D. Under sections 227(1A) and 236C of the Act, TEIs and PTEs respectively must not charge domestic students a fee which exceeds the maximum specified as a condition on funding by the TEC under sections 159ZC and 159ZD of the Act.

 - "special deposit" means a deposit held other than at call on behalf of the Crown, or any local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1974;
 - "trust deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit or a special deposit) held on trust:
 - (i) for persons not of full age or capacity; or
 - (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
 - (iii) otherwise than at call.
- (2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.
- **3. Rates of Common Fund interest**—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.
- (2) The rate of Common Fund interest on each protection deposit associated with a particular private training establishment shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate dollar range of the total of those deposits.

- 1. Pursuant to section 172I of the Electricity Act 1992 ("Act"), I notify the amendment of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 ("Rules") under section 172H of the Act.
- 2. The empowering provision for the Electricity Governance Regulations in relation to which the amendments to the Rules are made is section 172D(1)(1)(b) of the Act.
- 3. The nature of the amendment of Rule 11.5.3 of Section IV of Part C is to change the wording of the Rule to correct the definition of the receivers of under-frequency event rebates and to delete a superfluous extension of this definition to a special case of receivers.
- 4. Pursuant to section 172z(4) of the Act, the reasons for my decision to amend the Rules are that the changes correct existing anomalies, align with current practice and cause the least disruption to related rules.
- 5. These Rules come into force on 27 September 2007.

- **2. Exemption**—Transpower New Zealand Limited ("Transpower") is exempted from compliance with Rule 3.1.3.2(b) of Section II of Part F of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 ("Rules").
- **3. Terms and conditions**—This exemption is granted on the condition that it expires on 26 October 2007.
- **4. Reasons for granting the exemption**—The reasons for granting this exemption are:
 - (a) Transpower is not currently able to comply with some of the requirements of Section II of Part F of the Rules as they relate to determining the content of the schedules of draft default transmission agreements;
 - (b) the Commission is consulting on proposed rule changes to address this issue. These rule changes, if made by the Minister of Energy, are likely to come into effect by 25 October 2007;
 - (c) the exemption will allow time for the Commission to consult on the proposed rule changes and (depending on the results of the consultation) recommend them to the Minister;

- (d) not granting the exemption may result in unwarranted costs relating to disputes and rule breach procedures that occur while the proposed rule changes are being consulted on and considered. These costs would be obviated if the proposed rule changes proceed; and
- (e) if the rule changes do not proceed, Transpower will need to comply with the Rules, as they currently stand, from the date the exemption expires.

Consolidated Statement of Accounting Policies and Notes for the Year Ended 31 March 2007

1. Formation

The West Coast Community Trust ("the group") was formed on 30 May 1988 through the creation of a trust deed in compliance with the Trustee Banks Restructuring Act 1988. The trust's original capital of \$3 million came from the proceeds of the sale of Westland Bank Limited. The group consists of West Coast Community Trust and its former subsidiary West Coast Community Trust Charitable Company Limited. This subsidiary was wound up pursuant to a resolution of trustees dated 22 July 2004. These accounts have been prepared in accordance with the Financial Reporting Act 1993. The group qualifies for differential reporting because its revenue and number of employees fall below the threshold set by the differential reporting standards.

The group has applied all the differential reporting exemptions allowed with the exception of SSAP3 – Accounting for Depreciation.

2. Measurement System

The measurement system adopted is that of historical cost.

3. Particular Accounting Policies

The particular accounting policies adopted in the statements, which have a significant effect on the results and financial position disclosed, are:

- (a) Income Determination
 - Interest income has been accrued to balance date on a daily basis.
- (b) Valuation of Assets
 - (i) Investments

Investments are stated at net realisable value.

(ii) Fixed Assets

All fixed assets are recorded at cost less accumulated depreciation to date.

(c) Depreciation

Depreciation has been charged on a straight line basis allocated over an estimated economic life of the assets. Depreciation has been calculated as follows:

(d) Goods and Services Tax

The group is exempt from registration for goods and services tax under section 14(b) of the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

These financial statements have therefore been prepared on a GST inclusive basis.

(e) Consolidation

The West Coast Community Trust and its subsidiary charitable company, West Coast Community Trust Charitable Company Limited, have been consolidated using the purchase method of consolidation. As the West Coast Community Trust Charitable Company Limited was wound up as at 31 March 2006, no consolidation has been necessary in regard to the 2007 figures.

4. Taxation

From 1 April 2004, the trust is exempt from income tax under section CB4(1)(m) of the Income Tax Act 1994. As a result, the only taxation the trust pays is in relation to imputation credits and withholding payments deducted from dividends and overseas earnings, which are not eligible to be refunded.

5. Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies.

Rates of remuneration, including honoraria and meeting fees, are set by the Minister of Finance. The group has also insured all trustees against liability to other parties that may arise from their position as trustees, excluding liability for gross negligence or criminal actions.

A register of interest is held at the office of the trust and is available for public inspection.

The trustees have adopted a code of conduct. There were no breaches of this code during the financial year ended 31 March 2007.

7. Trust Funds

Although the trust does not maintain an inflation reserve, it does seek to maintain the trust capital in real terms. The trust calculates that an amount of \$1,404,067 is required to be retained to stabilise the original \$3 million fund from inflation. Our current retained earnings is \$2,161,871 which leaves \$757,804 as the growth of the trust in real terms.

8. Investments

The value of investments which are held in equities and fixed interest are subject to market fluctuations. The total investment portfolio is diversified in such a way that over time, reductions in value in particular asset classes should be more than offset by increases in other classes. Investments are disclosed at market value at balance date and any gains (losses) arising from that treatment are shown under revenue in the statement of financial performance. No provision has been made for potential gains or losses that could occur due to future market fluctuations. The investment portfolio as at 31 March 2007 is diversified as follows:
