Requirements for Building Consent Accreditation Body

- 1. Pursuant to section 249 of the Building Act 2004 ("the Act"), the Chief Executive of the Department of Building and Housing ("the department") hereby gives notice of requirements for the building consent accreditation body appointed under section 248 of the Act.

Minimum frequency of audits

- 3. Subject to paragraph 4 of this notice, the minimum frequency of audits that the building consent accreditation body must conduct on accredited building consent authorities must be not less than one full technical reassessment audit of each building consent authority every two years.
- 4. The next full technical reassessment audit of the Christchurch City Council ("the council") by the building consent accreditation body is delayed until September 2012. After the 2012 audit of the council, full technical reassessment audits of the council must continue to be carried out not less than once every two years in accordance with paragraph 3.

Other matters

- 5. The building consent accreditation body shall enter into and maintain an agreement with the department in respect of its appointment under section 248 of the Act.
- 6. The building consent accreditation body shall:

Conduct of audits

- (a) undertake special assessment audits of building consent authorities for the building consent accreditation body's own assurance purposes, or upon a written request from the department or from the building consent authority itself;
- (b) with specific reference to prescribed standards and criteria for accreditation, undertake all audits generally in accordance with ISO/IEC 17011:2004 General requirements for bodies providing assessment and accreditation of conformity assessment bodies, including:
 - (i) accompanying and assessing building officials as they undertake their day to day duties;
 - (ii) reviewing building consent files;
 - (iii) interviewing a range of building consent authority staff; and
 - (iv) conducting case studies of completed or partially completed buildings.

Records and provision of information

(c) maintain accurate and complete records of audits undertaken and:

- (i) hold safely and securely all such records and any documents received or prepared in the course of audit work; and
- (ii) provide to the department, upon written request, all such records and documents (and/or copies thereof) in accordance with the terms of the request;
- (d) provide to the department regular, extraordinary and annual reports on audit work and related matters;
- (e) supply to the department a copy of every building consent authority accreditation assessment report as soon as practicable after the completion of the report; and
- (f) provide the department, upon written request, with timely information and assistance to enable the department to meet obligations under the Building Act 2004, or any other relevant Act, Regulation, Rule or Government Directive;

Complaints procedure

- (g) maintain a standard operating procedure in respect of complaints about the performance of any building consent authority, and in respect of disputes, appeals or complaints made in respect of building consent accreditation body decisions or actions. The complaints procedure will include:
 - (i) the time period within which the complaint must be acknowledged;
 - (ii) according to the nature of the complaint, the steps that will be taken to substantiate the complaint;
 - (iii) a requirement to document details of the complaint, actions taken to acknowledge and substantiate the complaint, and any subsequent decisions or actions taken in respect of the complaint; and
 - (iv) a requirement to keep the complainant informed about subsequent decisions and actions taken.

Notice of accreditation intentions and substantiated complaints

- (h) before granting or revoking any accreditation, notify the department of the intention to grant or revoke and take no further action in respect of that accreditation until written comments from the department have been received (see Note below); and

This determination may be cited as "Determination S18: Issue of Perpetual Non-cumulative Shares by NZ Co, and Related Transactions".

1. Explanation

(Note that the explanation does not form part of the determination.)

- (1) This determination relates to an arrangement involving the issue of perpetual non-cumulative shares ("the PPS") by a New Zealand company ("NZ Co") to its parent company ("Parent Co"). That arrangement is the subject of private ruling BR Prv 11/10 issued on 17 March 2011, and is fully described in that ruling.
- (2) The PPS are an excepted financial arrangement. The PPS form part of a financial arrangement as contemplated by section EW 6(1) of the Income Tax Act 2007 ("the wider financial arrangement"). The wider financial arrangement also includes a loan from a related party to Parent Co ("the Parent Loan"), the use of the Parent Loan proceeds by Parent Co to subscribe for the PPS, and the use of dividends received on the PPS, plus payments Parent Co is to receive in terms of the letter dated the 23rd day of December 2009 issued by NZ Co to Parent Co ("the NZ Co Letter"), to pay interest on the Parent Co Loan.
- (3) This wider financial arrangement has excepted financial arrangement components, as defined in section EW 5 of the Income Tax Act 2007. The PPS are an excepted financial arrangement component of the wider financial arrangement.
- (4) The amount of income derived or expenditure incurred by a person under the financial arrangement rules in respect of a financial arrangement excludes any amount that is

solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement described in sections EW 5(2) to (16) of the Income Tax Act 2007

(5) This determination prescribes a method to be used for determining the part of the consideration payable and receivable by the parties to the wider financial arrangement that is solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement.

