Any person wishing to lodge an objection should do so in writing, to the New Zealand Customs Service, Attn: Valuation, Origin and Classification section, PO Box 29, Shortland Street, Auckland 1140. Email: voc@customs.govt.nz, before 15 November 2016. All submissions should include:
  - a. the Tariff Concession (Advertisement) Notice number;
  - b. the Tariff item; and
  - c. reference number.
- 2. All submissions from local New Zealand manufacturers should include:
  - a. the range of suitable alternative goods made locally in New Zealand;
  - b. the grounds on which objection is made (including reasons why the locally produced or manufactured good is a suitable alternative);
  - c. present and potential output;
  - d. details of factory cost in terms of materials, labour, overheads, including the proportion of domestic and imported content.
- 3. Where further information is required in order to make a submission an objector should contact the applicant in writing and refer a copy of the enquiry to the New Zealand Customs Service quoting the details in paragraph 1 above.
