EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Notice amends the statistical key codes, units and descriptions of the Tariff items specified in this Notice. The additions to the statistical key structure under Tariff items 3213.10.00 and 3213.90.00 are to provide for the monitoring of children's finger paints and watercolour paints. The amendment under Tariff item 3824.90.50 is to correct the spelling of the word "chlorinated". The amendment under Tariff item 7215.50.20 is to correct the "dot" structure between statistical key codes 29H and 39E. The amendments under Tariff items 8528.72.00, 8528.73.00, 8529.90.09 and 8529.90.11 provide for the removal of statistical key codes for televisions mounted in cabinets, and cabinets for radios and televisions. The additions to the statistical key structure under Tariff items 9609.10.09 and 9609.90.39 are to provide for the monitoring of children's crayons.
