Determination S14: Issue of Perpetual Non-cumulative Shares by BNZIS, and Related Transactions

"This determination may be cited as 'Determination S14: Issue of perpetual non-cumulative shares by BNZIS, and related transactions'.

1. Explanation (which does not form part of the determination)

- 1.1 This determination relates to an arrangement involving the issue of perpetual non-cumulative shares (the "BNZIS Shares") by BNZ Income Securities Limited ("BNZIS") to the public and National Equities Limited ("NEL") pursuant to an investment statement dated 25 February 2008. That arrangement is the subject of private ruling BR Prv 09/03 and product ruling BR Prd 09/02, issued on 5 February 2009, and is fully described in those rulings.
- 1.2 The BNZIS Shares are excepted financial arrangements. The BNZIS Shares form part of a wider financial arrangement including the investment by BNZIS of the proceeds of issue of the BNZIS Shares by way of a loan (the "BNZIM Loan") to BNZ Income Management Limited ("BNZIM"), and the use of the BNZIM Loan proceeds by BNZIM to subscribe for perpetual preference shares issued by BNZ (the "BNZ Preference Shares"). The BNZIS Shares are also subject to a call option ("Call Option") held by National Australia Bank Limited ("NAB"). BNZIS has entered into a Deed Poll ("Deed Poll") in favour of the BNZIS Shareholders, which applies if the dividends on the BNZIS Shares are not fully imputed and this results in a loss to a BNZIS Shareholder.
- 1.3 This wider financial arrangement has "excepted financial arrangement" components as defined in section EW 5 of the Income Tax Act 2007. The excepted financial arrangements are:
 - the BNZIS Shares;
 - the BNZ Preference Shares; and
 - the Call Option.
- 1.4 The amount of gross income deemed to be derived, or expenditure deemed to be incurred, by a person under the financial arrangement rules in respect of a financial arrangement excludes any amount of income, gain or loss, or expenditure that is solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement.
- 1.5 This determination prescribes a method to be used for determining the part of the consideration receivable by the parties to the arrangement that is attributable to the excepted financial arrangements.

2. Reference

2.1 This determination is made pursuant to section 90AC(1)(h) of the Tax Administration Act 1994.

3. Scope of Determination

- 3.1 This determination applies specifically to:
 - the BNZIS Shares;
 - the BNZ Preference Shares; and
 - the Call Option.

4. Principle

4.1 The BNZIS Shares, the BNZ Preference Shares, the Call Option and the BNZIM Loan are each part of a wider

financial arrangement which has "excepted financial arrangement" components as defined in section EW 5 of the Income Tax Act 2007. The excepted financial arrangements are:

- the BNZIS Shares;
- the BNZ Preference Shares; and
- the Call Option.
- 4.2 Any income, gain or loss, or expenditure that is solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement is not included when calculating gross income or expenditure under the financial arrangement rules.
- 4.3 This determination specifies that the amounts that are solely attributable to the excepted financial arrangements are the amounts paid under or with respect to the BNZIS Shares, the BNZ Preference Shares and the Call Option.
- 4.4 This determination specifies that no part of (inter alia) the amount advanced or repaid under the BNZIM Loan, or the interest paid on the BNZIM Loan, is solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement.

5. Interpretation

5.1 This determination has no specialised terms that need to be defined further.

6. Method

- 6.1 The amounts that are solely attributable to the BNZIS Shares are:
 - the issue price per BNZIS Share of \$1;
 - the dividends paid on the BNZIS Shares by BNZIS;
 - any amount paid by BNZIS under the Deed Poll where BNZIS has not fully imputed the dividends on the BNZIS Shares;
 - any other distributions paid on or with respect to the BNZIS Shares by BNZIS; and
 - any amounts paid to acquire the BNZIS Shares, whether pursuant to the Call Option or otherwise.
- 6.2 The amounts that are solely attributable to the BNZ Preference Shares are:
 - the issue price per BNZ Preference Share of \$1;
 - the dividends paid on the BNZ Preference Shares by BNZ:
 - any other distributions paid on or with respect to the BNZ Preference Shares by BNZ; and
 - any amounts paid to acquire the BNZ Preference Shares.
- 6.3 The amounts that are solely attributable to the Call Option are:
 - the amount paid to acquire the BNZIS Shares under the Call Option; and
 - the value of the BNZIS Shares transferred to a person nominated by NAB pursuant to the Call Option.