2. Reference

This determination is made under section 90AC(1)(h) of the Tax Administration Act 1994.

3. Scope of determination

- (1) This determination applies specifically to the PPS.
- (2) This determination applies if the interest paid on the Parent Co Loan is at an arm's length market rate.

4. Principles

- (1) The PPS, the Parent Co Loan, and the payment and other obligations under the NZ Co Letter are each part of a wider "financial arrangement" that has excepted financial arrangement components as defined in section EW 5 of the Income Tax Act 2007.
- (2) Any amount that is solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement described in sections EW 5(2) to (16) of the Income Tax Act 2007 is not included when calculating income or expenditure under the financial arrangements rules.
- (3) This determination specifies that the only amounts that are solely attributable to the excepted financial arrangement within the wider financial arrangement are the amounts paid under or with respect to the PPS.
- (4) This determination specifies that no part of (*inter alia*) the amount advanced or repaid under the Parent Co Loan, the interest paid on the Parent Co Loan, or the payments or other consideration provided in terms of the NZ Co Letter, is solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement.

5. Interpretation

This determination has no specialised terms that need to be defined further.

6. Method

The amounts that are solely attributable to the PPS are:

- the issue price of the PPS;
- the dividends paid on the PPS;
- any other distributions paid on or with respect to the PPS by NZ Co; and
- any amounts paid to acquire the PPS.

7. Example

NZ Co raised \$20,000,000.00 from the issue of the PPS to Parent Co on 29 December 2009. Parent Co funded its acquisition by a loan of the same amount from a related party, at an interest rate of 9.25% per annum, payable quarterly on 28 March, June, September and December each calendar year. Therefore the amount of interest on the Parent Co Loan for each full quarter is \$462,500.00.

The amounts solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement are:

- the issue price of the PPS; and
- the dividends paid on the PPS.

The amounts not solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement are:

- the amount of the Parent Co Loan (\$20,000,000.00);
- the interest paid or capitalised on the Parent Co Loan (\$462,500.00 per quarter, plus the amount of any interest on any capitalised interest);
- the amount outstanding to be repaid on the repayment of the Parent Co Loan; and
- the payments or other consideration provided in terms of the NZ Co Letter.

 - "deposit" means a sum of money held by Public Trust belonging to any estate, which money for the time being forms part of the Common Fund;

"special deposit" means a deposit held other than at call on behalf of the Crown, or any local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1974;

"trust deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit or a special deposit) held on trust:

- (i) for persons not of full age or capacity; or
- (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
- (iii) otherwise than at call.
- (2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.
- **3. Rates of Common Fund interest**—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.
- (2) The rate of Common Fund interest on each protection deposit associated with a particular private training establishment shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate dollar range of the total of those deposits.

- (b) is signed by the persons (if any) who are required by law to sign that document; and
- (c) is not an "offer information statement" or "profile statement" (as those terms are defined in section 9 of the Corporations Act 2001).

qualified auditor has the same meaning as in section 2C of the Securities Act 1978.

specified futures contract means a futures contract that is issued by the Company and described in a disclosure document

- (2) Any term or expression that is defined in the Act or the Regulations and used, but not defined, in this notice has the same meaning as in the Act or the Regulations.
- **3. Authorisation**—(1) The Company is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in specified futures contracts.
- (2) The authorisation only applies to specified futures contracts to which the Company is, or intends to be, a party.
- (3) The authorisation is subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) the Company does not enter into specified futures contracts with any person other than a person who has entered into a written agreement with the Company, and then only in accordance with the terms of that agreement;
 - (b) the Company is licensed as an Australian Financial Services Licensee under the Corporations Act 2001 and holds an AFS Licence that authorises the Company to advise retail and wholesale clients on, and to deal with retail and wholesale clients in, specified futures contracts;
 - (c) the Company notifies the Commission if the Company's AFS licence is varied or revoked and notifies the Commission of any regulatory action taken by ASIC in relation to its AFS Licence;
 - (d) there is a product disclosure statement relating to the specified futures contracts at the time that the specified futures contracts are made available to New Zealand investors or the Company gives advice or assistance to, or induces or attempts to induce, New Zealand investors in relation to the acquisition or disposal of any specified futures contract;

