The Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 12 July 2012

The following notice is given pursuant to section 50 Public Trust Act 2001 ("the Act").

Notice

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 12 July 2012.

(2) Unless otherwise specified, the determinations and revocation in this notice take effect from and including 11 July 2012.

- **2. Interpretation**—(1) Unless the context otherwise requires:
 - "agency deposit" means a deposit (not being an investment deposit) held as agent or attorney;
 - "call deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit, a special deposit or a trust deposit) held in the ordinary course of administration, and determined by Public Trust to be held at call;
 - "deposit" means a sum of money held by Public Trust belonging to any estate, which money for the time being forms part of the Common Fund;
 - "investment deposit" means a deposit held at call or otherwise as an investment under section 51 of the Act;
 - "protection deposit" means a deposit, held at call, of tuition, boarding, accommodation or other fees by or on behalf of a student enrolled at a private training establishment within the meaning of Part 18 of the Education Act 1989;
 - "special deposit" means a deposit held other than at call on behalf of the Crown, or any local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1974;
 - "trust deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit or a special deposit) held on trust:
 - (i) for persons not of full age or capacity; or
 - (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
 - (iii) otherwise than at call.
- (2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.
- **3. Rates of Common Fund interest**—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.
- (2) The rate of Common Fund interest on each protection deposit associated with a particular private training establishment shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate dollar range of the total of those deposits.
- (3) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 3 for the appropriate interest payment frequency, term and dollar range.
- (4) Despite subparagraph (1), the rate of Common Fund interest payable on deposits made pursuant to an enactment shall be the rate (if any) specified in the enactment.
- (5) Despite subparagraphs (1), (2) and (3), in particular cases or classes of case, Public Trust and the depositor may agree on a rate of interest payable on investment deposits, protection deposits or special deposits that is different from the rate specified in Schedules 1, 2, or 3 and the agreed rate then applies.
- **4.** Revocation of notice and transitional provisions—
 (1) The Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 21 June 2012 is revoked.
- (2) Unless otherwise specified, the rates of interest specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice do not apply to any period that ends with 11 July 2012 but otherwise operate as from 12 July 2012.
- (3) The rates of interest specified in Schedule 3 to this notice:
 - (i) do not apply to investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term that commenced prior to 12 July 2012; but
 - (ii) do apply to investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term that commenced on or after 12 July 2012.

Commerce Act (Summary of Transpower Input Methodologies Determination) Notice 2012

Pursuant to Part 4 of the Commerce Act 1986 ("Act"), the Commerce Commission ("Commission") gives the following notice.

Notice

- 1. Title—This notice is the Commerce Act (Summary of Transpower Input Methodologies Determination) Notice 2012.
- 2. Transpower input methodologies determination
- 2.1 On 29 June 2012, the Commission made the Commerce Act Transpower Input Methodologies Determination [2012] NZCC 17 ("Determination").
- 2.2 The Determination sets out the input methodologies that apply to the supply of electricity lines services, as that term is defined in section 54C of the Act ("Electricity Lines Services") by Transpower, as that term is defined in section 54B of the Act ("Transpower") for the purpose of information disclosure regulation and individual price-quality regulation, as required by Part 4 of the Act.
- 2.3 In accordance with section 52W(2) of the Act, this notice is published as a brief description of the nature of each input methodology and the goods or services to which it applies. It includes the reasons for determining the methodologies and how the methodologies are publicly available.
- 2.4 The input methodologies in this determination are the same in all respects as the input methodologies in the 2010 Decision (as amended by the Commission's Decision No. 737 and consolidated on 1 November 2011).

3. Nature of the input methodologies and the goods or services to which they apply

The following input methodologies apply to Electricity Lines Services that are supplied by Transpower:

- (a) cost of capital (an approach to calculating a weighted average cost of capital by applying a specified methodology that includes certain fixed parameters, and an approach to calculating a term credit spread differential); and
- (b) asset valuation (an approach to calculating the value of the initial regulatory asset base and how this is rolled forward over time, including rules regarding depreciation and revaluation of assets); and
- (c) cost allocation (an approach which ensures that costs that have been allocated under any agreement in respect of the provision of system operator services are not also recoverable through the charges for other Electricity Lines Services that Transpower supplies); and
- (d) treatment of taxation (a tax payable approach to calculating a tax allowance for regulatory purposes); and
- (e) regulatory rules and processes relating to:
 - (i) specification of price (which includes that maximum revenues will be specified by a total revenue cap, and identifies any costs that can be passed through to prices);
 - (ii) incremental rolling incentive scheme (an approach that allows Transpower to retain efficiency gains in controllable operating expenditure across regulatory periods); and
 - (iii) reconsideration of an individual price-quality path (the circumstances in which an individual price-quality path may be reconsidered within a regulatory period).

