Education Act 1989

The Education (2015 Annual Maximum Fee Movement and Fee Limits) Notice 2014

Under sections 159L(3)(d) and 159M(b) of the Education Act 1989, the Minister for Tertiary Education, Skills and Employment gives notice of the proposed conditions setting limits on the annual increases that tertiary education organisations may make to fees charged to domestic students in 2015.

It also specifies the conditions under which specified education funds are allocated by the Tertiary Education

Commission (TEC) to tertiary education organisations (TEOs).

Notice

1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Education (2015 Annual Maximum Fee Movement and Fee Limits) Notice 2014.

2. Commencement—The proposed conditions outlined in this notice apply for the 2015 academic year only.

3. Proposal—I propose to specify conditions under section 159L(3)(d) that the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) must attach to funding provided under the relevant funding mechanisms, in particular:

- (a) to specify the annual limits by which TEOs can increase fees charged to domestic students enrolled in courses that are leading to short awards, certificate, diploma, degree and postgraduate qualifications that receive Student Achievement Component (SAC) funding in 2015; and
- (b) to specify the other conditions in relation to fees that the TEC must attach to SAC funding; and
- (c) to specify the conditions that the TEC must attach to specified education funds outlined in this notice.

4. Application—The conditions set out in this notice refer to:

- (a) Fees as including the following items: Tuition fees, compulsory course costs, examination fees, other charges associated with a programme of study, material charges, cost of field trips and any compulsory purchase of equipment or books through the organisation.
- (b) TEOs, as defined in section 159B, include tertiary education institutions (TEIs), private training establishments (PTEs) and rural education activities programme providers (REAPs).

5. Call for submissions—Any TEO and any other person, body or organisation having an interest in the matter is invited to make a submission on the proposed Annual Maximum Fee Movement (AMFM) and other proposed conditions set out in this notice.

Proposed Conditions to be Attached to Student Achievement Component Funding (SAC) Allocated and Paid for by the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC) to Tertiary Education Organisations (TEOs)

General

1. These conditions apply to fees charged for SAC-funded provision in all TEOs.
2. The fees in relation to a particular course of study or training will be subject to these conditions if:
 - (a) the TEO is the sole source of the item to which the cost relates; and

- (b) all students enrolled in the relevant course of study or training are required to pay the fees.

Annual Maximum Fee Movement (AMFM)

3. For 2015, the permitted AMFM is a 4% increase on the fees, exclusive of GST, charged in 2014 for short awards, certificate, diploma, degree and postgraduate courses at New Zealand Qualifications Framework (NZQF) Level 3 or above that receive SAC funding.

Exceptions to the AMFM

4. A TEO may apply, on the basis of exceptional circumstances, for exceptions from the 2015 AMFM of 4% for courses at NZQF Level 3 or above. Any exceptions granted will not exceed an additional 4% increase.
5. In considering exceptional circumstances, the TEC will use the following criteria:
 - (a) The organisation is unable to support the course(s) while remaining financially viable;
 - (b) for courses at NZQF Levels 3–8, the completion rate for the course met or exceeded the median performance benchmark for that level in the previous year;
 - (c) the TEO can demonstrate that the qualification of which the course is a part is in some way unique or special, for example, that there are no local alternatives to the course available; and
 - (d) that not allowing an exception will prevent the TEO from making a significant contribution to the achievement of one or more of the Government's priorities, as set out in the Tertiary Education Strategy 2014/2019.
6. An application must satisfy all criteria to gain an exception.

Low or Zero Fee Courses

7. If the fees for a course, other than a course that is Level 1 or Level 2 on the NZQF and funded through the SAC funding mechanism, are less than \$511.11 (GST inclusive) (\$444.44 GST exclusive) per Equivalent Full-Time Student (EFTS) in 2014, then for 2015, the tertiary education provider can increase the fee to up to \$511.11 (GST inclusive) (\$444.44 GST exclusive) per EFTS, or can increase the fee for the course by 4%, whichever is the greater.

Fees for SAC Funded Level One and Two Provision

8. A TEO must not charge fees to learners aged under 25 years old enrolled in a course that is at Level 1 or Level 2 on the NZQF and funded through the Student Achievement Component (SAC) fund under the "Plan Allocation Process".
9. For all other SAC funded provision at NZQF Levels 1 and 2 that is delivered under the usual plan process, a TEO may not charge a higher fee for any course in 2015 than it charged for the same course, the last time that provider offered that course.

