## TARIFF CONCESSION APPROVALS, WITHDRAWALS AND DECLINES NOTICE (NO. 1) 2014

I, Allwyn John Netto, Chief Customs Officer, New Zealand Customs Service, acting pursuant to section 8 of the Tariff Act 1988 under delegated authority hereby:

- (a) In accordance with Part II of the Tariff approve in respect of the entry of goods listed in the First Schedule to this notice the rates of duty or exemptions from duty specified in that Schedule with effect from the first day of the month so specified
- (b) In accordance with Part II of the Tariff approve in respect of the entry of goods listed in the Second Schedule to this notice the exemptions from duty specified in that Schedule with effect from the first day of the month so specified subject however to such purposes and conditions which I prescribe
- (c) Withdraw with effect fourteen days from the date of this Gazette, or otherwise at the date so specified, the approvals granted in respect of the entry of goods listed in the Third Schedule to this notice.

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### Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

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#### **Termination of Dumping Investigation: Diaries From the Republic of Korea**

Notice is hereby given that, acting pursuant to section 11(1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 ("the Act"), I have terminated a dumping investigation in respect of diaries from the Republic of Korea, as described in the Notice of Initiation of Dumping Investigation dated the 11th day of June 2013 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 20 June 2013, No. 78, page 2135, imported or intended to be imported into New Zealand.

I have terminated the investigation because I am satisfied, in terms of section 11(1)(b) of the Act, that there is insufficient evidence that material injury to a New Zealand industry has been or is being caused or is threatened by means of the dumping of the goods.
