Radiocommunications Regulations 2001

Radiocommunications Regulations (General User Radio Licence for Amateur Radio Operators) Notice 2013

Pursuant to section 111 of the Radiocommunications Act 1989 and Regulation 9 of the Radiocommunications Regulations 2001, and acting under delegated authority from the chief executive, I give the following notice.

Notice

1. Short title and commencement—(1) This notice is the Radiocommunications Regulations (General User Radio Licence for Amateur Radio Operators) Notice 2013.

(2) This notice comes into force on **1 August 2013**.

2. General user radio licence—A general user radio licence is granted for the transmission of radio waves by amateur radio operators in New Zealand, for the purpose of communications in the amateur radio service in accordance with the terms, conditions and restrictions of this notice.

3. Terms, conditions and restrictions applying to New Zealand amateur operators—(1) Persons who hold a General Amateur Operator's Certificate of Competency and a callsign issued pursuant to the Regulations may operate an amateur radio station in New Zealand.

(2) The callsign prefix of "ZL" may be substituted with the prefix "ZM" by the callsign holder for the period of, and participation in, a recognised contest, or as the control station for special event communications.

(3) Operation on amateur bands between 5 MHz and 25 MHz is not permitted unless a person has held a General Amateur Operators Certificate of Competency for three months and logged 50 contacts during this period. The person must keep the logbook record for at least one year and, during this period, produce it at the request of the chief executive.

4. Terms, conditions and restrictions applying to visiting amateur operators—(1) Persons visiting New Zealand who hold a current amateur certificate of competency,

authorisation or licence issued by another administration, may operate an amateur station in New Zealand for a period not exceeding 90 days, provided the certificate, authorisation or licence meets the requirements of Recommendation ITU-R M.1544 or CEPT T/R 61-01 or CEPT T/R 61-02 and is produced at the request of the chief executive.

(2) The visiting overseas operator must use the national callsign allocated by the other administration to the operator, in conjunction with the prefix or suffix "ZL", except where subsection (3) applies, which is to be separated from the national callsign by the character "/" (telegraphy), or the word "stroke" (telephony).

(3) The visiting overseas operator may use the prefix or suffix:

- a. ZL7 when visiting the Chatham Islands
- b. ZL8 when visiting the Kermadec Islands
- c. ZL9 when visiting the Sub-Antarctic Islands

5. Terms, conditions and restrictions applying to all amateur operators—(1) The use of callsigns, including temporary and club callsigns, must be in accordance with publication PIB 46 "Radio Operator Certificate and Callsign Rules" published at www.rsm.govt.nz

(2) Callsigns must be transmitted at least once every 15 minutes during communications.

(3) National and international communication is permitted only between amateur stations, and is limited to matters of a personal nature, or for the purpose of self-training, intercommunication and radio technology investigation, solely with a personal aim and without pecuniary interest. The passing of brief messages of a personal nature on behalf of other persons is also permitted, provided no fees or other consideration is requested or accepted.

(4) Communications must not be encoded for the purpose of obscuring their meaning, except for control signals by the operators of remotely controlled amateur stations.

(5) Except as provided to the contrary in this notice, transmitter power output must not exceed 1000 watts peak envelope power (pX), as defined in ITU Radio Regulation 1.157.

(6) Amateur stations must, as far as is compatible with practical considerations, comply with the latest ITU-R recommendations to the extent applicable to the amateur service.

(7) In accordance with Article 25 of the International Radio Regulations, amateur operators are encouraged to prepare for, and meet, communication needs in support of disaster relief.

(8) Amateur beacons, repeaters and fixed links may not be established pursuant to this licence.

(9) Unwanted emissions outside the frequency bands specified in this Schedule must comply with the requirements of technical standard ETSI ETS 300 684 published by the European Telecommunications Standards Institute (ETSI).

(10) This general user radio licence applies only to transmissions within the frequency ranges set out in the Schedule to this licence. All such transmissions must be made in accordance with the notes for the frequency range in which that transmission take place and in accordance with the other conditions set out in this licence.

Fisheries (Seabird Sustainability Measures— Bottom Longlines) Circular 2013 (No. MPI 189)

1. Title—This circular is the Fisheries (Seabird Sustainability Measures—Bottom Longlines) Circular 2013.

2. Commencement—This circular comes into force on **2 August 2013**.

3. Seabird sustainability measures in relation to specified vessel—From the date that this circular comes into force, consent is given for the vessel "*Tasman Viking*" to discharge offal or whole fish during hauling on the same side of the vessel to which the hauling station is located, despite clause 9(2) of the Fisheries (Seabird Sustainability Measures—Bottom Longlines) Circular 2010.

