##### Notice

1. The Board of Trustees of Te Wharekura o Mauao, Tauranga shall be known as Te Poari o Te Wharekura o Mauao ("Te Poari").

2. The board, hereafter referred to as Te Poari, shall be constituted as follows:

- Up to five whānau (parent) representatives, nominated and elected by the whānau of Te Wharekura o Mauao according to the process outlined in this notice;
- tumuaki (principal) of Te Wharekura o Mauao;
- one kaimahi (staff) representative, nominated and elected by the staff of Te Wharekura o Mauao according to the process outlined in this notice;
- two taura (student) representatives, nominated and elected by students according to the process outlined in this notice; and

(e) up to four co-opted trustees, selected by Te Poari in consultation with whānau, to provide high level skills in selected areas of expertise important to the Wharekura community. These may be, but are not limited to, skills in finance, property, personnel and student achievement.

- The nomination and election of whānau representatives, the kaimahi representative and the taura representatives shall be by way of hui managed by a Returning Officer engaged by Te Poari. This person shall not be considered for selection as a whānau, kaimahi or taura representative and shall not be the tumuaki.
- Except as set out in this notice, the constitution will operate as if sections 92, 96, 97(1), 99, 101, 102, 104 and 105 of the Act apply where relevant. In particular, the definitions of "Board staff" and "parent" in section 92 shall apply in relation to eligibility and voting for whānau representatives and the kaimahi representative.
- Except as set out in this notice, the constitution will operate as if the Regulations made pursuant to section 118 of the Act ("the Election Regulations") applied.
- The Returning Officer will organise nomination hui and election hui for whānau kaimahi and taura representatives as required for triennial elections or any necessary by-elections.
- Nominations must be called for in the same manner as required under the Election Regulations with necessary modification to account for the hui process and inform the relevant voters as to the date and location of the hui. No less than 14 days' notice must be given of the details of any relevant hui.
- Each nomination hui must be held on a date set by the returning officer within the period between four and two weeks before the relevant election date.
- Nominations may be received by the returning officer before the nomination hui, from eligible voters present at the relevant hui, or directly by the returning officer within two working days after the nomination hui. All nominations must be recorded on the nomination forms approved under the Election Regulations.
- An election hui must be held on the relevant election or by-election date. Voting will occur on voting forms approved under the Election Regulations and provided directly to each voter by the returning officer. Voters may collect their voting paper from the returning officer at or after the election hui and be given five calendar days from the date of the hui to cast their vote by returning the supplied voting paper to the returning officer.
- Taura representatives election – the taura council will nominate and elect two representatives for Te Poari. If more than two nominations are received, the returning officer will hold an election hui for the members of the taura council to vote.
- In the event that the taura council ceases to exist or function, the two taura representatives to Te Poari will be elected through a nomination hui and election hui following the same process as described above for whānau and kaimahi representatives. In this situation all students enrolled at the Wharekura (including those in years 7 and 8) will be entitled to vote for the taura representatives.
- The current board shall fix dates for the first nomination and election hui under this constitution between 1 April 2013 and 30 May 2013.
- All current elected, co-opted, appointed and selected trustees on the board of trustees of Te Wharekura o Mauao shall leave office at the end of the day before the

day on which the new elected representatives take office in 2013.

15. The ongoing term of office for the whānau, kaimahi and taurira representatives will follow the regular cycle set out in the Act.
16. The returning officer will not be eligible for election to Te Poari, and must not be a current Te Poari member or the tumuaki of the wharekura. The returning officer must have the trust of the wharekura community. The current Te Poari will engage the returning officer.

3. **Appointment of Poutiriao**—I confirm, under Regulation 9(1) of Te Arawa Lakes (Fisheries) Regulations 2006, the appointment of John Ransfield and John Waaka

as Poutiriao to manage customary food-gathering within Te Arawa fisheries area from **24 June 2013**. The appointments will expire on **14 September 2013**.

**4. Komiti Whakahaere membership**—The Poutiriao (John Ransfield and John Waaka) become members of the Komiti Whakahaere.

**5. ## Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003

### Variable Speed Limit at Rural Schools (Turning Vehicle Hazard) Notice No. 3

Pursuant to clause 6.1 of Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003 and a delegation from the NZ Transport Agency, I, Glenn Bunting, Network Manager, approve a variable speed limit at the schools listed in the Schedule, where there is a turning vehicle hazard, in accordance with the conditions set out in this notice:

**Conditions****1. Variable speed limit**

A road controlling authority may set a variable speed limit of 60km/h or 70km/h, as specified in the Schedule, to manage the hazard caused by turning vehicles at the schools listed in the Schedule.

**2. Length of variable speed limit**

The variable speed limit on the main road on which the school is located must be a minimum length of 300 metres, unless this condition is impractical, but should not be longer than 500 metres. The length of variable speed limit on side roads may be shorter than 300 metres.

**3. Periods of operation**

The 60km/h or 70km/h speed limit may operate for a maximum period of:

- 35 minutes before the start of school, until the start of school; and
- 20 minutes at the end of school, beginning no earlier than 5 minutes before the end of school; and
- 10 minutes at any time when vehicles are entering or leaving the school grounds or there is pedestrian or cycle activity on the road outside the school, at schools where all approaches to the variable speed limit are controlled by "Variable speed limit (rural schools turning vehicle hazard)" signs.

**4. Signs**

- Signs that comply with the "Rural Schools Variable Speed Limit (Turning Vehicle Hazard) Trial" notice published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 17 May 2012, No. 55, page 1606, must be installed on every approach to a variable speed limit at a school listed in the Schedule as follows:
  - At least one "Variable speed limit (rural schools turning vehicle hazard)" sign on each approach to the variable speed limit on the main road outside the school and on each approach on a major side road that intersects with the road controlled with a variable speed limit; and

(ii) at least one “Variable speed limit – fixed (rural schools turning vehicle hazard)” sign on each approach on a minor side road that intersects with the road controlled with a variable speed limit.

(b) R1-1, R1-1.1 or R1-3 signs that comply with Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004 must be installed at the end of the variable speed limit on every road that leaves the variable speed limit.

### 5. Bylaw

A road controlling authority must set a variable speed limit for a school listed in the Schedule by making a bylaw in accordance with Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003.

### 6. Savings

A variable speed limit that was set in accordance with the “Variable Speed Limit at Rural Schools (Turning Vehicle Hazard)” notice published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 17 May 2012, No. 55, page 1605 (as amended<sup>1</sup>) remains in force until it is replaced by the variable speed limit specified in the Schedule in this notice.

### 7. Revocation

The “Variable Speed Limit at Rural Schools (Turning Vehicle Hazard)” notice, published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 17 May 2012, No. 55, page 1605, is revoked.