7. Example

BNZIS raised \$449,730,000 from the issue of the BNZIS Shares on 28 March 2008, and lent the same amount to BNZIM, at an interest rate of 9.89% per annum, payable quarterly on 28 March, June, September and December. Therefore, the amount of interest on the BNZIM Loan for each full quarter is \$11,119,574.

BNZIM used the funds to invest in BNZ Preference Shares.

The BNZIS Shares have traded on the NZDX at prices of from \$1 to \$1.10.

The amounts solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement are:

- the issue price of the BNZIS Shares;
- the dividend paid on the BNZIS Shares;

- the consideration paid for the purchase of BNZIS Shares on the NZDX;
- the issue price of the BNZ Preference Shares; and
- the dividend paid on the BNZ Preference Shares.

The amounts not solely attributable to an excepted financial arrangement are:

- the amount of the BNZIM Loan (\$449,730,000);
- the interest paid on the BNZIM Loan (\$11,119,574 per quarter);
- the amount paid by BNZIM to BNZIS under the BNZIM Loan as reimbursement for expenses incurred by BNZIS (provided that such expenses are not "non-integral fees", as defined in section YA1); and
- the amount to be repaid on the repayment of the BNZIM Loan.

- **3. Rates of Common Fund interest**—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.

Notice of Recommendation and Assessment Concerning the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 —Rule Amendment Proposal No. 133, 2009

- 1. This notice of a recommendation and assessment concerning the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 ("Rules"), Rule Amendment Proposal No. 133, 2009, is issued by the Electricity Commission ("Commission") pursuant to section 172E(3)(a)(iii) of the Electricity Act 1992 ("Act").
- 2. The Act provides that, no later than 10 working days after making a recommendation to the Minister of Energy and Resources ("Minister") concerning an earlier urgent amendment to the Rules, the Commission must publicise the recommendation and the assessment completed under section 172F of the Act.

Recommendation that the Minister not revoke, replace or amend the urgent rule amendment

- 3. Section 172E(3) of the Act provides that the Commission is not required to comply with section 172E(2)(b) and section 172F (relating to consultation and assessment) before making an urgent rule amendment, if it is considered necessary or desirable in the public interest for the rule amendment to be made urgently.
- 4. Instead, consultation and the assessment must be carried out within 6 months of the amendment being made.
- 5. On 18 September 2008, the Minister made an urgent amendment to part J of the Rules by publishing the Notice of Making of Electricity Governance Amendment Rules (No. 65) 2008 and Notice of Reasons for Decision*.
- 6. The urgent rule amendment was made to resolve an unanticipated issue that arose when new reconciliation rules came into force on 1 May 2008. The new reconciliation rules provide for a change from reconciliation on the basis of differencing to global reconciliation. That change distorted the seasonal adjustment shapes used for the reconciliation of non half-hour electricity volumes.
- 7. The distortion meant that allowing the process in the Rules to allocate non half-hour volumes of electricity over the 1 May 2008 boundary would have resulted in the inaccurate allocation of volumes between participants, which would have financially disadvantaged participants that were incumbent retailers before 1 May 2008 compared with participants that were independent retailers. The rule amendment resolves the issue by minimising the distortion, and the resulting financial disadvantage to participants that were incumbent retailers.
- 8. The Commission has assessed the options for achieving the objective of the rule amendment, issued a statement of proposal, and consulted with persons representative of interested persons likely to be substantially affected by the rule amendment. Three submissions were received in relation to the rule amendment.
- 9. In accordance with section 172E(3)(a) of the Act, having considered the three submissions received, on 16 February 2009 the Commission recommended to the Minister that the Minister not revoke, replace or amend the rule amendment.

