

Electricity Industry Reform Act 1998

Notice of Exemption—Westpower Limited

The Commerce Commission ("Commission"), pursuant to section 81 of the Electricity Industry Reform Act 1998 ("EIR Act"), exempts Westpower Limited ("Westpower") from the application of section 17 of the EIR Act in respect of the "cross-involvement" (as that term is defined in the EIR Act) that would be created through its investment in a hydro generation plant, located on the Amethyst River at Harihari, South Westland, through the joint venture proposal outlined in its application for exemption registered by the Commission on 4 August 2006.

The exemption is subject to the following conditions:

(a) The joint venture company and Westpower's electricity lines business must comply with rules

- 1 to 6 and 11 to 15 of the Arms Length Rules set out in Schedule 1 of the EIR Act.
- (b) Westpower must not be involved directly or indirectly in the selling of electricity to any end-use customer connected to Westpower's electricity network. This does not preclude the sale of electricity to an electricity retailer.
- (c) This exemption does not extend to engaging in the financial hedging of risks relating to the price of electricity in New Zealand beyond the nameplate generation capacity (6 MW per annum) of the proposed hydro generation plant.
- (d) This exemption is specific to the cross-involvements created through Westpower's involvement in the proposed joint venture. It does not extend to any other interest or existing or future cross-involvement of Westpower.

The Commission may vary or revoke the exemption in accordance with section 81 (5) of the EIR Act.

 - (a) the possibility that Genesis' commercial incentives in relation to the event charge could lead to delays in HLY5 commissioning or unproven reliability during the winter of 2007; and
 - (b) commissioning of HLY5, given its size and complexity and the contribution it is expected to

make to security of supply in the winter of 2007, is a relatively unique circumstance compared to re-commissioning of existing assets or commissioning of new smaller assets.

Phytosterol esters may only be added to yoghurt –

- (a) such that the yoghurt contains no more than 1.5g total fat per 100g; and

- (c) where the total phytosterol ester added is no less than 1.3g and no more than 1.6g.

- (e) concentrated fruit purée; and
- (f) comminuted fruit; and
- (g) orange peel extract; and

- (1) A formulated beverage must contain no more than

 - (b) caffeine.

Editorial note:

Formulated beverages are liquid products which are sold in a form designed to be consumed as is, that is, without the need to reconstitute or add further ingredients.

Racing Act 2003

Amendments to the Betting Rules

Pursuant to section 52 of the Racing Act 2003, the New Zealand Racing Board hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the Betting Rules*.

Change #1

A new definition added to Rule 3.1 as follows:

(r) "Payout" means the amount that will be paid on a winning bet and includes any refunds due on that bet.

Change #2

Rule 4.1 amended to:

4.1 Compliance with these Rules and Rules of Racing

The placing and acceptance of bets and the payments of Dividends, Returns and Refunds whether on the Totalisator or at Fixed Odds, must comply with these rules and the Rules of Racing.

Change #3

A new Rule 4.12 added as follows:

4.12 Denomination to which dividends will be rounded

The denomination to which dividends, refunds, returns and payout amounts will be rounded shall be determined by the Board and may be varied from time to time at the discretion of the Board. See Appendix 1.

Change #4

A new Rule 10.7.2 (d) added as follows:

(d) The reinvestment amount shall be truncated down to the nearest whole cent.

Change #5

Rule 10.8.5 amended to:

10.8.5 Payment of dividends and refunds in respect of Percentage Bets

A winning Percentage Bet will receive the product, rounded in accordance with Appendix 1, of, the declared Dividend, and the number of dollars that the Percentage Bet had invested on the winning combination.

The total amount due in Refunds to any Percentage Bet will be rounded in accordance with Appendix 1.

Change #6

Rule 12.3 (c) amended to:

(c) All Returns will be rounded in accordance with Appendix 1 where applicable.

Change #7

Rule 14.6 (f) amended to:

(f) All ticket Returns will be rounded in accordance with Appendix 1 where applicable.

Change #8

Rule 16.4 amended to:

16.4 Returns

Multi Odds are calculated by multiplying the Odds for each individual selection, then rounding up to the nearest cent. The Multi Return is calculated by multiplying the Multi Odds by the Investment amount and rounding in accordance with Appendix 1.

Example: Auckland to beat Wellington is paying \$1.70, Warriors to beat Canberra is paying \$2, All Whites to beat Japan is paying \$3.40.

Multi Odds = $1.70 \times 2 \times 3.40 = 11.56$.

Multi Return for \$20 Investment = $20 \times 11.56 = 231.20$.

 - (ii) Scratchings of selections that have had bets of a Minimum Bet Value of between \$2 and \$5 placed via the PhoneBet channel during the Early Bird Service will not be transferable to another selection, but will be refunded.
 - (b) Account Holders with a disability that are unable to use other betting channels. For the avoidance of doubt, Account Holders with a disability include:
 - (i) Those existing Account Holders known to the Board as having a disability of such a nature that restricts the use of the other channels, as determined by the Board from time to time; and
 - (ii) all other Account Holders, with a disability of such a nature that restricts the use of the other channels as determined by the Board from time to time, on application to the Board.

These Rules come into force on 13 November 2006.
