Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

Initiation of Dumping Investigation: Preserved Peaches From Spain

Notice is hereby given that, acting pursuant to section 10(1) of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988, and under delegated authority from the Chief Executive of the Ministry of Economic Development, I have initiated an investigation to determine both the existence and effect of the alleged dumping of the goods described in the Schedule to this notice originating from Spain, being satisfied that sufficient evidence has been provided that:

- (a) the goods imported into New Zealand are being dumped; and
- (b) by reason thereof, there is a threat of material injury to the New Zealand industry producing like goods and also being satisfied that the collective output of those New Zealand producers who have, in writing, expressed support for the application for an investigation constitutes:
 - (a) twenty-five percent or more of total New Zealand production of like goods produced for domestic consumption (assessed during the most recent representative period, being not less than six months); and
 - (b) more than 50 percent of the total production of like goods produced for domestic consumption (as so assessed) by those New Zealand producers who

have, in writing, expressed support for or opposition to the application.
