Order

1. Title—This order is the National Water Conservation (Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere) Amendment Order 2011¹.

- **2. Commencement**—This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *New Zealand Gazette*.
- **3. Principal order amended**—This order amends the National Water Conservation (Lake Ellesmere) Order 1990².
- **4. References to Lake Ellesmere**—The title and the entire order is amended by omitting every reference to "Lake Ellesmere" and substituting "Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere".
- **5. Interpretation**—The following definitions are amended in Clause 2 Interpretation:

The definition of "Act" is amended by substituting the words "Water and Soil Conservation Act 1967" with "Resource Management Act 1991".

The definition of "Lake Ellesmere" is omitted and substituted with:

"Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere means that variable body of water commonly known as Lake Ellesmere, otherwise known as Te Waihora, located at and about map reference Infomap 242–3 170°20′, 43°4′, and having an area of about 20,000 hectares."

The definition of "lake level" is omitted and substituted with:

"lake level means the water level measured in calm conditions as determined by taking the mean average of the level recorded by the Canterbury Regional Council at its water level recorder at or about Nutts Cut (map reference NZTopo50 BX24: 682 557) and either one of the levels recorded by the Canterbury Regional Council at its manual or telemetered records at or about Taumutu (map reference NZTopo50 BY23: 498 443 or NZTopo50 BY23: 499 448):

provided that the Canterbury Regional Council may, at its discretion and when necessary due to windy conditions, estimate the reading which would have been obtained in calm conditions."

The definition of "m.a.s.l" is omitted and substituted with "m.s.l. means the elevation in metres above 1937 Lyttelton vertical datum."

6. Outstanding features—Clause 3 is omitted and substituted with the following clause:

Outstanding features

It is hereby declared that Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere has or contributes to the following outstanding amenity or intrinsic values which warrant protection:

- (a) habitat for wildlife, indigenous wetland vegetation and fish; and
- (b) significance in accordance with tikanga Māori in respect of Ngāi Tahu history, mahinga kai and customary fisheries."
- **7. Restrictions on lake openings and closings**—Clause 4 is amended as follows:
 - (1) Clause 4(1) is amended by omitting "a water right shall not be granted under section 21 of the Act and a general authorisation shall not be made under section 22 of the Act" and substituting "a resource consent shall not be granted under sections 9, 12 and 14 of the Act".
 - (2) Clause 4(2) is amended by omitting "water right may be so granted" and substituting "resource consent may be so granted".
 - (3) Clause 4(2) is amended by inserting the following paragraph as paragraph (c):
 - "(c) To allow the lake to be artificially opened to the sea at any time during the period commencing on the 1st day of April and ending with the 15th day of June next following."

- (4) Clause 4(2)(c) is amended by renumbering paragraph "(c)" as paragraph "(d)".
- **8.** Right to dam or to drain land not to be granted—Clause 5 is amended as follows:
 - (1) Clause 5(1) is amended by omitting "a water right shall not be granted under section 21 of the Act and a general authorisation shall not be made under section 22 of the Act" and substituting "a resource consent shall not be granted under sections 9, 13 and 14 of the Act".
 - (2) Clause 5(1) is amended by omitting "1.13m.a.s.l." and substituting "1.20m.s.l.".
 - (3) Clauses 5(2) to (4) are amended by omitting "water right" and substituting "resource consent".
- **9. Restriction on grant of resource consents**—Clause 6 is amended as follows:
 - (1) Clause 6(1) is amended by omitting "a water right shall not be granted under section 21 of the Act and a general authorisation shall not be made under section 22 of the Act" and substituting "a resource consent shall not be granted under sections 9, 12, 13 and 14 of the Act".
 - (2) Clause 6(2) is omitted and substituted with the following subclause:
 - "(2) Notwithstanding anything in this order, it shall be lawful for a resource consent to be so granted for research into and enhancement of, habitat for wildlife, indigenous wetland vegetation and fish, and significance in accordance with tikanga Māori in respect of Ngāi Tahu history, mahinga kai and customary fisheries."

- **10. Scope of this order**—Clause 7 is amended by omitting "the second proviso to section 21(1) of the Act" and substituting "sections 14(3)(b) and (e) of the Act".
- **11. Explanatory Note**—The explanatory note is omitted and substituted with the following explanatory note:

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order declares that Te Waihora / Lake Ellesmere provides or contributes to an outstanding habitat for wildlife, indigenous wetland vegetation and fish, and significance in accordance with tikanga Māori in respect of Ngāi Tahu history, mahinga kai and customary fisheries.