4. Restriction on consent given—The consent given in clause 3 is subject to the following standards and requirements in relation to the vessel "*Tasman Viking*":

- (a) Offal and whole fish must be held in batches and discharged together;
- (b) discharge must only be done when either:
 - (i) a minimum of 200kg of offal has accumulated; or
 - (ii) a maximum of 400kg of whole fish has accumulated;
- (c) each discharge event must last no longer than five minutes;

- (d) the estimated weight of discharge for each event must be recorded, with weight of offal and whole fish discard recorded separately;
- (e) the start and end time of the discharge must be recorded;
- (f) a fisheries observer must be carried on the first two trips operating under the measures specified in this notice;
- (g) the consent given in clause 3 only applies to the following time periods:
 - (i) 2 August 2013 to 31 October 2013; and
 - (ii) 1 August 2014 to 31 October 2014.

5. Expiry—This circular expires at the close of **31 October 2014**.

3. Interpretation—In this notice:

- (a) “mātaihai reserve” means the identified traditional fishing ground described in clause 4 of this notice.
- (b) “Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki” means any person or persons appointed as Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki for the mātaihai reserve under Regulation 24 of the Fisheries (Kaimoana Customary Fishing) Regulations 1998.

4. Declaration of a mātaihai reserve—The Minister for Primary Industries declares a mātaihai reserve over all fisheries waters enclosed by a line:

- (a) commencing at a point on the mean high water mark (MHWM) west of Cape Wīwī (at 35°09.18'S and 174°06.72'E); then
- (b) proceeding in a straight line in an easterly direction for approximately 1.9km to a point on an offshore rock (at 35°09.12'S and 174°08.05'E); then
- (c) proceeding in a straight line in an easterly direction to a point on Ninepin Island (at 35°09.16'S and 174°08.25'E); then
- (d) proceeding in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to a point offshore east of Moturoa Island (at 35°12.73'S and 174°06.84'E); then

- (e) proceeding in a straight line in a westerly direction to the eastern most point on the MHWM of Moturoa Island (at 35°12.67'S and 174°06.36'E); then
- (f) proceeding in a generally westerly direction along the MHWM of the south coast of Moturoa Island to the western most point on the MHWM of Moturoa Island (at 35°12.53'S and 174°04.49'E); then
- (g) proceeding in a straight line in a north-westerly direction to a point on the MHWM at Poraenui Point (at 35°11.57'S and 174°04.09'E); and then
- (h) proceeding in a generally north-easterly direction along the MHWM to the point of commencement.

5. Appointment of Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki—The Director-General names Hugh Rihari, Waata Rameka, Arena Munro, Whakaaropai Rihari, Bonnie Craven, Richard Civil, Arthur Ashby, Monica Ashby, Te Atareria Rameka, Mana Paul and Whakaiti Beau Heihei as Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki for the mātaihai reserve.

6. Prohibition on commercial fishing—Commercial fishing within the mātaihai reserve is prohibited under Regulation 27(2) of the Fisheries (Kaimoana Customary Fishing) Regulations 1998.

7. Power to authorise taking of fisheries resources for customary food-gathering—The Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki may authorise any individual to take fish, aquatic life or seaweed for customary food-gathering purposes from within the whole or any part of the mātaihai reserve. No fishing for customary food-gathering purposes may take place in the mātaihai reserve without authorisation from the Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki.

These changes follow consultation by the Council with all medical practitioners with current practising certificates, in accordance with Council's established practice of consulting on changes to prescribed fees. Medical practitioners received a document providing an explanation of the proposed increase. In the information provided to the medical practitioners, the Council noted:

- (a) The additional disciplinary levy of \$65.22 (exclusive of GST) that was implemented for 2012/13 would not be charged in 2013/14. One effect of this is a reduction in the Council's revenue for 2013/14 of approximately \$1M. A second effect is that those paying the practising certificate fee will pay less in 2013/14 even with the proposed practising certificate fee increase of \$10.00.*
- (b) The practising certificate fee has not increased since 1 July 2009 (except for the disciplinary levy in 2012/13). Since that time the overall increase in the Consumer Price Index has been between 8% and 9%.*
- (c) The Council, like any organisation, is facing increasing costs. The majority of its increasing costs relate directly to its responsibilities as a medical regulator under the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003.*
- (d) The Council had reviewed all areas of expenditure and reduced several items.*

Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003

Notice Replacing Scopes of Practice and Prescribed Qualifications

This notice replaces all previous scopes of practice and prescribed qualifications notices of the New Zealand Medical Radiation Technologists Board ("the Board").

Introduction

Under section 11 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 ("the Act"), the New Zealand Medical Radiation Technologists Board ("the Board") is obliged to define each of the practice areas that make up the practice of medical radiation technology. The Board's role is to identify for each of these practice areas – known as *scopes of practice* or *scopes* – the aspects of medical radiation technology covered by each scope. Medical radiation technology practitioners seeking to practise in New Zealand must first be registered with

the Board in one or more of the scopes of practice as defined in this notice.

