 - (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
 - (iii) otherwise than at call (not being a special deposit).
- (2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

Daniel Ronald Mathers

to be an officer of the Government of the Dependency while he acts as Senior New Zealand Representative at Scott Base during the period beginning with this appointment and ending with the close of 10 October 2004:

I confer on Daniel Ronald Mathers, while he holds office as an officer of the Government of the Dependency, all the powers exercisable in New Zealand by a Justice of the Peace, and also the powers exercisable in New Zealand by a Coroner:

Daniel Ronald Mathers is to exercise his functions at such places within the Dependency as may be directed by an officer of the Government of the Dependency who has the general executive and administrative authority in preserving Her Majesty's rights and sovereignty and the laws in force in the Dependency.

As witness the hand of Her Excellency the Governor-General as the Governor of the Ross Dependency, this 5th day of March 2004.

2.1 The easement to convey telecommunications will contain the right and powers implied into easements for a right to convey telecommunications and computer media as set out in the Fourth Schedule to the Land Transfer Regulations 2002, except as such rights and powers are expressly modified below.

3.0 Easement to Convey Electricity

- 3.1 The easement to convey electricity will contain the rights and powers implied into such easement by the Fourth Schedule to the Land Transfer Regulations 2002, except as such rights and powers are expressly modified below.
- 3.2 The electricity easement facility through that part of the servient land shown as "A", "B" and "C" on the easement plan is restricted to lines under the ground.

4.0 Right of Way

- 4.1 The rights and powers implied into vehicular rights of way by the Ninth Schedule to the Property Law Act 1952 are expressly negatived.