- (e) before the Company enters into a specified futures contract with any person, that person has received a disclosure document relating to that specified futures contract:
- (f) every advertisement for a specified futures contract must refer to a disclosure document that relates to the specified futures contracts referred to in the advertisement;
- (g) no advertisement shall contain any information, sound, image or other matter that is inconsistent with any disclosure document referred to in the advertisement:
- (h) any Company document that states the Company has been authorised by the Commission to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts includes a statement to the effect that:
 - (i) the Commission's role in authorising futures dealers is limited and does not imply approval or endorsement of the business, trading or solvency of the Company; and
 - (ii) the Commission has not approved any agreements or any disclosure documents of the Company;
- (i) the Company holds client funds in a segregated client money account in accordance with the provisions of the AFS licence, the Corporations Act 2001, and any regulations made under the Corporations Act 2001 in relation to the protection of client money and client property; and;
- (j) the Company maintains proper records:
 - (i) to record dealings in respect of specified futures contracts with clients;
 - (ii) to record client money or property received, held or otherwise dealt with in connection with dealings in specified futures contracts; and
 - (iii) which are audited or reviewed, and reported on, in accordance with the Company's AFS Licence and the Financial Reporting Act 1993;
- (k) the Company's financial statements are prepared and registered as if the Company is an issuer in terms of the Financial Reporting Act 1993 and are audited at least once a year by a qualified auditor under the Financial Reporting Act 1993;
- (1) the Company sends a copy of its audited financial statements to the Commission not more than three months after the end of each financial year;
- (m) the Company maintains adequate professional indemnity insurance for its business at all times; and
- (n) the Company immediately notifies the Commission in writing of any material matter concerning the Company's authorisation as a futures dealer, including the following events:
 - (i) The insolvency of the Company or the bankruptcy of any of its directors;
 - (ii) if any auditor's report prepared in accordance with the Company's AFS Licence shows any non-compliance with that AFS Licence or the Corporations Act 2001;
 - (iii) where a receiver, provisional liquidator, liquidator or a similar officer is appointed, or any resolution is passed or order made for the liquidation or dissolution of the Company;
 - (iv) if the Company, or any of its directors, is convicted of an indictable offence;
 - (v) any regulatory action taken against the Company, or any of its directors or senior

- management whether in New Zealand or elsewhere; and
- (vi) if any director or member of the senior management leaves the Company or if any new director or member of senior management is appointed to the Company.
- **4. Further conditions relating to disclosure documents**—(1) The disclosure document must include information that would enable a prudent but non-expert investor to make a

decision about whether to invest in a specified futures

contract of that class.

 - (a) A description of the key terms and features of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (b) the name and contact details of the Company;
 - (c) a description of the amounts payable, or the method of calculating the amounts payable, by a person to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, including the consequences of failing to make any payments;
 - (d) a description of the amounts, or the method of calculating the amounts, of any margins, including initial margins and variation margins, payable by a person to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, including the consequences of failing to pay any margin;
 - (e) a description of the treatment of margins, including initial margins and variation margins, payable by a person to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (f) a description of the types of fees or charges payable by a person, directly or indirectly, to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (g) a description of the rights of the Company or any other person to alter any of the fees or charges applicable to that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (h) a description of the nature of any amounts or returns that may be payable, or the method of calculating any amounts or returns that may be payable, by the Company to a person in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (i) a description of the key factors that determine the amounts or returns that may be payable by the Company to a person in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - a description of the principal risks associated with entering into that class or those classes of specified

