2010 Reassessment of Anti-dumping Duty: "Choice" Grade Canned Peaches From South Africa

Pursuant to section 14 of the Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act 1988 ("the Act"), the Minister of Commerce, having carried out a reassessment of the anti-dumping duty applying to imports into New Zealand of "choice" grade canned peaches from Langeberg & Ashton Foods Pty Ltd, South Africa, and having determined new amounts of anti-dumping duty applicable to those goods, gives the following notice.

Notice

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the “2010 Reassessment of Anti-dumping Duty: “Choice” Grade Canned Peaches from South Africa.”

(2) This notice replaces and supersedes all previous notices in relation to the subject goods described below in the First Schedule.

(3) Pursuant to section 17 of the Act, the reassessed anti-dumping duty, set out in the Second Schedule to this notice, shall apply to imports of the goods specified in the First Schedule with effect from the day after the date of this notice.

Radiocommunications Regulations 2001

Radiocommunications Regulations (General User Radio Licence for Amateur Radio Operators) Notice 2010

Pursuant to Regulation 9 of the Radiocommunications Regulations 2001 (“the Regulations”) made under section 116(1)(b) of the Radiocommunications Act 1989, and acting under delegated authority from the Chief Executive, I give the following notice.

Notice

1. Short title and commencement—(1) This notice is the Radiocommunications Regulations (General User Radio Licence for Amateur Radio Operators) Notice 2010.

(2) This notice comes into force on **1 March 2010**.

2. General user radio licence—A general user radio licence is granted for the transmission of radio waves by amateur radio operators in New Zealand, for the purpose of communications in the amateur radio service in accordance with the terms, conditions and restrictions of this notice.

3. Terms, conditions and restrictions applying to New Zealand amateur operators—(1) Persons who hold a General Amateur Operators Certificate of Competency and a callsign issued pursuant to the Regulations may operate an amateur radio station in New Zealand.

(2) The callsign prefix of “ZL” may be substituted with the prefix “ZM” by the callsign holder for the period of, and participation in, a recognised contest, or as the control station for special event communications.

(3) Operation on amateur bands between 5 MHz and 25 MHz is not permitted unless a person has held a General Amateur Operators Certificate of Competency for three months and logged 50 contacts during this period. The person must keep the logbook record for at least one year and, during this period, produce it at the request of the chief executive.

4. Terms, conditions and restrictions applying to visiting amateur operators—(1) Persons visiting New Zealand who hold a current amateur certificate of competency, authorisation or licence issued by another administration, may operate an amateur station in New Zealand for a period not exceeding 90 days, provided the certificate, authorisation or licence meets the requirements of Recommendation ITU-R M.1544 or CEPT T/R 61-01 or CEPT T/R 61-02 and is produced at the request of the chief executive.

(2) The callsign must be the national callsign allocated by the other administration to that person, in conjunction with the prefix or suffix “ZL” which is to be separated from the national callsign by the character “/” (telegraphy), or the word “stroke” (telephony).

5. Terms, conditions and restrictions applying to all amateur operators—(1) The use of callsigns, including temporary and club callsigns, must be in accordance with publication PIB 46 “Radio Operator Certificate and Callsign Rules” published at www.rsm.govt.nz

(2) Callsigns must be transmitted at least once every 15 minutes during communications.

(3) National and international communication is permitted only between amateur stations, and is limited to matters of a personal nature, or for the purpose of self-training, intercommunication and radio technology investigation, solely with a personal aim and without pecuniary interest. The passing of brief messages of a personal nature on behalf of other persons is also permitted, provided no fees or other consideration is requested or accepted.

(4) Communications must not be encoded for the purpose of obscuring their meaning, except for control signals by the operators of remotely controlled amateur stations.

(5) Except as provided to the contrary in this notice, transmitter power output must not exceed 500 watts peak envelope power (pX), as defined in ITU Radio Regulation 1.157.

(6) Amateur stations must, as far as is compatible with practical considerations, comply with the latest ITU-R recommendations to the extent applicable to the amateur service.

(7) In accordance with Article 25 of the International Radio Regulations, amateur operators are encouraged to prepare for, and meet, communication needs in support of disaster relief.