Proposed Conditions to be Attached to Specified Funds that are Allocated and Paid for by the Tertiary Education Commission to TEOs

10. A TEO may not charge fees to learners enrolled in 2015 in the courses funded by funds specified in paragraph 11.
11. Specified funds:
 - (a) Youth Guarantee Programme;
 - (b) Gateway;
 - (c) Māori and Pasifika Trades Training;

- (d) Intensive Literacy and Numeracy, Refugee English Fund;
- (e) Intensive Literacy and Numeracy, English for Speakers of Other Languages;
- (f) Intensive Literacy and Numeracy;
- (g) Workplace Literacy and Numeracy;
- (h) Adult Literacy Educator Grants;
- (i) Search and Rescue (Adult and Community Education);
- (j) Emergency Management (Adult and Community Education).

Sanctions

12. Where the TEC decides that a TEO is not complying with the conditions set out in this notice, it can withdraw funding for that course. This sanction will only be exercised as a final resort, and the TEC will work with the provider to rectify any non-compliance in the first instance.

Note: Effect of this Notice

These notes do not form part of this notice, but are intended to indicate its general effect.

- A. Section 159L(3)(d) of the Education Act 1989 ("Act") provides that the Minister, when determining the design of a funding mechanism, may specify the conditions that the TEC must attach to funding provided under the mechanism, including conditions that limit the fees that an organisation may charge domestic students.
- B. Under section 159M(b) of the Act, the Minister may not specify conditions setting limits on fees until two months after the date of publication of a notice in the *New Zealand Gazette* that:
- (i) states that the Minister proposes to specify such conditions; and
 - (ii) sets out the proposed conditions; and
 - (iii) invites submissions on the proposed conditions; and
 - (iv) specifies the date by which submissions must be received, which must be a date no more than 21 days after the date of the *New Zealand Gazette* notice.
- C. The conditions setting limits on fees subsequently specified by the Minister in accordance with section 159L(3)(d) of the Act must be attached as conditions on the receipt of funding payable by the Tertiary Education Commission to an organisation under sections 159YA and 159ZC of the Act.
- D. Under sections 227(1A) and 234A of the Act, TEIs and PTEs respectively must not charge domestic students a fee that exceeds the maximum specified as a condition on

funding approved by the TEC under sections 159YA and 159ZC of the Act.

Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003

Notice of Scope of Practice and Prescribed Qualifications for the Practice of Anaesthetic Technology in New Zealand*

Pursuant to sections 11 and 12 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003, this notice replaces the previous notice (published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 5 April 2012, No. 40, page 1201) issued by the Medical Sciences Council of New Zealand (“Council”).

This notice sets out the scope of practice and qualifications for the practice of anaesthetic technology in New Zealand as required by sections 11 and 12 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 (“Act”).

The Profession of Anaesthetic Technology

Anaesthetic technology is the provision of peri-operative technical management and patient care for supporting the provision of quality health care and safe anaesthetic services in New Zealand accredited health facilities.

Tasks included in this definition, but not limited to, are:

- anaesthetic related research and development;
- applied science and anaesthetic technology education;
- advanced patient monitoring;
- collection of samples for diagnostic investigation; and
- management.

Scope of Practice

The profession of anaesthetic technology contains one scope of practice of an anaesthetic technician.

Pursuant to section 11 of the Act, the Council specifies the anaesthetic technician scope of practice as:

An **anaesthetic technician** is a member of an anaesthetic care team, working collaboratively with other health professionals.

An **anaesthetic technician**:

- Utilises technical and clinical judgment to assess peri-operative requirements and provide patient care and assistance during all aspects of anaesthetic administration and during anaesthetic related procedures.
- Cannot prescribe and/or administer agents used for general anaesthesia and/or sedation independently. Administration of anaesthetic agents can only occur in an assisting role under the direction of a medical anaesthetist¹ or intensive care specialist.
- Provides support to the medical anaesthetist or intensive care specialist and collaborates and works alongside other health professionals during peri-operative, interventional and investigative procedures.
- Provides anaesthetic assistance in operating departments, radiology and MRI units, intensive care, obstetric and emergency departments and any other area where anaesthesia is administered.
- Provides support for the safe transportation of patients, both within the hospital environment and/or between hospitals or surgical healthcare facilities.
- Works as a team member alongside other health workers.²
- Provides physical and emotional support to the patient to enhance the safe outcome of anaesthetic procedures.
- Anticipates and prepares the equipment, monitoring and other requirements specific to each anaesthetic procedure.

The Council's Competencies for Anaesthetic Technicians describe the skills and activities of an anaesthetic technician.