4. Reasons for determining the input methodologies

- 4.1 The Commission was required to determine input methodologies that apply to Electricity Lines Services (including Electricity Lines Services that are supplied by Transpower) by no later than 31 December 2010 (pursuant to an extension granted by the Minister of Commerce under section 52U(2) of the Act).
- 4.2 The Commission determined the input methodologies that apply to Electricity Lines Services (including Electricity Lines Services that are supplied by Transpower) on 22 December 2010. That followed a process of extensive consultation with interested parties, including by holding workshops and a conference, through which the Commission considered it had obtained sufficient information to make its input methodologies determination.
- 4.3 In a judgment dated 22 December 2011 the High Court declared the Transpower cost of capital input methodology to be unlawful to the extent of the Commission's decision as to leverage, and required that the Commission consult again on that matter.
- 4.4 The Commission undertook further consultation with interested parties on leverage in the cost of capital input methodology and has obtained sufficient information to make its input methodologies determination.
- 4.5 Having considered all submissions received from interested parties within set time frames throughout the consultation process, the Commission considers that the input methodologies that it has determined meet the purpose of input methodologies as set out in section 52R of the Act and meet the purpose of Part 4 of the Act, as set out in section 52A of the Act and that no materially better alternatives have been proposed during the consultation process. After further consultation on leverage the Commission made its determination. The input methodologies in the determination are the same in all respects as the input methodologies in the 2010 Decision (as amended by the Commission's Decision No. 737 and consolidated on 1 November 2011).
- 4.6 More comprehensive detail of the background and analysis to support these reasons for determining the input methodologies is set out in the Input Methodologies (Transpower) Reasons Paper, 22 December 2010 and in the Input Methodologies (Transpower) Supplementary Reasons Paper for Leverage in Cost of Capital, 29 June 2012 (the "Reasons Papers").

5. How the Determination is publicly available

Explanatory Note

The Commerce Amendment Act 2008 introduced changes to the Commerce Act 1986 ("Act"), including a requirement for the Commerce Commission ("Commission") to determine up-front input methodologies that apply to regulated services, to the extent applicable to the type of regulation under consideration.

The purpose of input methodologies is to promote certainty for suppliers and consumers in relation to the rules, requirements, and processes applying to the regulation, or proposed regulation, of goods or services under Part 4 of the Act.

The purpose of Part 4, as set out in section 52A of the Act, is to promote the long-term benefit of consumers in markets where there is little or no competition and little or no likelihood of a substantial increase in competition, by promoting outcomes that are consistent with outcomes produced in competitive markets such that suppliers of regulated goods or services:

- (a) have incentives to innovate and invest, including in replacement, upgraded, and new assets; and
- (b) have incentives to improve efficiency and provide services at a quality that reflects consumer demands; and
- (c)share with consumers the benefits of efficiency gains in the supply of the regulated goods or services, including through lower prices; and
- (d) are limited in their ability to extract excessive profits.

In accordance with section 54S of the Act, the Commission determined an input methodology for Transpower's capital expenditure proposals on 31 January 2012 (following an extended deadline granted by the Minister of Commerce pursuant to that section).

Notification of Amendment to Input Methodologies for Related Party Asset Acquisitions

Pursuant to section 52W of the Commerce Act 1986, the Commerce Commission ("Commission") gives public notice that it has amended the input methodologies applying to suppliers of gas pipeline services and electricity distribution services.

The amendments provide additional methods for valuing assets acquired by suppliers from related parties for the purposes of information disclosure and customised price-quality path proposals.

- (d) a person authorised in another jurisdiction by the competent authority of that jurisdiction to deal in futures contracts; or
- (e) Her Majesty The Queen in right of New Zealand, a Crown entity named in the Crown Entities Act 2004, or a State enterprise named in the First or Second Schedule to the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 (each as amended from time to time); or
- (f) a person who is a statutory corporation or a registered bank; or
- (g) a person whose principal business is the investment of money or who, in the course of and for the