Clause 3: Authorisation

- 3(1) Direct FX is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts other than futures contracts made on or effected through a recognised exchange.
- 3(2) The authorisation is subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) Direct FX deals only on behalf of its wholesale clients, being any client that is:
 - (i) a person who controls at least \$10 million; or
 - (ii) a trustee of a trust or a funds manager, acting in that capacity, who has under that person's control, as trustee or funds manager, net assets of at least \$10 million; or
 - (iii) a person who is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts under the Act; or
 - (iv) a person authorised in another jurisdiction by the competent authority of that jurisdiction to deal in futures contracts; or
 - (v) Her Majesty The Queen in right of New Zealand, a Crown entity named in the Crown Entities Act 2004, or a State enterprise named in the First or Second Schedule to the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986 (each as amended from time to time); or
 - (vi) a person who is a statutory corporation or a registered bank; or
 - (vii) a person whose principal business is the investment of money or who, in the course of and for the purposes of their business, habitually invests money; or
 - (viii) a person who is a related body corporate of any of the persons mentioned in subparagraphs (i) to (vii) above;
 - (b) before dealing in any futures contract in respect of which the authorisation applies, Direct FX is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the wholesale client is contracting:
 - (i) as principal on its own account; or
 - (ii) on behalf of a related body corporate; or
 - (iii) as trustee of a trust or manager of a managed fund; and
 - (c) Direct FX does not hold client money or client property in connection with dealing in futures contracts; and
 - (d) Direct FX is licensed as an Australian Financial Services Licensee under the Corporations Act and continues to hold an AFS Licence which authorises Direct FX to provide futures dealing and advisory services (at least in respect of foreign exchange contracts) to wholesale clients; and
 - (e) Direct FX notifies the Commission if Direct FX's AFS Licence is varied or revoked and notifies the Commission of any regulatory action taken by ASIC in relation to Direct FX's AFS Licence; and
 - (f) Direct FX provides the Commission with a copy of Direct FX's annual financial statements no later than 3 months after the end of each financial year for Direct FX; and
 - (g) Direct FX notifies the Commission of any material matter concerning Direct FX's authorisation as a futures dealer.

Pursuant to section 38 of the Securities Markets Act 1988, the Securities Commission gives the following notice.

Notice

Clause 1: Title, commencement and expiry

- 1(1) This notice is the Authorised Futures Dealers (Latitude FX Limited) Notice 2009.
- 1(2) This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its publication in the New Zealand Gazette.
- 1(3) This notice expires on the close of 28 February 2010.

Clause 2: Interpretation

- 2(1) In this notice, unless the context otherwise requires:
 - "Act" means the Securities Markets Act 1988.
 - "Advertisement" has the meaning given to it in section 2A of the Securities Act 1978, except that every reference to securities should be read as a reference to specified futures contracts, and every reference to the issuer should be read as a reference to the Company.
 - "Auditor" means the qualified auditor who has been appointed by the Company and entered into agreed-upon procedures with the Company in accordance with clause 6(1) and (2) of this notice.
 - "Company" means Latitude FX Limited.
 - "disclosure document" means a written document that describes and contains the offer of, and relates specifically to, a particular classes, or particular classes, of the specified futures contracts.
 - "Prescribed Liquid Funds Amount" is the amount specified in clause 5(3).
 - "qualified auditor" has the same meaning as in section 2C of the Securities Act 1978.
 - "Regulations" means the Futures Industry (Client Funds) Regulations 1990.
 - "specified futures contract" means a futures contract that is an option in respect of foreign currency or other forward foreign exchange contract that is issued by the Company and described in the disclosure document.
 - "Surplus Liquid Funds" has the meaning set out in clause 5(4).
- 2(2) Any term or expression that is defined in the Act or the Regulations and used, but not defined, in this notice has the same meaning as in the Act or the Regulations.

Clause 3: Authorisation

- 3(1) The Company is authorised to carry on the business of dealing in specified futures contracts.
- 3(2) The authorisation only applies to specified futures contracts to which the Company is, or intends to be, a party.
- 3(3) The authorisation is subject to the conditions that:
 - (a) the Company does not enter into specified futures contracts with any person other than a person who has entered into a written agreement with the Company, and then only in accordance with the terms of that agreement;
 - (b) before the Company enters into a specified futures contract with any person, that person has received a disclosure document that complies with the requirements of clause 4 of this notice;
 - (c) every advertisement for a specified futures contract must refer to a disclosure document that relates to the specified futures contracts referred to in the advertisement and that complies with clause 4 of this notice;
 - (d) no advertisement shall contain any information, sound, image or other matter that is inconsistent with any disclosure document referred to in the advertisement;
 - (e) any Company document that states the Company has been authorised by the Securities Commission to carry on the business of dealing in futures contracts includes a statement to the effect that:
 - (i) the Securities Commission's role in authorising futures dealers is limited and does not imply approval or endorsement of the business, trading or solvency of the Company; and
 - (ii) the Securities Commission has not approved any agreements or any disclosure documents of the Company;
 - (f) the Company complies with regulations 3 to 8, 14 to 17 and 22 to 24 of the Regulations as if the Company were a dealer for the purposes of those Regulations, and must, when a client's position is closed out, immediately pay any money owing to the client under that specified futures contract into a client bank account;
 - (g) the amount of a client's margin which is withdrawn from the client bank account in relation to a particular specified futures contract does not exceed the lesser of:
 - (i) the amount described in the disclosure document relating to that specified futures contract in accordance with clause 4(5)(d) of this notice; and
 - (ii) the amount of margin payable by the Company to another entity in respect of a contract entered into by the Company to back off its exposure under the specified futures contract in respect of which the client has paid that margin;
 - (h) the Company maintains proper records:
 - (i) to record dealings in respect of specified futures contracts with clients;
 - (ii) to record client money or property received, held or otherwise dealt with in connection with dealings in specified futures contracts; and

