- (e) Her Majesty The Queen in right of New Zealand, a Crown entity named in the Crown Entities Act 2004, or a State enterprise named in the First or Second Schedule to the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 (each as amended from time to time); or
- (f) a person who is a statutory corporation or a registered bank; or
- (g) a person whose principal business is the investment of money or who, in the course of and for the purposes of their business, habitually invests money; or
- (h) a person who is a related body corporate of any of the persons mentioned in subparagraphs (a) to (g) above.

- 2(2) Any term or expression that is defined in the Act and used, but not defined, in this notice has the same meaning as in the Act.

Clause 3: Authorisation

 - (e) in respect of any futures contract that is made on or effected through a recognised exchange, any acquisition or disposal of the contract is effected through a person who is an authorised participant or member of the recognised exchange and who is authorised or licensed by the laws of the country in which it operates to deal in futures contracts on behalf of that person and to hold client money for that purpose; and
 - (f) the Company provides the Commission with a copy of its audited annual financial statements no later than three months after the end of each financial year for the Company; and
 - (g) the Company notifies the Commission of any material matter concerning its authorisation as a futures dealer, including the following events:
 - (i) the insolvency of the Company or the bankruptcy of any of its directors;
 - (ii) where a receiver, provisional liquidator, liquidator or a similar officer is appointed, or any resolution is passed or order made for the liquidation or dissolution of the Company;
 - (iii) if the Company, or any of its directors or member of the senior management, is convicted of an indictable offence;
 - (iv) any regulatory action taken against the Company, or any of its directors or senior management, whether in New Zealand or elsewhere; and
 - (v) if any director or member of the senior management leaves the Company or if any new director or member of the senior management is appointed to the Company.

Amendments to the Betting Rules

Pursuant to sections 52 and 54 of the Racing Act 2003, the New Zealand Racing Board hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the Betting Rules*.

Change #1

Rule 12 CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO FIXED ODDS RACE BETTING is amended by adding the following new rule:

12.17 Special Options

From time to time the Board may offer special options on Fixed Odds Race Betting. The applicable condition relating to that special option will be displayed in the option notation on the Board's website at the time of offering the market.

Should any eventuality occur not covered by the condition relating to the special option then the Board will look for suitable parallels within the Betting Rules as an aid to bet Settlement.

Change #2

Rule 14 CONDITIONS APPLICABLE TO FIXED ODDS SPORTS BETTING is amended by adding the following new rule:

14.17 Special Options

From time to time the Board may offer special options on Fixed Odds Sports Betting. The applicable condition relating to that special option will be displayed in the option notation on the Board's website at the time of offering the market.

Should any eventuality occur not covered by the condition relating to the special option then the Board will look for suitable parallels within the Betting Rules as an aid to bet Settlement.

Change #3

Rule 15 SPORT SPECIFIC RULES is amended by the addition of new Rule 15.10(n) as follows:

15.10 Cricket

Limited Over Matches (including Twenty20)

Head to Head:

- (m) All bets will be Settled on the Official Result. In the event of a tie Rule 14.13 Dead Heats will apply. Notwithstanding, if there is an official method prescribed in the competition rules to determine a winner in the event of a tie, bets will be Settled on the winner of the match as a result of that method.

Tied Matches:

- (n) With the exception of head to head betting (as above), in the event of a tie, any subsequent super over, bowl off, or other similar method for determining an outcome of the match, does not count towards the result of any other option.

Change #4

Rule 15 SPORT SPECIFIC RULES is amended by a change to Rule 15.12(c) and the addition of new Rules 15.12(d), (e), (f), (g), (h) and (i) as follows:

15.12 Football

Top Series/Competition/Tournament Goal Scorer:

- (c) Bets will be Settled on the official competition results (regardless of whether all matches are played or not). Rule 14.13 Dead Heats Rules will apply. Bets on players not named in at least one starting XI will be Void. Goals scored during extra time will count for top goal scorer markets.

Tournament Totals:

- (d) For tournament total markets including goals, red cards, yellow cards and corners, extra time does not count.

Relegation Betting:

- (e) Bets will be Settled based on the position on the final day of the season regardless of any subsequent disqualifications or points deductions. Bets will be Voided on any team that does not fulfil its fixtures and complete the season.

