Cessation of Anti-dumping Duties on Oral Liquid Paracetamol From the Republic of Ireland

Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988

The Chief Executive of the Ministry of Economic Development gives notice that the anti-dumping duties on oral liquid paracetamol from the Republic of Ireland ceased to be payable with effect from **30 March 2010**.

As the duties were not subject to a review, in accordance with section 14(9) of the Dumping and Countervailing

Duties Act 1988, the anti-dumping duties ceased to be payable as five years had passed since the final determination was made to impose the duties.
