Increase in Application Fee for Reference 99 Tariff Concession

As a result of the increase in the rate of GST from 12.5% to 15% on 1 October 2010, the application fee for a tariff concession under Part 2 tariff concession reference 99 will increase from \$390.00 to \$398.67. The revised fee is GST inclusive and will apply to all Reference 99 tariff concession applications received by the Ministry of Economic Development on or after 1 October 2010.