Player Specials:

- (f) For all player specials such as to score a goal or to score a hat-trick, the player must start the match at kickoff for bets to stand.

Total Match Corners:

- (g) Bets on the number of corners in a match refers to corners taken rather than corners awarded. If a corner is awarded but the whistle blows for the end of the match before it is taken, then it will not count towards total

corners. If there is a dispute over the number of corners, the result will be obtained from Sportinglife.com or another website that provides results if Sportinglife.com is not available.

Top Team Goal Scorer:

- (h) Bets will be Settled on the player scoring the most goals including extra time but excluding penalty shoot outs. Bets will be Void on any player not starting at least one match.

First Goal Method:

- (i) For the purpose of this market a “shot” is considered to be an effort on goal propelled by a body part below the waist, a “header” an effort on goal propelled by a body part above the waist. Only one outcome will be Settled as a winner, therefore if the goal is a penalty, then “penalty” will be Settled as a winner while “shot from inside the penalty box” will be Settled as a loser. Similarly, if the goal is scored directly from a free-kick, “direct from free-kick” will be Settled as a winner while “shot from outside the penalty box” will be Settled as a loser.

Change #5

Rule 15 SPORT SPECIFIC RULES is amended by the addition of new Rule 15.19 as follows:

15.19 Rowing

- (a) Results will be determined by Podium Placing regardless of subsequent disqualifications.
(b) Competitors are deemed to have taken part once they have lined up for the first heat. If they subsequently Withdraw for any reason, including disqualification, bets will be Settled as losers.

These Rules come into force on **9 June 2010**.

Notice of Replacement Scope of Practice and Related Qualifications Prescribed by the Nursing Council of New Zealand for Enrolled Nurses

This notice, pursuant to sections 11(1) and 12(1) of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 ("the Act"), is the Notice of Scope of Practice and Related Qualifications Prescribed by the Nursing Council for Enrolled Nurses (2010) and comes into force on **31 May 2010**.

The scopes of practice and related qualifications for Nurse Assistant and Enrolled Nurse, published in the Supplement to the *New Zealand Gazette*, 15 September 2004, No. 120, at pages 2959 and 2960, are revoked by this notice under sections 11, 12 and 14 of the Act.

Scope of Practice – Enrolled Nurse

Enrolled nurses practise under the direction and delegation of a registered nurse or nurse practitioner to deliver nursing care and health education across the life span to health consumers in community, residential or hospital settings.

Enrolled nurses contribute to nursing assessments, care planning, implementation and evaluation of care for health consumers and/or families/whanau.

The registered nurse maintains overall responsibility for the plan of care.

Enrolled nurses assist health consumers with the activities of daily living, observe changes in health consumers' conditions and report these to the registered nurse, administer medicines and undertake other nursing care responsibilities appropriate to their assessed competence.

In acute settings, enrolled nurses must work in a team with a registered nurse who is responsible for directing and delegating nursing interventions.

In some settings, enrolled nurses may coordinate a team of health care assistants under the direction and delegation of a registered nurse.

In some settings, enrolled nurses may work under the direction and delegation of a registered health practitioner*.

In these situations, the enrolled nurse must have registered nurse supervision and must not assume overall responsibility for nursing assessment or care planning.

Enrolled nurses are accountable for their nursing actions and practise competently in accordance with legislation, to their level of knowledge and experience.

They work in partnership with health consumers, families/whanau and multidisciplinary teams.

*A person who is registered under the Act eg midwife, medical practitioner, occupational therapist.

The Nursing Council competencies for enrolled nurses describe the skills, knowledge and activities of enrolled nurses.

Qualifications**New Zealand Graduates**

Successful completion of an 18-month programme in enrolled nursing at level 5 on the New Zealand Qualification Authority – National Qualifications Framework accredited by the Nursing Council; and

a pass in an assessment of the Nursing Council competencies for enrolled nurses by an approved provider; and

a pass in an Examination for Enrolled nurses.

Nurses From Overseas

Registration with an overseas regulatory authority; and

an international qualification that is equivalent to a prescribed qualification.

Overseas applicants may also be required to:

pass an assessment of the Nursing Council competencies for enrolled nurses by an approved provider; and/or

successfully complete a programme approved by the Nursing Council for the purpose of assessing competencies for enrolled nurses.
