If Transmitter Power Control is not in use, then the maximum permitted mean power shall be reduced by 3 dB.

In the band 57 to 64 GHz, the average power density of any emission, measured during the transmit interval, shall not exceed -40 dBW/cm² (9 μ W/cm²) at a distance of 3 metres and the peak power density of any emission shall not exceed -37 dBW/cm² (18 μ W/cm²) at a distance of 3 metres. In the band 57 to 64 GHz, the peak total transmitter power shall not exceed -3 dBW (500 mW). In the band 57 to 64 GHz, for emissions of bandwidths less than 100 MHz, the transmitter peak power must be limited to -3 dBW (500 mW) x (bandwidth (MHz) / 100 (MHz)).

20. In the bands 3.64 to 4.04 MHz and 10.44 to 10.76 MHz, the maximum permitted field strength is $-40 \text{ dB}\mu\text{A/m}$ measured in a 10 kHz bandwidth at 10 metres.
21. In the band 3.18 to 3.38 MHz, the maximum permitted field strength is $-20 \text{ dB}\mu\text{A/m}$ measured in a 10 kHz bandwidth at a distance of 10 metres.
22. Indoor-Only Systems: In the band 57000 to 66000 MHz, the power spectral density must not exceed 13 dBm/MHz e.i.r.p. and spurious emissions outside the band must be less than -30 dBm/MHz .

Except where condition 24 applies, transmissions from devices operating in the band 921 to 928 MHz must not exceed the following unwanted emission limits: -79 dBW (-49 dBm) from 800 to 915 MHz, then varying from -79 dBW (-49 dBm) at 915 MHz to -66 dBW (-36 dBm) at 921 MHz in accordance with the formula $y = mx + C$, where—, $y = \text{dBm}$, $x = \text{MHz}$, $m = dy/dx$, $C = \text{the value of } y \text{ where } x = 0 \text{ (the } y \text{ intercept)}$. Outside the band 800 MHz to 1 GHz, the limits prescribed in applicable standards prescribed in the Radiocommunications (Radio Standards) Notice 2010* apply. In the absence of applicable standards, the limits prescribed in Table 2 of the notice apply.

 - 1) This condition applies where, in the course of business, any person manages a network consisting of five or more devices that transmit in the band 921 to 928 MHz.
 - 2) Where this condition applies:
 - a. The number of simultaneous transmissions in any single square kilometre within the area covered by the network must not exceed 35 on average over any five-minute period; and
 - b. The unwanted emission limits for the devices, using a reference bandwidth of 100 kHz, must not exceed:
 - (i) -70 dBW (-40 dBm) from 800 MHz to 915 MHz;
 - (ii) -56 dBW (-26 dBm) from 915 MHz to 921 MHz;
 - (iii) -56 dBW (-26 dBm) from 928 MHz to 935 MHz;
 - (iv) -63 dBW (-33 dBm) from 935 MHz to 1 GHz; or
 - (v) Outside the band 800 MHz to 1 GHz, the unwanted emission limits specified in Table 2 of the Radiocommunications (Radio Standards) Notice 2010.
25. In the band 0.009000 to 0.090000 MHz, the magnetic field strength from devices must not exceed $72 \text{ dB}\mu\text{A/m}$ at a distance of 10 metres. In the band 0.090000 to 0.190000 MHz, the magnetic field strength from devices must not exceed $43 \text{ dB}\mu\text{A/m}$ at a distance of 10 metres, except in the band 0.119000 to 0.135000 MHz, where the magnetic field strength from devices must not exceed $66 \text{ dB}\mu\text{A/m}$ at a distance of 10 metres.
26. Use is limited to the purpose known as radio microphones (also known as wireless microphones, in ear monitors or wireless audio transmitters). Analogue modulation schemes are permitted with a maximum necessary bandwidth of 300 kHz. Digital modulation schemes are permitted with a maximum necessary bandwidth of 200 kHz. Use of a power level above -20 dBW is only permitted when the user has first determined that the intended use will not affect the reception of television broadcasts in or adjacent to the proposed area of operation.

6. General conditions applying to all transmissions under this licence—

1. The frequency ranges, peak power of transmissions within those frequency ranges, and designated uses of frequencies are those prescribed in this licence. All transmissions in a given frequency range must comply with any special conditions relating to that frequency range.
2. Transmitters, and persons supplying or using transmitters, must comply with the requirements of Regulations 32 to 37 of the Radiocommunications Regulations 2001.
3. Frequency use is on a shared basis and the chief executive does not accept liability under any circumstances for any loss or damage of any kind occasioned by the unavailability of frequencies or interference to reception.
4. Should interference occur to services licensed pursuant to a radio licence or a spectrum licence, the chief executive reserves the right to require and ensure that any transmission or any emission pursuant to this General User Radio Licence change frequency, reduce power, or cease operation.
5. Transmissions that are broadcasting, as defined in the Broadcasting Act 1989, are not permitted.

7. Consequential revocation of licence—(1) The Radiocommunications Regulations (General User Radio Licence for Short Range Devices) Notice (No. 2) 2012, dated the 28th day of May 2012 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 31 May 2012, No. 61, page 1751, is revoked.

(2) Notwithstanding the revocation of the notice under subsection (1), every transmitter capable of making transmissions compliant with the requirements of that notice on the commencement date of this notice is deemed to be compliant with the requirements of this notice.