- purposes of their business, habitually invests money; or
- (h) a person who is a related body corporate of any of the persons mentioned in subparagraphs (a) to (g) above
- (3) Any term or expression that is defined in the Act and used, but not defined, in this notice has the same meaning as in the Act
- **3. Authorisation**—(1) The Company is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts generally.
- (2) The authorisation in clause 3(1) is subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) the Company does not carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts except as part of the business of the Company as a fund manager or an investment adviser or investment manager for a fund manager of a fund; and
 - (b) the Company deals only on behalf of its wholesale clients; and
 - (c) before dealing in any futures contract in respect of which the authorisation applies, the Company is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the wholesale client is contracting:
 - (i) as principal on its own account; or
 - (ii) on behalf of a related body corporate; or
 - (iii) as trustee of a trust or manager of a managed fund; and
 - (d) the Company does not carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts on behalf of any wholesale client other than one who has entered into a written contract for services with the Company, and then only in accordance with the terms of that contract; and
 - (e) the Company, and any other person acting on its behalf, does not hold or receive client money or client property in connection with its dealing in futures contracts; and
 - (f) in respect of any futures contract that is made on or effected through a recognised exchange, that any acquisition or disposal of the contract is effected through a person who is an authorised participant or member of the recognised exchange and who is authorised or licensed by the laws of the country in which it operates to deal in futures contracts on behalf of that person and to hold client money for that purpose; and
 - (g) the Company notifies FMA as soon as practicable of any material matter concerning the Company's authorisation as a futures dealer, including any regulatory action taken concerning the Company, whether in New Zealand or overseas; and
 - (h) the Company provides FMA with a copy of the Company's audited financial statements no later than three months after the end of each financial year for the Company.

Dental Technology practice is a subset of the practice of dentistry, and is commensurate with a Dental Technician's approved education, training and competence.

It involves processes and procedures associated with the design, manufacture and repair of fixed and removable oral and extraoral appliances and prostheses prescribed by a practising dental specialist, dentist, clinical dental technician, medical practitioner or other practising health practitioner.

The working relationship between dental technicians and prescribing practising health practitioners is set out in the Dental Council Code of Practice – The Practice of Dental Technology and Clinical Dental Technology and the working relationship within the Practice of Dentistry.

Detailed Scope for Dental Technology Practice

The Dental Council defines the practice of Dental Technology as processes and procedures associated with the design, manufacture and repair of fixed and removable oral and extraoral appliances and prostheses prescribed by a practising dental specialist, dentist, clinical dental technician, medical practitioner or other practising health practitioner.

This involves:

- selection of appropriate dental materials for the design, manufacture and repair of fixed and removable oral and extraoral appliances and prostheses prescribed by a practising dental specialist, dentist, clinical dental technician, medical practitioner or other practising health practitioner.
- processes and procedures associated with the design, manufacture and repair of:
 - o complete removable dentures and overdentures.
 - removable partial dentures including precision attachments.
 - fixed and removable orthodontic appliances.
 - crowns and bridges including precision attachments on natural teeth and implants.
 - o implant overdentures and implant supported dentures.
 - tissue and implant supported maxillofacial, ocular and auricular appliances and prostheses, and other appliances and prostheses involved in the overall prosthetic rehabilitation of patients.
 - specialist treatment appliances such as, but not limited to:

diagnostic stents and radiographic stents, appliances for the treatment of temporomandibular disorders, appliances for the treatment of speech disorders, appliances for the treatment of sleep disorders and appliances for the treatment of audio disorders.

 undertake shade taking and shade checking, which may include the removal of a pre-loosened temporary restoration and try-in of the permanent restoration, without removal or placement of an abutment, as prescribed by and prior to the final fitting¹ by a dentist or dental specialist.

Practice in this context goes wider than dental technology to include teaching, research, and management, given that such roles influence clinical and technical practice and public safety. Areas of dental technology practice that were not included in a practitioner's training should not be undertaken unless the practitioner has completed appropriate training and practices to the standard required by the relevant Code of Practice.

The following scope of practice replaces the Scope for Clinical Dental Technology Practice published in the New Zealand Gazette, 21 October 2010, No. 143, page 3602.

Clinical Dental Technicians

Scope for Clinical Dental Technology Practice

The Scope of Practice for Clinical Dental Technicians is set out in the documented "Detailed Scope for Clinical Dental Technology Practice" produced and published from time to time by the Dental Council.

Clinical Dental Technology practice is a subset of the practice of dentistry, and is commensurate with a Clinical Dental Technician's approved education, training and competence.

It involves the scope of practice for Dental Technology, plus the fitting of complete removable dentures and the fitting of some other types of removable dentures and oral and extraoral appliances under specific conditions – as set out in the detailed scope of practice.