Section 12 of the Act requires the Board to formally "prescribe" the specific qualifications that medical radiation technology practitioners must have to be eligible for registration in each of the scopes of practice. The prescribed qualifications may be different for each scope of practice.

The Board last published a full list of the scopes of practice and prescribed qualifications for the profession of medical radiation technology dated the 1st day of December 2010 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 9 December 2010, No. 170, page 4208. Since then the Board has consulted on, and approved, changes to the descriptors for each of its scopes of practice and associated prescribed qualifications, and as contained in this new Gazette Notice.

The Profession of Medical Radiation Technology

Medical radiation technology is a patient centred profession that encompasses the practices of medical imaging and radiation therapy. Medical imaging practitioners use different technologies to create images of the human body for diagnosis and the staging and management of disease. Radiation therapy practitioners use technology to create and evaluate images and data related to the localisation, planning and delivery of radiation treatments.

Scopes of Practice

The profession of medical radiation technology contains eight scopes of practice. Pursuant to section 11 of the Act, the Council specifies those scopes of practice as:

1. Scope of Practice – Medical Imaging Technologist

Medical Imaging Technologists are responsible for the outcome of the diagnostic imaging examination. The outcome of the examination is recorded electronically to allow for consultation with other health and medical practitioners.

Medical Imaging Technologists produce high quality diagnostic radiographs or carry out diagnostic procedures using ionising radiation. With appropriate training, Medical Imaging Technologists may practise computed tomography (CT), mammography, and angiography. Medical Imaging Technologists evaluate the diagnostic quality of images and take corrective measures as required.

Medical Imaging Technologists competencies include, but are not limited to, patient care, patient positioning, imaging physics and technology, anatomy and physiology identification and assessment, bioeffects and radiation safety, clinical and organisational responsibility for the examination, and quality assurance.

2. Scope of Practice – Radiation Therapist

Radiation Therapists are responsible for the planning and delivery of radiation treatment, primarily for people diagnosed with cancer. Radiation Therapists create and evaluate images for the localisation, planning and delivery of radiation treatment according to the prescription of the Radiation Oncologist.

Radiation Therapists provide specific care to patients throughout the course of their treatment and educate patients on the management of any treatment related side-effects.

Radiation Therapists' competencies include, but are not limited to, patient care, treatment design and delivery, radiation safety, clinical and organisational responsibility for the planning and treatment, and quality assurance.

3. Scope of Practice – Nuclear Medicine Technologist

Nuclear Medicine Technologists are responsible for the outcome of the nuclear medicine examination. The outcome of the examination is recorded electronically to allow for consultation with other health and medical practitioners.

Nuclear Medicine Technologists are involved in the preparation, administration, imaging and quantification of diagnostic pharmaceuticals to demonstrate organ and molecular function as well as the delivery of therapeutic radiopharmaceuticals to treat a number of pathologies.

Nuclear Medicine Technologists operate gamma camera systems (SPECT) and PET imaging systems with or without sealed sources of radioactive materials or x-ray tubes for attenuation correction, anatomical fusion, transmission imaging or, subsequent to a Board-approved training programme, diagnostic CT.

Nuclear Medicine Technologists' competencies include, but are not limited to, patient care, patient positioning, preparation and administration of radiopharmaceuticals, radionuclide and radiation safety, in-vitro diagnostic testing, radionuclide therapy, clinical and organisational responsibility for the examination, and quality assurance.

4. Scope of Practice – Sonographer

Sonographers are responsible for the outcome of the diagnostic ultrasound examination. The outcome of the examination is recorded electronically to allow for consultation with other health and medical practitioners.

Sonographers perform a wide range of real-time diagnostic examinations and may at their discretion (and in accordance with clinical and workplace guidelines) extend the examination to include relevant regions and/or sequences not suggested in the referral.

Sonographers' competencies include, but are not limited to, patient care, ultrasound physics and technology, anatomy and physiology identification and assessment, diagnostic interpretation of the ultrasound findings, bioeffects and the use of ultrasound technology, clinical and organisational responsibility for the examination, and quality assurance.

5. Scope of Practice – Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Technologist

Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Technologists are responsible for the outcome of the MRI examination. The outcome of the examination is recorded electronically to allow for consultation with other health and medical practitioners.

MRI Technologists produce high quality diagnostic images using a powerful magnetic field. MRI Technologists may at their discretion (and in the accordance with clinical and workplace guidelines) extend the examination to include relevant regions and/or sequences not suggested in the referral or protocol.

