Rural Intersection Active Warning System Variable Speed Limit—State Highway 2, East Taratahi Road, Wiltons Road Intersections

Pursuant to clause 6.1 of Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003 and clause 4.4(4) of Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004 and delegations from the NZ Transport Agency, I, Glenn Bunting, Network Manager, approve a rural intersection active warning system variable speed limit on State Highway 2 at the East Taratahi Road and Wiltons Road intersections, in accordance with the conditions set out in this notice.

Conditions

1. Variable Speed Limit

The NZ Transport Agency (Highways and Network Operations Group) may set a variable speed limit of 70km/h on State Highway 2, at the intersections with East Taratahi Road and Wiltons Road, to manage the safety of traffic when vehicles are crossing or turning at the intersections.

2. Operation of the Variable Speed Limit

The variable speed limit, which must be displayed on variable speed limit signs, may operate when a vehicle is detected approaching the intersections on the side road or turning right on State Highway 2 and may continue to operate until those vehicles have cleared the intersections. When the variable speed limit is not operating, the variable speed limit signs must either display the permanent speed limit or be blank.

3. Signs

Speed limit signs that comply with Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004 must be installed to identify the section of road subject to the variable speed limit as follows:

- at least one R1-2.1 "Variable speed" sign installed above a W11 intersection warning sign, at the beginning of the variable speed limit on State Highway 2, facing road users approaching the intersections with East Taratahi Road and Wiltons Road; and
- R1-1 "Standard", R1-1.1 "100km/h" or R1-3 "Derestriction" signs at the end of the variable speed limit, facing road users on each road that leaves the intersections, to indicate the permanent speed limit that applies beyond that point.

4. Length of Variable Speed Limit

The variable speed limit on State Highway 2 must be a minimum length of 300 metres, but must not be longer than 500 metres.

5. Bylaw

The NZ Transport Agency (Highways and Network Operations Group) must set the variable speed limit by making a bylaw in accordance with Land Transport Rule: Setting of Speed Limits 2003.

Fisheries (Declaration of Toka Tāmure Mātaitai Reserve Bylaws) Notice 2016 (Notice No. MPI 599)

Pursuant to Regulations 28 and 29 of the Fisheries (Kaimoana Customary Fishing) Regulations 1998, the Minister for Primary Industries hereby gives the following notice:

Notice

1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Fisheries (Declaration of Toka Tāmure Mātaitai Reserve Bylaws) Notice 2016.

2. Commencement—The bylaw comes into effect 28 days after the date of its notification in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

3. Interpretation—In this notice:

- a. The term **Toka Tāmure Mātaitai Reserve** means that mātaitai reserve at Mahia Peninsula notified in the Fisheries (Declaration and Notification of Toka Tamure Mātaitai Reserve and Appointment of Tangata Kaitiaki/Tiaki) Notice 2012 ([New Zealand Gazette, 16 August 2012, No. 98, page 2736](#)).

A person must not, on any day between 1 August and 29 February of any year, take more than 25 kina from Toka Tāmure Mātaitai Reserve.

Bylaw 4 — Prohibition on taking kina during closed season

A person must not, on any day between 1 March and 31 July of any year, take any kina from Toka Tāmure Mātaitai Reserve.

Bylaw 5 — Prohibition on using underwater breathing apparatus

A person must not use an underwater breathing apparatus to take fish, shellfish or seaweed from Toka Tāmure Mātaitai Reserve.

Bylaw 6 — Prohibition on using loops

A person must not use a loop to take spiny rock lobster from Toka Tāmure Mātaitai Reserve.

Notice is hereby given, pursuant to the Airport Authorities Act 1966 (“Act”), to advise all aircraft operators and users of Ardmore Airport that the fourth increment of the five-yearly annual increase for facility fees, night flying fees and parking fees is to take effect **1 April 2016**, being a 5% annual increase.

Additionally, Ardmore Airport notifies that future increases in facility fees, night flying fees and parking fees for the final year, as publicly advised on 30 March 2013, are as follows:

- A 5% per annum increase for each successive 12-month period commencing on 1 April 2017 and ending on 31 March 2018.

NIGHT FLYING	In addition to the above fees, “night flying” fees are applicable to both fixed wing and helicopter aircraft as follows: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. \$6.48 per night landing;2. \$0.88 per night touch and go (fixed wing aircraft only). <i>Note:</i> For administration purposes “night flying” is deemed to be any movement conducted after civil twilight. Special conditions may apply to non-resident operators. Contact Ardmore Airport Limited for more information.
APPLICATION	The facility fee covers the use of runways, taxiways and apron areas with the exception that the flat rate for helicopters applies to all helicopters that access, for the purposes of facilitating a landing, any area of land designated as “airport land” by Ardmore Airport Limited (whether it be operational, non-operational or leased land and includes the airspace associated with that designation).

PARKING

This covers aircraft parked on aprons, airport operational area and non-leased sites:

- A. Parking up to two hours - no fee.
- B. Parking in excess of two hours - \$15.74 for every 24-hour period or part period from time of landing. Parking usage will be determined by Ardmore Airport Limited.

GENERAL

- A. MCTOW means maximum certified takeoff weight in kilograms.
- B. All fees are subject to Goods and Services Tax.
- C. All fees are payable by the 20th of the month following landing.

Fees will be invoiced to and payable by the registered owner of the aircraft as per the Civil Aviation Authority Register of Aircraft unless, with the prior written approval of Ardmore Airport Limited, another party has agreed to be liable for payment (but nevertheless without limiting the liability of the registered owner).
- E. A late payment penalty may be imposed on any fees which remain outstanding at the end of the month in which payment is due. Such penalty shall be 15% per annum on the amount outstanding calculated on a daily basis from the date on which payment was due until the date of actual payment, but with a minimum of \$10.00.
- F. The registered owner of the aircraft grants a security interest to Ardmore Airport Limited as security for payment of all fees and charges due to it from time to time and for the performance by the registered owner of the aircraft of that owner's other obligations to Ardmore Airport from time to time. For the purposes of section 36(1)(b) of the Personal Property Securities Act 1999 (PPSA), and to ensure maximum benefit and protection for Ardmore Airport Limited by virtue of section 36(1)(b)(iii) of the PPSA, the registered owner of the aircraft confirms, by using the airport land, such registered owner intends to and does grant to Ardmore Airport Limited as security for the registered owner's indebtedness and obligations, a security interest in all of the registered owner's present and after-acquired property including the relevant aircraft. The registered owner waives the right to receive a copy of the verification statement confirming registration of a financing statement or financing change statement relating to the security interest so granted. Each registered owner agrees that nothing in sections 114(1)(a), 133 and 134 of the PPSA shall apply to the security and waives the owner's rights under sections 121 and 132 of the PPSA.
- G. Ardmore has the right to remove any aircraft parked on aprons, airport operational area and non-leased sites for any period longer than seven days continuously. The registered owner of the aircraft will meet all costs of removal and any future storage of the aircraft. Ardmore Airport Limited accepts no liability for any loss or damage caused as a result of such removal, even if Ardmore Airport Limited has been notified of the likelihood of such loss or damage.
- H. Where an aircraft owner fails to meet any payment due on due date and Ardmore Airport Limited incurs costs of recovering any amount payable, the aircraft owner shall meet such costs including without limitation, any debt collection or enforcement charges and legal costs on a solicitor and client basis.
- I. The charges are set in accordance with section 4(2) of the Act and may be varied from time to time.
- J. Ardmore Airport Leaseholders will qualify for an annual credit of \$200.00 for facility fees. Contact Ardmore Airport Limited for more information.