Prescribed Qualifications

Pursuant to section 12 of the Act, the following qualifications are prescribed for registration as an anaesthetic technician:

1. A tertiary qualification in anaesthetic technology from a New Zealand university combined with relevant and specialised anaesthetic technology experience and successful completion of an anaesthetic technician examination, all of which are accredited and/or approved by the Council.
2. A course of training and/or examinations combined with relevant and specialised anaesthetic technology experience that, in the opinion of the Council, is substantially equivalent to the course of the New Zealand prescribed qualification.
3. Certification in anaesthetic technology by an authority outside New Zealand, combined with relevant and specialised anaesthetic technology experience and/or the successful completion of an anaesthetic technician examination, all of which are approved and/or accredited by the Council and that, in the opinion of the Council, is sufficient for registration as an anaesthetic technician.
4. New Zealand registered and enrolled nurses who have at least five years' post-nursing-qualification specialised anaesthetic technology experience in a New Zealand health facility may apply for registration as an anaesthetic technician. The nurse may be required to undergo a work-based assessment as approved by the Council.

Amendments to Betting Rules

Pursuant to section 52 of the Racing Act 2003, the New Zealand Racing Board ("Board") hereby gives notice of the following amendments to the Betting Rules published as a Supplement to the *New Zealand Gazette*, 25 August 2003, No. 113, page 2981.

Change #1**"4.16 Cancellation of Investments**

An Investor must ensure that their bet is placed correctly as the Board may refuse to cancel any bet without giving reason. Without limiting this power, the Board may refuse to cancel any bet for any of the following reasons:

- (a) The bet was placed via the Internet.
- (b) The bet was placed on an Authorised Event during "Live Betting".
- (c) The first Race involved in the bet has started.
- (d) The first Authorised Event involved in the bet has started.
- (e) The bet was placed on an Authorised Event during a break in play, and play has resumed.

- (f) The bet is a Fixed Odds bet and more than 60 seconds has elapsed since the bet was accepted by the Board.
- (g) The bet is a Totalisator Bet and more than 120 seconds has elapsed since the bet was accepted by the Board.”

Change #2**“5****CONDITIONS RELATING TO INVESTMENTS BY CASH****5.1 Acceptance and Issue of Bets**

- (a) The Board’s agent in charge of any Totalisator Agency may declare at any time that the office is closed for receiving cash Investments.
- (b) Only bank notes, coins or such other instruments for payment as the Board may determine from time to time shall be accepted.
- (c) On acceptance of the Investment by the Board, Investors will be issued with a bet on a printed ticket which must be presented when claiming any Dividend, Return or Refund due in respect of such bet.
- (d) Such tickets will be printed to show the date of issue, the name designated for the Race Meeting or event concerned, the selections, Ticket Value and such other particulars as may be required to identify the bet recorded.
- (e) Subject to the provisions of this Rule and Rule 4.16, the Investor shall be deemed to accept the ticket issued to him or her unless he or she applies within 120 seconds (for a Totalisator Bet) or 60 seconds (for a Fixed Odds Bet) of the bet being accepted by the Board for the rectification of any error or omission in the ticket.”

Change #3**“10.10.3 Commingling as Guest**

- (a) The New Zealand Racing Board may bet into a Merged Pool of a Commingling Partner as listed in Rule 10.10.6.
- (b) Subject to Rule 10.10.3(c), when Commingling as a Guest, the Betting Rules of the Host jurisdiction as they apply to the commingled pools will apply and will override the equivalent rule in New Zealand Racing Board’s General Betting Rules. The Betting Rules of the Host are listed in the appropriate Commingling Partner Appendix as defined in Rule 10.10.6.
- (c) Irrespective of the Controlling Body, the Board’s Betting Rules 4.16(g) that relate to the cancellation of Totalisator bets will apply to Commingled bets.

10.10.4 Commingling as Hub

- (a) The NZ Racing Board may bet into a Merged Pool of a Commingling Partner as listed in Rule 10.10.6 via a Hub.
- (b) Subject to Rules 10.10.3(c) and 10.10.3(d), when Commingling as a Hub, the Betting Rules of the Host jurisdiction as they apply to the commingled pools will apply and will override the equivalent rule in New Zealand Racing Board’s General Betting Rules. The Betting Rules of the Host are listed in the appropriate Commingling Partner Appendix as defined in Rule 10.10.6.
- (c) Irrespective of the Controlling Body, the Board’s Betting Rules 4.16(g) that relate to the cancellation of Totalisator bets will apply to Commingled bets.”

These Rules come into force on **19 May 2014**.
