Customs and Excise Act 1996

Customs (Import Entry) Amendment Rules 2007 (CR 1D/2007)

Pursuant to section 288(1)(d) and (12) of the Customs and Excise Act 1996, the Chief Executive hereby amends the Customs (Import Entry) Rules 1997.

- 1. Title—(1) These rules are the Customs (Import Entry) Amendment Rules 2007.
- (2) In these rules, the Customs (Import Entry) Rules 1997* are called "the principal rules". (*CR 1D/1997, as amended by CR 1D/2004)
- 2. Commencement—These rules shall come into force on 1 June 2007.
- **3.** Amendment—Form C4G in Schedule 1 of the principal rules is hereby revoked and substituted with the form set out in the Schedule to these rules.
- **4.** Rules to continue in force—Except to the extent amended by these rules, the principal rules shall remain in force.
- **5. Status of Rules**—These rules are regulations for the purposes of the Regulations (Disallowance) Act 1989.
