# Order of the Council in Disciplinary Session in Respect of an Enrolled Nurse

After due inquiry and in exercise of its powers under section 41 (1) (b), 42 (2) (b) (a), 42 (3) and 48A of the Nurses Act 1977, the Nursing Council of New Zealand ("the council") in a decision dated 21 February 2001, ordered that **Paul Desmond Breeze** practise under certain conditions for a period of 2 years from the date when he recommences working as an enrolled nurse including practising under the supervision of a registered nurse.