Biosecurity Act 1993

Controlled Area Notice in Respect of *Echinococcus granulosus* (Hydatids) (Notice No. MPI 294)

1. Revocation—The “Controlled Area Notice in Respect of *Echinococcus granulosus* (Hydatids) (Notice No. 1682)” notice, dated the 5th day of May 2010 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 13 May 2010, No. 55, page 1520, is revoked.

livestock means animals kept for use or profit and includes, but is not limited to, sheep, goats, cattle, deer, horses, llamas and alpacas.

offal means all internal organs including, but not limited to, liver and lungs.

treated means either:

- (a) boiled for a minimum of 30 minutes; or
- (b) frozen to minus 10 degrees Celsius, or colder, and maintained at that temperature for at least 10 days.

untreated offal means offal that has not been treated.

4. Declaration of a Controlled Area—Pursuant to section 131(2) of the Act, I declare the whole of New Zealand to be a controlled area to enable the limitation of the spread of true hydatids (*Echinococcus granulosus*), being an unwanted organism under the Act.

5. Notice of Controls—Under section 131(3)(b) of the Act, I give notice of the following matters.

Within the controlled area:

- (a) a person being the owner of, or in charge of, a dog must control their dog at all times in such a manner as to prevent it from having access to untreated offal (unless the untreated offal is derived from livestock slaughtered by a processor operating a risk management programme registered under the Animal Products Act 1999);
- (b) offal derived from livestock must not be fed to dogs unless it has been either:
 - (i) treated; or
 - (ii) slaughtered by a processor operating a risk management programme registered under the Animal Products Act 1999.
- (c) occupiers of land must dispose of, as soon as possible, dead livestock in a manner that prevents it from being accessed by dogs, including stray dogs.

- (c) following the line of the MHW within the estuarine waters of Aotea Harbour to the northern harbour entrance at Potahi Point; then

(2) On 15 November 2013, the Minister for Primary Industries appointed, under Regulation 22(3) of the Fisheries (South Island Customary Fishing) Regulations 1999, Henry Couch as a Tangata Tiaki/Kaitiaki for managing customary food-gathering in the mātaimai reserve, a traditional fishing-ground enclosed by a line that:

- (a) commences at the mean high-water mark (MHWM) in line with the Cass Bay-Church Reserve boundary (at 43°36.56'S and 172°41.24'E); then
- (b) proceeds in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to a point offshore from Windy Point (at 43°36.82'S and 172°40.34'E); then
- (c) proceeds in a straight line in a south-westerly direction to a point on the MHWM in line with the 1C Taukahara boundary (at 43°36.84'S and 172°40.14'E); then
- (d) proceeds along the MHWM in a generally north-easterly direction to the point of commencement.

- (iii) otherwise than at call.

(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

3. Rates of Common Fund interest—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.

This notice will take effect on **20 December 2013**.

Amendments to Betting Rules

Pursuant to section 52 of the Racing Act 2003, the New Zealand Racing Board hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the Betting Rules published as a Supplement to the *New Zealand Gazette*, 25 August 2003, No. 113, page 2981.

Change #1

Please delete the information from “15.26 Swimming” to “15.29 Yachting” and replace with the following:

“15.26 **Surfing**

- (a) All bets stand regardless of any postponement provided the event starts within 3 days of the scheduled start time.
- (b) All bets stand regardless of any change of venue.
- (c) Results will be determined by Podium Placing and will not take into account any subsequent disqualifications or changes.

15.27 Swimming

Bets will be Settled on the Podium Placing regardless of any subsequent disqualifications.

15.28 Tennis

- (a) A tennis match is deemed to have started with the first serve of the match. For head to head betting including in-play betting, if one player Withdraws or is disqualified and the match has already started, the player progressing to the next round will be deemed the winner.
- (b) If the match has not started, all bets will be Void.
- (c) In the event that there is no next round, for example in round robin and Davis Cup events, when a player Withdraws or is disqualified and the match has already started, their opponent will be deemed to be the winner.
- (d) In the event of a change to playing surface, venue or change from indoor to outdoor and vice versa, before or during a match or tournament, all bets stand for match and tournament betting.
- (e) When a match is reduced from five sets to three sets, then head to head betting will stand but all other bets will be Void unless the result has already been determined. When a match is reduced from three sets to one set, then head to head betting is Void. All other bets are also Void unless the result has already been determined.
- (f) For sets betting, the match must be completed for bets to stand. If a player Withdraws for any reason before the required sets are completed, then all bets will be Void. If the number of sets change, all bets are Void.
- (g) For first and second set winner, handicap betting, set scores and all totals betting including total games, total sets and total aces, if the match is not completed all bets will be Void unless the result has already been determined.
- (h) For outright tournament betting, bets will be Void if a player does not take part in any match. If a player has started the tournament, then Withdraws for any reason, bets on that player will be losers.
- (i) For game betting, if a game is completed after an interruption or played in subsequent days, all bets will stand for that game. If a game is completed by the awarding of a penalty point by the umpire, the game shall be deemed to be complete. However, if a game is completed by the awarding of a penalty game by the umpire, all bets shall be Void. If a player retires from a match while a game is in progress, but before that game has been completed, that game shall be deemed to be incomplete and all bets Void. If a particular game is not played because a set has already been completed, all bets are Void. A tiebreaker is not recognised as a game.
- (j) The above Rules also apply to doubles and team events.

15.29 Triathlon

Results will be determined by Podium Placing.

15.30 Yachting

When a race is postponed by more than 12 hours (for any reason), all bets will be Void.”

These Rules come into force on **1 December 2013**.
