 - "protection deposit" means a deposit, held at call, of tuition, boarding, accommodation or other fees by or on behalf of a student enrolled at a private training establishment within the meaning of Part 18 of the Education Act 1989;
 - "special deposit" means a deposit held other than at call on behalf of the Crown, or any local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1974;
 - "trust deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit or a special deposit) held on trust:
 - (i) for persons not of full age or capacity; or
 - (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
 - (iii) otherwise than at call.
- (2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.
- **3. Rates of Common Fund interest**—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.
- (2) The rate of Common Fund interest on each protection deposit associated with a particular private training establishment shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate dollar range of the total of those deposits.
- (3) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 3 for the appropriate interest payment frequency, term and dollar range.

- (4) Despite subparagraph (1), the rate of Common Fund interest payable on deposits made pursuant to an enactment shall be the rate (if any) specified in the enactment.
- (5) Despite subparagraphs (1), (2) and (3), in particular cases or classes of case, Public Trust and the depositor may agree on a rate of interest payable on investment deposits, protection deposits or special deposits that is different from the rate specified in Schedules 1, 2, or 3 and the agreed rate then applies.
- **4.** Revocation of notice and transitional provisions—(1) The Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 22 December 2011 is revoked.
- (2) Unless otherwise specified, the rates of interest specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice do not apply to any period that ends with 31 January 2012 but otherwise operate as from 1 February 2012.

- (iv) any enactment effective in the Company's place of incorporation which the NZ Participant must comply with because of its participation in the Market.
- (4) The Company must give the notice under clause 7(3) as soon as practicable after taking the disciplinary action, or knowing or suspecting the person has committed, is committing, or is likely to commit the significant contravention.
- (5) Any notice given by the Company under clause 7(3) must include:
 - (a) the person's name and contact details; and
 - (b) if it relates to a disciplinary action, the grounds for, nature of, and reasons for the action taken; and
 - (c) if it relates to a known or suspected contravention, the facts supporting the Company's view and to which obligation the known or suspected contravention relates; and
 - (d) any other information reasonably required by Financial Markets Authority in order to carry out its functions.
- (6) The Company must, if requested to do so in writing by the Financial Markets Authority and if not prohibited by any applicable law:
 - (a) give to Financial Markets Authority (or any person authorised by Financial Markets Authority) all information, documentation, assistance, and access to the Company's facilities; and
 - (b) answer any question asked by Financial Markets Authority (or any person authorised by Financial Markets Authority),

that are necessary or desirable to enable Financial Markets Authority to fulfil its functions.

- (7) The Company must notify Financial Markets Authority as soon as practical if:
 - (a) the Company's licence to operate a derivatives market in the Company's place of incorporation is varied or revoked; or
 - (b) any statutory requirement applying to the company as a result of, or in connection with, its operation of a derivative market is amended in a manner which materially alters an obligation or requirement imposed on the Company.
- (8) The Company must notify Financial Markets Authority as soon as practicable if:
 - (a) the Company becomes aware that the Company, or any of the Company's directors or senior management personnel, is subject to investigation by any regulatory or law enforcement agency; or
 - (b) the Company, or any of the Company's directors or senior management personnel, is subject to any adverse finding by any Court, tribunal, regulatory authority, or disciplinary committee; or
 - (c) the Company becomes aware that ASX Clear (Futures) Pty Limited, or any of its directors or senior management personnel, is subject to investigation by any regulatory or law enforcement agency; or
 - (d) ASX Clear (Futures) Pty Limited, or any of its directors or senior management personnel, is subject

to any adverse finding by any Court, tribunal, regulatory authority, or disciplinary committee.

- (9) The Company must, within three months after the end of its financial year, give a report to Financial Markets Authority on the extent to which it has complied with its obligations under clause 8 of this notice in the preceding financial year.

Government Roading Powers Act 1989 Land Transport Act 1998

New Zealand Transport Agency (Mana Clearway) Bylaw 2012/1

Pursuant to section 61(3) of the Government Roading Powers Act 1989 and section 22AB(1)(h) and (m) of the Land Transport Act 1998, the NZ Transport Agency (the Agency) hereby makes the following bylaw.

Bylaw

- **1. Title and commencement**—This bylaw may be cited as the New Zealand Transport Agency (Mana Bylaw) 2012/1 and will come into force on 1 March 2012.
- **2. Interpretation**—In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

Agency, Vehicle and **Passenger Service Vehicle** have the same meaning as in section 2(1) of the Land Transport Act 1998.

Clearway has the same meaning as in the TCD Rule.

Emergency vehicle has the same meaning as in clause 1.6 of the Road User Rule.

Enactment includes:

- (a) Acts and Regulations.
- (b) Bylaws.

Erection of prescribed sign includes marking a road or part of a road with any road marking which falls within the definition of "prescribed sign" in this bylaw.

Prescribed sign means any sign or road marking which is authorised under subclause 12.2(3) of the TCD Rule.