- futures contracts, including any specific risk factors that apply to any one or more of the particular specified futures contracts;
- (k) if it is reasonably foreseeable that, at the end of the arrangement relating to that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, a person will have received, in total, less than the amount paid to the Company for the specified futures contracts, a statement to this effect and a brief description of the circumstances that may produce this result;
- (l) a description of the parties' rights to alter the terms of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
- (m) a description of the parties' rights to terminate, cancel, surrender, or otherwise make or obtain payment of any amounts or returns in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, other than as described in paragraphs (h) and (i);
- (n) a statement as to whether a person is entitled to sell his or her interest in a specified futures contract to another person and, if so, whether in the opinion of the Company there is an established market for such sales;
- (o) a description of the treatment of client money or property received, held or otherwise dealt with in connection with dealing in specified futures contracts, other than as described in paragraph (e);
- (p) the names or descriptions, and the addresses and business telephone numbers, of officers, employees, or agents of the Company to whom enquiries about the specified futures contracts can be made, and to whom complaints about the specified futures contracts can be made;
- (q) a statement to the effect that other information about the Company is contained or referred to in financial statements of, or relating to, the Company and where a copy of the latest financial statements may be obtained from;

- (u) any other material matters applicable to that class or those classes of specified futures contracts.

ISCR means the New Zealand Institute for the Study of Competition and Regulation.

market:

- (a) means the market that has been, or will be, established by the market provider for the purposes of trading specified futures contracts; and
- (b) includes a sponsored market or branded market.

market provider means iPredict Limited.

participant means any person who has an account with the market provider for the purposes of trading specified futures contracts.

participant's contribution limit, in respect of a participant, means \$2,500 in any period of six months, with a cumulative total limit of \$10,000, calculated as the total of all contributions paid by the participant less the total of all amounts reimbursed by the market provider.

participants' funds account means a call deposit account with a registered bank that is established and maintained by the clearing house for the purposes of the market

participation agreement means an agreement between the participant, the market provider, and the clearing house under which the market provider allows the participant to trade on the market and the participant agrees to be bound by the rules of the market.

specified agreement means an agreement:

- (a) under which a participant has a contingent or an actual right to be paid, by the clearing house from funds held in the participants' funds account, at a specified future date, an amount that depends on one or more political, business, economic, sociological, or demographic events or circumstances;
- (b) under which that payment may not exceed the total amount payable by participants for the acquisition from the market provider of a bundle of specified agreements of which the specified futures contract forms a part;
- (c) in respect of which a participant's right referred to in paragraph (a) is able to be traded on the market; and
- (d) the terms of which are publicly available on an internet site maintained by, or on behalf of, the market provider at all reasonable times.

specified future date includes a date that is described by referring to the day, or number of days (including, to avoid doubt, the number of working or other specified type of days) after a specified future act or event happens or circumstance occurs.

specified futures contract means:

- (a) a specified agreement;
- (b) a specified right.

specified right means the right of a participant under paragraph (a) of the definition of "specified agreement" (whether held by the participant who is a party to that specified agreement or by another participant).

sponsor means the person on whose behalf, or by arrangement with whom, the market provider establishes a sponsored market.

sponsored market means a market established by the market provider on behalf of, or by arrangement with, a sponsor:

- (a) to meet specific information or research needs of the sponsor;
- (b) on which the only specified futures contracts able to be traded relate to one or more business projects or financial indicators of the sponsor;
- (c) in respect of which the sponsor, for the purposes of trading by any participant, may only contribute sponsor's contributions that do not exceed the sponsor's contribution limit.

sponsor's contribution means, in respect of a participant, an amount that a sponsor of a sponsored market certifies to the market provider:

- (a) has been or will be provided to the participant in a specified period for the purposes of trading exclusively on that sponsor's sponsored market; and
- (b) will not be deducted from, or be taken into account in determining, the amount of any salary, bonus, benefit or other entitlement payable to that participant by or on behalf of that sponsor or any related party of that sponsor.

sponsor's contribution limit, in respect of a participant, means \$1,000 in any period of six months.

Vic Link means Victoria Link Limited.

- (2) Any term or expression that is defined in the Act and used, but not defined, in this notice has the same meaning given to it by the Act.
- **3. Authorisation**—(1) The market provider is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in specified futures contracts to which the market provider or clearing house is, or intends to be, a party.
- (2) For all markets other than branded markets, the authorisation in clause 3(1) is subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) the only contracts which may be traded on the market are those declared to be contracts to which Part III of the Act relates pursuant to the declaration and exemption under section 37(7) and section 48(1)(d) of the Act known as the Futures Contracts (iPredict Limited) Declaration and Exemption Notice 2008;
 - (b) the market provider must comply with all conditions of the Futures Contracts (iPredict Limited) Declaration and Exemption Notice 2008;
 - (c) subject to clause 3(2)(d) the fees charged by the market provider and clearing house from participants may not exceed:
 - (i) \$20 for account opening; and