The working relationship between clinical dental technicians and prescribing practising health practitioners is set out in the Dental Council Code of Practice – The Practice of Dental Technology and Clinical Dental Technology and the working relationship within the Practice of Dentistry.

Detailed Scope for Clinical Dental Technology Practice

The Dental Council defines the practice of clinical dental technology as:

- processes and procedures associated with the design, manufacture and repair of fixed and removable oral and extraoral appliances and prostheses prescribed by a practising dentist, dental specialist, medical practitioner or other authorised health practitioner as set out in the detailed scope for dental technology practice.
- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the fitting of removable complete dentures and the fitting of some other types of removable dentures and oral and extraoral appliances under specific conditions as set out below and as described below.
- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the trial fitting and repair of removable complete and partial implant overdentures prescribed and the final fitting² by a dentist or dental specialist.

As well as the activities delineated in the detailed scope for dental technology practice, clinical dental technology practice involves:

- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the fitting and relining of removable complete dentures when there are no natural teeth remaining and there is no diseased or unhealed hard or soft tissue.
- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the fitting and relining of removable partial dentures subject to the patient having obtained an oral health certificate from a dentist or dental specialist.
- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the construction of removable complete and partial immediate dentures on the prescription of, and prior to the fitting by a dentist or dental specialist.
- taking impressions, relining and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the construction of removable complete and partial

root/tooth overdentures subject to the patient having obtained an oral health certificate from and on the prescription of a dentist or dental specialist, and prior to the final fitting² by a dentist or dental specialist.

- processes and procedures associated with extraoral maxillofacial prostheses, for those with formal training or if they can demonstrate that they have the requisite knowledge and training to undertake this work³:
 - Taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the fitting, construction and repair of extraoral maxillofacial prostheses, that are not in direct communication with the naso- or the orophayngeal airway under the prescription of a dentist, dental specialist or medical practitioner, who remains responsible for the clinical outcomes of the patient.
 - Taking impressions of maxillofacial defects that are in direct communication with the naso- or the orophayngeal airway, for those clinical dental technicians with formal training or if they can demonstrate that they have the requisite knowledge and training to undertake this work, and only under the direct clinical supervision of a dentist, dental specialist or medical practitioner qualified to manage an airway emergency, who remains responsible for the clinical outcomes of the patient.
- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the construction of removable complete and partial implant overdentures on the prescription of, and prior to the final fitting² by a dentist or dental specialist. This does not include removal or placement of abutments such as healing, temporary or permanent, or fixture level/subgingival impression copings.
- repairing and/or relining of removable complete and partial implant overdentures on the prescription of and prior to the final fit² by a dentist or dental specialist and appropriate referral when indicated.
- designing, constructing, repairing and supplying appliances for the treatment of sleep disorders only on the prescription of a registered dentist, dental specialist or medical practitioner.
- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive procedures involved in the construction of an anti-snoring device, however, only a dentist, dental specialist or medical practitioner, who retains responsibility for the clinical care outcomes, can perform the final fit² of the appliance.
- in relation to the above activities:
 - Obtaining medical and dental histories and consulting with other health practitioners as appropriate.
 - Examination of the oral tissues to ensure that the patient's mouth is fit for purpose and free of disease, disorder or abnormality.
 - Referral of patients to a dentist, dental specialist or medical practitioner when any disease, disorder or abnormality is detected.
 - Referral of patients to a dentist, dental specialist or medical practitioner for a prescription for an oral health certificate and treatment plan where required.
 - Preparation of a treatment plan (in association with a prescription if required) and communicating this to the patient.
 - Oral health education and promotion.

Practice in this context goes wider than clinical dental technology to include teaching, research, and management, given that such roles influence clinical and technical practice and public safety.

The scope involves clinical procedures associated with the design, manufacture, trial fitting and repair of removable complete and partial implant overdentures prescribed and fitted by a practising dentist or dental specialist.

Detailed Scope for Implant Overdentures

As well as the activities delineated in the detailed scopes for dental technology and clinical dental technology practice, the additional scope for implant overdenture practice includes:

- taking impressions and undertaking other non-invasive clinical procedures involved in the construction of removable complete and partial implant overdentures on the prescription of, and prior to the final fitting⁴ by, a dentist or dental specialist.
- repairing removable complete and partial implant overdentures prescribed and fitted by a dentist or dental specialist and appropriate referral when indicated.
- relining removable complete and partial implant overdentures on the prescription of, and prior to the final fitting by a dentist or dental specialist⁴.