- (b) For the purposes of the rates set and assessed for the 2011/12 financial year in that part of Waikato District that was formerly part of Franklin District, the financial impact statement included in the Waikato District Council's annual plan for 2011/12:
 - (i) may be set in accordance with the relevant parts of Franklin District Council's Long Term Council Community Plan for 2009–19; and
 - (ii) may provide for those rates to differ from rates set and assessed in other parts of Waikato District.
- (2) The rates referred to in subclause (1) may be set at an amount that reflects the change in the rate of goods and services tax on 1 October 2010.
- (3) In subclause (1) the term "rates" includes:
 - (a) a general rate, including any general rate set differentially;

- Only authorised commercial vessels, or other vessels authorised by the Harbourmaster, may enter the Auckland ferry terminal basin between Princes Wharf and Queens Wharf, and extending 50 metres north from the northern end of each wharf.
- 3. The Auckland Harbourmaster's Direction 3-07, which applies to the Auckland ferry terminal basin (or Down Town ferry terminal basin), applies at all times.

- No vessel may enter the naval defence area at Devonport, as identified in Auckland Harbour Chart NZ5322, unless authorised by the Royal New Zealand Navy.

- 6. No vessel under 500 gross tonnes may impede the navigation of any vessel over 500 gross tonnes.

- 7. No vessel is to approach, or remain, within 50 metres of any vessel over 500 tonnes which is moored or not underway at any time.
- 8. No person may jump, dive or swim from any wharf or structure within the permit area, unless the person has been authorised by the Harbourmaster or a member of the Police holding the powers of a constable.

Additional Restrictions

All vessels must comply with any temporary restrictions or directions issued by the Auckland Harbourmaster.

Temporary restrictions or directions will be broadcast on VHF channel 12 as soon as practicable after the restriction or direction is issued, and every hour at approximately 15 minutes past the hour while it is in force.

In addition, advice to vessels to listen to these broadcasts will be transmitted on VHF channel 16.

Hours of Operation

The declaration will apply 24 hours per day for the entire period from 1 September 2011 to 31 October 2011 inclusive.

Means of Enforcement

Compliance with the above conditions and requirements will be enforced by appointed enforcement officers, as defined in section 200B(6) of the Maritime Transport Act 1994.

Commerce Commission ("Commission") standard terms determinations, under section 30M of the Telecommunications Act 2001 ("the Act"), in respect of the designated access services of:

The Commission is required to give public notice of the commencement of the review described above under section 30R(5)(b).

On 7 July 2011, the Commission gave public notice that it had commenced a review of the pricing set out in Decisions 609, 611 and 672 for the purpose of implementing clause 4A of subpart 1 of Part 1 of Schedule 1 of the Act ("clause 4A review").

The Commission gives public notice that it has commenced another review of Decisions 609, 611 and 672 under section 30R of the Act ("benchmarking review") that will include:

- updating the benchmark data set used in Decision 609 to determine the monthly UCLL prices and UCLL connection charges.
- updating prices under Decisions 609, 611 and 672 that are affected by the UCLL benchmark data update.

The Commission is also required to include in the notice the closing day for submissions.

The Commission intends to release a draft decision covering both the clause 4A review and the benchmarking review in relation to Decisions 609 and 611 in late August 2011.

A separate decision will be released at a later date reagrding the clause 4A and benchmarking reviews in relation to Decision 672.

This separate decision will still fall within the scope of the clause 4A review and the benchmarking review.

- (c) a person who is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts under the Act; or
- (d) a person authorised in another jurisdiction by the competent authority of that jurisdiction to deal in futures contracts; or
- (e) Her Majesty The Queen in right of New Zealand, a Crown entity named in the Crown Entities Act 2004, or a State enterprise named in the First or Second Schedule to the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 (each as amended from time to time); or
- (f) a person who is a statutory corporation or a registered bank; or
- (g) a person whose principal business is the investment of money or who, in the course of and for the purposes of their business, habitually invests money; or
- (h) a person who is a related body corporate of any of the persons mentioned in subparagraphs (a) to (g) above.
- (2) Any term or expression that is defined in the Act and used, but not defined, in this notice has the same meaning as in the Act
- **3. Authorisation**—(1) Subject to clause 3(2), the Company is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts generally.
- (2) The authorisation applies only to dealing in futures contracts that consists of advising or assisting a person in connection with the acquisition or disposal of a futures contract.
- (3) The authorisation is subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) the Company does not hold client money or client property in connection with dealing in futures contracts; and
 - (b) the Company does not carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts on behalf of any person other than one who has entered into a written contract for services with the Company, and then only in accordance with the terms of that contract; and
 - (c) the Company deals only on behalf of its wholesale clients; and
 - (d) before dealing in any futures contract in respect of which the authorisation applies, the Company is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the wholesale client is contracting:
 - (i) as principal on its own account; or
 - (ii) on behalf of a related body corporate; or
 - (iii) as trustee of a trust or manager of a managed fund; and
 - (e) in respect of any futures contract that is made on or effected through a recognised exchange, any acquisition or disposal of the contract is effected through a person who is an authorised participant or member of the recognised exchange and who is authorised or licensed by the laws of the country in which it operates to deal in futures contracts on behalf of that person and to hold client money for that purpose; and
 - (f) the Company provides the Financial Markets Authority with a copy of the Company's audited financial statements no later than three months after the end of each financial year for the Company; and