Public holiday means a day specified as a public holiday in section 44(1) of the Holidays Act 2003.

Road User Rule means the *Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004.*

TCD Rule means *Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004.*

- **3.** Clearway—Subject to the erection of the prescribed signs, the portion of highway described in:
- (1) Part A of Schedule 1 shall be a clearway from 6.30am until 9.30am, Monday to Friday except public holidays, and from 3.30pm until 6.30pm on Sunday and public holidays.
- (2) Part B of Schedule 1 shall be a clearway from 3.30pm until 6.30pm, Monday to Friday except public holidays, and from 11.30am until 2.30pm on Saturday.
- **4. Stopping, standing or parking of vehicles**—Subject to the erection of the prescribed signs, between the hours specified in subclauses 3(1) and (2) of this bylaw, the stopping, standing or parking of vehicles on the clearways is prohibited, except for emergency vehicles and for passenger service vehicles picking up or setting down passengers at authorised bus stops or parking bays.
- 5. The Agency must mark out lanes and erect signs—The Agency must mark out and indicate a prohibition on stopping by installing "Clearway" signs (with supplementary notices, as appropriate, to define the area and time of application) in accordance with subclause 12.2(3) of the TCD Rule.
- **6. Removal of vehicles by towing**—In addition to the powers conferred on it by any other enactment, the Agency may remove or cause to be removed, any vehicle or thing using the clearway in breach of this bylaw, and the Agency may recover from the person committing the breach any reasonable costs of such removal.
- **7. Offence and penalties**—Without limiting any provision of any other enactment, a person who breaches clause 4 of this bylaw commits an offence and is liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding \$500.00.
- **8. General exceptions**—A person is not in breach of this bylaw if the person proves that any act or omission that would otherwise constitute a breach, took place in circumstances provided for in subclauses 1.8(1), 1.8(3) or 1.8(4) of the Road User Rule.
- **9. Revocation**—The bylaw listed in Schedule 2 of this bylaw is hereby revoked.

- **10. Savings**—Any resolution, approval, permit or other act of authority made pursuant to the bylaw referred to in Schedule 2 remains in force in the area to which it applied on the date of revocation until revoked by the Agency.
- **11. Authority to make bylaw**—This bylaw was made by the Group Manager, Highways and Network Operations, under delegated authority of the Agency.

Pursuant to section 52 of the Racing Act 2003, the New Zealand Racing Board hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the Betting Rules*.

Change #1

Rule 12 CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO FIXED ODDS RACE BETTING is amended as follows:

12.2 Interpretation

"Return Bearing Placings (RBPs)" Like Dividend Bearing Placings for totalisator betting, RBPs are the number of Placings in an option that Returns will be paid on.

Final Field Win betting has one RBP.

Final Field Place betting has two RBPs if there are five, six or seven non scratched Race Entrants at the time that the Final Field Place betting option is opened for betting.

Final Field Place betting has three RBPs if there are eight or more non scratched Race Entrants at the time that the Final Field Place betting option is opened for betting.

Final Field Top Four has four RBPs.

Change #2

Rule 12 CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO FIXED ODDS RACE BETTING is amended as follows:

12.13 Dead Heats

(a) Subject to Rule 12.13(b), in the event of a dead heat between any of the Entrants in a Race on which Final Field and/or Futures Fixed Odds Race Bets have been placed, the amount to be paid to successful bets in respect of such Entrants shall be the Return multiplied by the number of Return Bearing Positions involved in the deadheat divided by the number of Race Entrants involved in the deadheat.

Example: If there is a deadheat for third in a race with three RBPs, then returns on the deadheaters will be multiplied by $\frac{1}{2}$ (1 Return Bearing Position [3rd] / 2 Race Entrants)

If there is a triple deadheat for second in a race with three RBPs then returns on the deadheaters will be multiplied by 2/3 (2 Return Bearing Positions [2nd & 3rd] / 3 Race Entrants)

(b) Where the Board has offered as a separate selection a dead heat between any of the entrants in a Race on which Final Field and/or Futures Fixed Odds Race Bets have been placed, such a dead heat shall be declared the Winning Selection.

Change #3

Appendix 4 FINAL FIELD DEDUCTION FORMULA is amended as follows:

Final Field Deduction Formula

80 divided by the product of the number of RBPs multiplied by the Odds for the Race Entrant at the time it was Scratched from a Race, provided the Odds are less than or equal to Maximum Deduction Odds

 $= 80/(RBPs \times Odds)$

Maximum Deduction Odds shall be \$35.00.

Example: Where a Race Entrant paying \$5.00 to Win and \$1.33 for a place (3 RBPs) is Scratched, the Return on successful Final Field Win Bets placed prior to that Scratching will be subject to a deduction of 16% (80/(1x5)). Successful Final Field Place Bets will be subject to a deduction of 20% (80/(3x1.33)).

These Rules come into force on 3 March 2012.