MRI Technologists' competencies include, but are not limited to, patient care, patient positioning, use of magnetic resonance imaging physics and technology, bioeffects and magnetic resonance safety, clinical and organisational responsibility for the examination, and quality assurance.

6. Scope of Practice – Trainee Nuclear Medicine Technologist

Suitably qualified registered health practitioners can apply for registration as a Trainee Nuclear Medicine Technologist in an approved training programme in nuclear medicine. Upon completion of the nuclear medicine training programme, and meeting the requirements for demonstrating clinical competence, the Trainee Nuclear Medicine Technologist is eligible to apply for registration in the scope of practice of Nuclear Medicine Technologist.

7. Scope of Practice – Trainee Sonographer

Suitably qualified registered health practitioners can apply for registration as a Trainee Sonographer in an approved training programme in ultrasound. Upon completion of the ultrasound training programme, and meeting the requirements for demonstrating clinical competence, the Trainee Sonographer is eligible to apply for registration in the scope of practice of Sonographer.

8. Scope of Practice – Trainee Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Technologist

Suitably qualified registered health practitioners can apply for registration as a Trainee MRI Technologist in an approved training programme in MRI. Upon completion of the MRI training programme, and meeting the requirements for demonstrating clinical competence, the Trainee MRI Technologist is eligible to apply for registration in the scope of practice of Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Technologist.

Qualifications Prescribed for Registration

Pursuant to section 12 of the Act, the following qualifications are prescribed for registration as a medical radiation technologist:

1. Medical Imaging Technologist

The practitioner must satisfy one of the following:

An undergraduate degree in diagnostic medical imaging from a New Zealand tertiary education institution that is accredited and monitored by the Board.

A qualification in diagnostic medical imaging approved by the Board combined with appropriate medical imaging experience.

A medical imaging qualification and/or course of study and/or successful completion of a Board registration examination assessment (REA) combined with appropriate medical imaging experience.

2. Radiation Therapist

The practitioner must satisfy one of the following:

An undergraduate degree in radiation therapy from a New Zealand tertiary education institution that is accredited and monitored by the Board.

A qualification in radiation therapy approved by the Board combined with appropriate radiation therapy experience.

A radiation therapy qualification and/or course of study and/or successful completion of a Board registration examination assessment (REA) combined with appropriate radiation therapy experience.

3. Nuclear Medicine Technologist

The practitioner must satisfy one of the following:

An undergraduate degree in medical imaging/radiation therapy and a qualification in nuclear medicine, combined with appropriate nuclear medicine experience.

A qualification in nuclear medicine approved by the Board combined with appropriate nuclear medicine experience.

A nuclear medicine qualification and/or course of study and/or successful completion of a Board registration examination assessment (REA) combined with appropriate nuclear medicine experience.

If the nuclear medicine qualification does not contain an assessment of clinical competence, the applicant must have completed a minimum of 3360 hours clinical experience in nuclear medicine before undergoing a Board registration examination assessment (REA).

4. Sonographer

The practitioner must satisfy one of the following:

An undergraduate degree in medical imaging or a relevant health science qualification and a postgraduate diploma in ultrasound from a New Zealand tertiary education institution that is accredited and monitored by the Board, combined with appropriate ultrasound experience.

A qualification in ultrasound approved by the Board combined with appropriate sonography experience.

An ultrasound qualification and/or course of study and/or successful completion of a Board registration examination assessment (REA) combined with appropriate ultrasound experience.

If the ultrasound qualification does not contain an assessment of clinical competence, the applicant must have completed a minimum of 3360 hours clinical experience in ultrasound before undergoing a Board registration examination assessment (REA).

5. Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Technologist

The practitioner must satisfy one of the following:

An undergraduate degree in medical imaging **and** a postgraduate diploma in MRI from a New Zealand tertiary education institution that is accredited and monitored by the Board, combined with appropriate MRI experience.

A qualification in MRI approved by the Board combined with appropriate MRI experience.

A MRI qualification and/or course of study and/or successful completion of a Board registration examination assessment (REA) combined with appropriate MRI experience.

If the MRI qualification does not contain an assessment of clinical competence, the applicant must have completed a minimum of 3360 hours clinical experience in MRI before undergoing a Board registration examination assessment (REA).

6. Trainee Nuclear Medicine Technologist

The practitioner must satisfy the following:

A qualification in medical imaging approved by the Board and enrolment in a Board-approved course of training in nuclear medicine.

7. Trainee Sonographer

The practitioner must satisfy the following:

A qualification in medical imaging and/or relevant health science approved by the Board and enrolment in a Board-approved course of training in ultrasound.

8. Trainee Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) Technologist

The practitioner must satisfy the following:

A qualification in medical imaging approved by the Board and enrolment in a Board-approved course of training in MRI.