Disease prevention and oral health promotion and maintenance are core activities.

Pursuant to section 52 of the Racing Act 2003, the New Zealand Racing Board hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the Betting Rules*.

Change #1

Rule 7 RULES FOR ESTABLISHING AND OPERATING A BETTING ACCOUNT is amended as follows:

7.2 Establishing a Betting Account

(d) The application to open a Betting Account must be accompanied by a deposit of the amount detailed in the Terms and Conditions schedule as amended from time to time.

Change #2

Rule 7 RULES FOR ESTABLISHING AND OPERATING A BETTING ACCOUNT is amended as follows:

7.4 Deposit of funds to a Betting Account

(d) A depositor must produce Identification before depositing cash into a Betting Account of the threshold amount detailed in the Terms and Conditions schedule as amended from time to time. Should the deposit be made on behalf of another party or parties, the Board's agent at the Totalisator Agency must obtain and record the Identification of the depositor before the deposit can be made.

Change #3

Rule 8 RULES RELATING TO INTERNET INVESTMENTS is amended as follows:

8.2 Establishment of an Account via the Internet

Investors who wish to place bets via the internet:

- (a) Must be 18 years of age or older and must have their identity and age verified by the Board. The acceptable methods of verification by the Board of age and identity are specified in APPENDIX 2; and
- (b) May establish an account by depositing clear funds at the amounts detailed in the Terms and Conditions schedule as amended from time to time.

The Board may (but will not be obliged to) accept bets as soon as an account has been established via the internet. Similarly, the Board may (but will not be obliged to) accept bets while this account remains in credit. However, the Board will not permit withdrawals to be made from this account until the Account Holder's age and identity have been verified in accordance with the procedure described in APPENDIX 2.

If an Account Holder's age and identity have not been verified by the Board within the number of days detailed in the Terms and Conditions schedule as amended from time to time after establishment of their account, then the Board will be entitled to suspend operation of that account until such verification has been received by the Board.

Existing Account Holders may, at the discretion of the Board, use their existing account to place bets via the internet. To the extent that these existing customers place bets via the internet, they will be bound by Rule 8 RULES RELATING TO INTERNET INVESTMENTS.

Change #4

Rule 8 RULES RELATING TO INTERNET INVESTMENTS is amended as follows:

8.4 Administration

The Board may charge an account administration fee for internet transactions. The transaction types, criteria and fees charged are detailed in the Terms and Conditions schedule as amended from time to time.

Change #5

APPENDIX 2 is amended as follows:

APPENDIX 2

Identification process for Betting Account established through internet

After completing the required application form for a new Betting Account, internet users MUST provide verification of identity, this may be by means of documentary or other evidence that is capable of identifying the customer. The accepted means of Identification are certified copies of a:

- Passport
- Driver's licence

A copy of the relevant page or pages of the above that contain the personal details, photograph and signature of the account applicant will be required. These must be endorsed by a reputable and identifiable person such as a:

- Notary public
- Lawyer
- Doctor in private practice
- Justice of the peace
- Government official

Please ensure that the endorsement is either stamped or a phone number provided by the verifier. (Please note that existing phonebetting Account Holders who enable their existing phone account for internet access do not need to send any identification.)

Note that the above form of identification can be presented at a Totalisator Agency in New Zealand for verification of identity and signature, in which case the TAB representative will send the verification documents to Account Betting Customer Services.

This record will be used as signature identification and age verification. If verification of the identity of the Account Holder is not received within 30 days of opening, the account may be "frozen" and may not be accessible until such time as this is received. Please note that withdrawals can NOT be made from accounts until this documentation has been received.

Acceptable forms of identification for Betting Accounts established through retail network

An application for a Betting Account made through the Board's retail network must be accompanied by identification that includes a photograph, specimen signature and proof of age. Acceptable forms of identification are:

- Passport
- Driver's licence
- HANZ 18+ Card