(ii) 12.5% of net earnings (payable only when and to the extent that funds are withdrawn by a participant),

and no such fees will be charged in respect of any sponsored market;

- (d) the market provider may increase fees above the levels provided in clause 3(2)(c), change the structure of those fees or introduce new categories of fees provided that at least five working days' notice is provided to participants before the new fees come into effect;
- (e) all funds paid to the clearing house by participants for credit to their accounts with the clearing house must be held in the participants' funds account, and the clearing house may only disburse funds from that account in the following circumstances:
 - (i) payments to participants in accordance with their account entitlements;
 - (ii) deductions of fees and interest;
 - (iii) repayment of amounts lodged in error or in excess of the participant's contribution limit; and
 - (iv) repayment of amounts lodged in error or in excess of the sponsor's contribution limit;
- (f) the clearing house remains at all times a whollyowned subsidiary of the market provider, and ISCR and Vic Link, together or individually, must at all times retain a majority of the voting shares in and the ability to control the appointment of a majority of the directors to the board of the market provider;
- (g) the clearing house must keep and maintain proper records of each participant's dealings, account and holdings;
- (h) the financial statements of the market provider and clearing house for each financial year are audited, and a copy of those financial statements and the audit report is made available electronically to any person requesting them and sent to the Commission no later than five months after the end of each financial year;
- (i) the clearing house is and remains obliged, under the terms and conditions of the participation agreement, to pay to any participant the available balance in that participant's account as soon as practicable (and in any event no later than three working days after receiving a request or instruction from that participant to do so, or six working days where the market provider has given at least five working days' notice to participants of its intention to extend this period) except to the extent (if any) that that balance consists of sponsor contributions which the sponsor has required not to be disbursed until after the liquidation date of the relevant sponsored market:
- (j) under the terms of participation, the market provider can prohibit any person from participating in the market;
- (k) the market provider and clearing house must report to the Commission annually on the operation of the market, including contracts traded, volume and value of trades, number of participants, and any material systems failures or interruptions;
- (1) the market provider and clearing house must immediately report to the Commission any discrepancy or shortfall discovered in the participants' funds account;
- (m) the market provider's website contains, in a prominent place, a statement to the effect that:

- (i) the markets operated by the market provider are intended as a research and educational facility, not as an investment market or a gambling facility, and the market provider has been authorised to act as a futures dealer, and the contracts traded are treated as futures contracts under New Zealand law, in order to provide certainty as to the legal treatment of the contracts:
- (ii) the Commission's role in authorising futures dealers is limited and does not imply approval or endorsement of the business, trading or solvency of the company concerned; and
- (iii) the Commission has not approved any documentation of the market provider, or the terms and conditions on which it carries out its business.
- (3) For branded markets, the authorisation granted in clause 3(1) is subject to the same conditions specified in clause 3(2), with the addition of the following condition:

The internet site for the branded market must contain prominent statements that it is operated by the market provider in reliance on the Commission's authorisation, and detailing the matters required under clause 3(2)(1).

Pursuant to sections 105 and 105B of the Medicines Act 1981 and the Medicines (Designated Prescriber—Registered Nurses Practising in Diabetes Health) Regulations 2011, the Nursing Council of New Zealand ("council") gives the following notice.

Notice

- **1. Title and commencement**—This notice is the Medicines (Designated Prescriber—Registered Nurses Practising in Diabetes Health) Notice 2011 and comes into force **1 April 2011**.
- 2. The purpose—The Schedule to this notice sets out the requirements that the council has determined must be met by registered nurses practising in diabetes health who wish to prescribe prescription medicines. These requirements are imposed under Regulations 6, 7 and 8 of the Medicines (Designated Prescriber—Registered Nurses Practising in Diabetes Health) Regulations 2011.

Schedule

A Requirements for Commencing for First Time to Prescribe (Regulation 6)

The council requirements for education and training that registered nurses practising in diabetes health must undertake before commencing prescribing for the first time are as follows:

(a) The completion of two level eight papers or equivalent, as assessed by the council. The papers must include the following content:

Pathophysiology, clinical assessment and decision making, and pharmacology; and

- (b) demonstrates a clear understanding of diabetes disease processes at level eight or equivalent as determined by the council; and
- (c) completion of a six to 12-week practicum with the authorised prescriber supervising the prescribing, which demonstrates knowledge to safely prescribe all specified diabetes medicines and knowledge of the regulatory framework for prescribing.

