- (i) stating its education activities within a written statement of its goals and objectives, approved by the governing body.
- (ii) having performance indicators to measure the achievement of its goals and objectives.

1.2 Systems to achieve goals and objectives

The provider puts into practice quality management systems to achieve its goals and objectives. The quality management systems must cover the following:

1.2.1 Governance and management

The provider has adequate and appropriate governance and management to achieve its goals and objectives. The provider demonstrates this by:

Ownership and governance

- (i) defining its ownership and governance structures.
- (ii) managing in the best interests of the establishment and its kaupapa.
- (iii) maintaining its corporate status.

Quality management systems

- (iv) applying a coherent set of policies and procedures (quality management system).
- (v) applying the management system across all sites.
- (vi) defining organisational structures, roles, responsibilities, authorities, lines of reporting and accountability.
- (vii) defining how it addresses the principles of the Treaty of Waitangi.

- (x) operating trust accounts that comply with section 236A of the Education Act 1989.

1.2.2 Personnel

The provider recruits, manages and develops its people to achieve its goals and objectives. The provider demonstrates this by:

- (i) using appropriate recruitment and selection practices to make sure it has enough personnel with:
 - teaching and subject knowledge
 - assessment and moderation expertise
 - educational management experience
 - quality management expertise

 - financial and administration expertise

Nurses Act 1977

Order of the Nursing Council in Disciplinary Session in Respect of a Registered Comprehensive Nurse

After due inquiry and in exercise of its powers under sections 42 (1) (b), 42 (2) (d), 42 (3) and 48A of the Nurses Act 1977, the Nursing Council of New Zealand ("the council"), in a decision dated the 30th day of October 2002, ordered that a registered comprehensive nurse be censured.

The council also ordered that the nurse pay \$11,500.00 (being 30%) towards the actual costs and expenses of and incidental to the investigation and prosecution by the preliminary proceedings committee and inquiry by the council and ordered that a notice stating the effect of these orders be published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, *Kai Tiaki: Nursing New Zealand*, the nursing council's newsletter and provided to accredited members of the press upon request with suppression of the nurse's and other parties' names together with suppression of all identifying features of the case.