(2) The determinations and revocation in this notice take effect from and including 17 February 2010.

2. Interpretation—(1) Unless the context otherwise requires:

"agency deposit" means a deposit (not being an investment deposit) held as agent or attorney;

"call deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit, a special deposit or a trust deposit) held in the ordinary course of administration, and determined by Public Trust to be held at call;

"deposit" means a sum of money held by Public Trust belonging to any estate, which money for the time being forms part of the Common Fund;

"investment deposit" means a deposit held at call or otherwise as an investment under section 51 of the Act;

"protection deposit" means a deposit, held at call, of tuition, boarding, accommodation or other fees by or on behalf of a student enrolled at a private training establishment within the meaning of Part 18 of the Education Act 1989;

"special deposit" means a deposit held other than at call on behalf of the Crown, or any local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1974;

"trust deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit or a special deposit) held on trust:

- (i) for persons not of full age or capacity; or
- (ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or
- (iii) otherwise than at call.

(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

3. Rates of Common Fund interest—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or

protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.

(2) The rate of Common Fund interest on each protection deposit associated with a particular private training establishment shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate dollar range of the total of those deposits.

(3) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 3 for the appropriate interest payment frequency, term and dollar range.

(4) Despite subparagraph (1), the rate of Common Fund interest payable on deposits made pursuant to an enactment shall be the rate (if any) specified in the enactment.

(5) Despite subparagraphs (1), (2) and (3), in particular cases or classes of case, Public Trust and the depositor may agree on a rate of interest payable on investment deposits, protection deposits or special deposits that is different from the rate specified in Schedules 1, 2, or 3 and the agreed rate then applies.

4. Revocation of notice and transitional provisions—

(1) The Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 11 February 2010 is revoked.

(2) The rates of interest specified in Schedules 1 and 2 to this notice do not apply to any period that ends with 16 February 2010 but otherwise operate as from 17 February 2010.

Notice of Making of Electricity Governance (Instantaneous Reserve Dispatch) Amendment Rules 2010 and Notice of Reasons for Decision

1. Pursuant to section 172I of the Electricity Act 1992 ("Act"), I notify the amendment of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 ("Rules") under section 172H of the Act.
2. The empowering provisions for the Electricity Governance Regulations in relation to which the amendments to the Rules are made are sections 172D(1)(1)(a), (b) and (c) of the Act.
3. A brief description of the nature of the amendments is as follows:
 - (a) Part A is amended to provide definitions to be consistent with the below mentioned amendments;

- (b) Schedule C6 of Part C is amended to be consistent with the below mentioned amendments;
 - (c) Section V of Part G is amended to allow for compensation to be paid to providers of instantaneous reserve in certain circumstances; and
 - (d) Schedule G2 of Part G is amended to allow the System Operator to use additional model parameters for dispatching instantaneous reserve.
4. The amendments are made under urgency in reliance on section 172E(3) of the Act.
 5. Pursuant to section 172Z(4) of the Act, the reasons for my decision to amend the Rules are to improve system security by:
 - (a) improving the dispatch of instantaneous reserve where there is insufficient instantaneous reserve; and
 - (b) ensuring the providers of instantaneous reserve are compensated, thus incentivising providers of instantaneous reserve to participate in the market.
 6. These Rules come into force on **1 May 2010**.

3. Terms and conditions—This exemption is granted on the following conditions:

- (a) the exemption expires on the earlier of the two:
 - (i) the date which is four months after this exemption comes into force;
 - (ii) the date on which the final assessment is received by Nga Awa Purua Joint Venture from the System Operator in accordance with Clause 127.1 of Schedule C4 of Part C of the Rules; and
- (b) the exemption only applies to the Nga Awa Purua Power Station.

4. Reasons for granting the exemption—The reasons for granting this exemption are:

- (a) the proposed exemption is not materially different from the exemptions granted previously from Rule 11.5.2 to other asset owners; and
- (b) if the event charge applied, it could result in an excessively cautious approach being taken which may prolong the commissioning of Nga Awa Purua Power Station at a time when it is desirable to avoid delays in the expansion of the capacity of the electricity system.