B. Other Training to be Undertaken (Regulation 7)

Registered nurses practising in diabetes health must undertake:

- (a) a minimum of 40 days per year of ongoing practice in a supervised prescribing relationship; and
- (b) ongoing competence requirements of professional development must include specific development relating to prescribing in diabetes health.

C. Assessments of Competence to be Completed (Regulation 8)

Registered nurses practising in diabetes health authorised to prescribe must provide to the council each year with their application for a practising certificate, evidence that they have maintained their prescribing competence.

Veterinarians Act 2005

Minimum Standards for Practising as a Veterinarian Notice 2011

Pursuant to section 75(i) of the Veterinarians Act 2005, the Veterinary Council of New Zealand ("council") sets out in this notice* the following prescribed minimum standards for practising as a veterinarian:

1. Fitness to Practise

A veterinarian must be fit in order to maintain his or her practising certificate and to practise as a veterinarian in New Zealand.

Matters that may bring fitness to practise into question can include:

- (a) mental or physical health conditions;
- (b) any addictive or inappropriate taking of drugs or alcohol;
- (c) any investigations, in New Zealand or overseas, by an employer, registration or professional body, educational institution or other authority (eg racing authority) relating to any matter that may be the subject of disciplinary proceedings;
- (d) a formal competence enquiry by an employer or registration body;
- (e) an adverse finding in any disciplinary action by an employer, registration or professional body, or other authority (eg racing authority);
- (f) being the subject of a police investigation and/or being the holder of a conviction in any criminal proceeding (including traffic offences involving alcohol and/or drugs), where the offence is punishable by imprisonment for a term of three months or longer; and
- (g) being the holder of a conviction for any offence against the Veterinarians Act 2005, the Agricultural Compounds and Veterinary Medicines Act 1997, the Animal Welfare Act 1981, the Misuse of Drugs Act 1975 and subordinate legislation, and any other Act or subordinate legislation that has a direct bearing on the veterinary profession.

All persons are required to provide the council with a statement about their fitness to practise when they apply for registration or for a practising certificate.

The council may also examine a person (section 25(a)), require statutory declarations (section 25(b)), require other information (section 25(c)) and take various actions under specific, relevant sections of the Veterinarians Act 2005.

2. Competence to Practise

(a) Competency Standards

Pursuant to section 88(3) of the Veterinarians Act 2005, the council refers persons to the document "Competency Standards and Performance Indicators for Veterinarians" available on its website

www.vetcouncil.org.nz

and from the council's office on request. This sets out the competency standards council expects veterinarians to meet, at the point of initial registration, and on an ongoing basis, and provides criteria against which an individual veterinarian's performance may be measured.

(b) Recency of Practice

Non-recency of practice can impact on performance. All applicants for a practising certificate are required to provide the council with information on their recency of practice. In the following situations, the council, after consideration of the individual circumstances of the case, may propose to decline or place conditions upon the applicant's practising certificate (section 26(3)(c)) for:

- those who have not practised as a veterinarian for the last three consecutive years, or have not practised as a veterinarian for the last three consecutive years in the area in which they intend to practise; and
- those who hold a recognised qualification or a pass in a prescribed examination or assessment programme (section 6) but have not:
 - o practised as a veterinarian for one or more years subsequent to gaining registration; or
 - o practised for one or more years in the area in which they intend to practise subsequent to gaining registration.

(c) Continuing Professional Development

The council requires all veterinarians to maintain and enhance their performance by engaging in continuing professional development activities. Pursuant to section 88(3) of the Veterinarians Act 2005, the council refers persons to the document "Continuing Professional Development – Guidance for Veterinarians" available on its website

www.vetcouncil.org.nz

and from the council's office on request. This sets out the continuing professional development standards council expects veterinarians to meet.

Under section 25, when considering an application for a practising certificate, the council may require the applicant to provide any document or information that the council considers, on reasonable grounds, is necessary to assess his or her application.

The council will use this section to monitor veterinarian's compliance with the continuing professional development declarations made in their annual practising certificate declarations. Section 26 may be used in situations of non-compliance.