- (iii) which are audited or reviewed, and reported on, in accordance with the Regulations and the Financial Reporting Act 1993;
- (i) the Company's financial statements are prepared and registered as if the Company is an issuer in terms of the Financial Reporting Act 1993 and are audited at least once a year by a qualified auditor under the Financial Reporting Act 1993.
- (j) the Company sends a copy of its audited financial statements to the Securities Commission not more than three months after the end of each financial year;
- (k) the Company at all times meets the capital adequacy requirements set out in clause 5 of this notice;
- (1) the Company at all times meets the reporting requirements set out in clause 6 of this notice;
- (m) the Company maintains adequate professional indemnity insurance for its business at all times; and
- (n) the Company immediately notifies the Securities Commission in writing of any material matter concerning the Company's authorisation as a futures dealer, including the following events:
 - (i) The insolvency of the Company or the bankruptcy of any of its directors;
 - (ii) where the Company has failed to comply, or believes it will fail to comply, with the capital adequacy requirements set out in clause 5;
 - (iii) where a receiver, provisional liquidator, liquidator or a similar officer is appointed, or any resolution is passed or order made for the liquidation or dissolution of the Company;
 - (iv) if the Company, or any of its directors, is convicted of an indictable offence;
 - (v) any regulatory action taken against the Company, or any of its directors or senior management whether in New Zealand or elsewhere; and
 - (vi) if any director or member of the senior management leaves the Company or if any new director or member of senior management is appointed to the Company.

Clause 4: Further conditions relating to disclosure documents

- 4(1) The disclosure document must include information that would enable a prudent but non-expert investor to make a decision about whether to invest in a specified futures contract of that class.
- 4(2) The disclosure document must include at the front of the disclosure document a statement describing a clients' right under the Act to receive investment advisers' disclosure from any person who gives the client investment advice in relation to the specified futures contract;
- 4(3) The disclosure document must remain up-to-date and continue to comply with clause 4 at all times, and may be amended by the Company at any time for this purpose;
- 4(4) The disclosure document must state, in a prominent place, the date as at which the disclosure document was prepared, and the date of every amendment that has been made to that disclosure document;
- 4(5) The disclosure document must contain all of the following information that is applicable to the class or classes of specified futures contracts to which the disclosure document relates, and must continue to contain all of the following information at the time the specified futures contract is entered into:
 - (a) a description of the key terms and features of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (b) the name and contact details of the Company;
 - (c) a description of the amounts payable, or the method of calculating the amounts payable, by a person to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, including the consequences of failing to make any payments;
 - (d) a description of the amounts, or the method of calculating the amounts, of any margins, including initial margins and variation margins, payable by a person to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contract, including the consequences of failing to pay any margin;
 - (e) a description of the treatment of margins, including initial margins and variation margins, payable by a person to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (f) a description of the types of fees or charges payable by a person, directly or indirectly, to the Company in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (g) a description of the rights of the Company or any other person to alter any of the fees or charges applicable to that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (h) a description of the nature of any amounts or returns that may be payable, or the method of calculating any amounts or returns that may be payable, by the Company to a person in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (i) a description of the key factors that determine the amounts or returns that may be payable by the Company to a person in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (j) a description of the principal risks associated with entering into that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, including any specific risk factors that apply to any one or more of the particular specified futures contracts;
 - (k) if it is reasonably foreseeable that, at the end of the arrangement relating to that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, a person will have received, in total, less than the amount paid to the Company for the specified futures contracts, a statement to this effect and a brief description of the circumstances that may produce this result;
 - (1) a description of the parties' rights to alter the terms of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts;
 - (m) a description of the parties' rights to terminate, cancel, surrender, or otherwise make or obtain payment of any amounts or returns in respect of that class or those classes of specified futures contracts, other than as described in paragraphs (h) and (i);

- (n) a statement as to whether a person is entitled to sell his or her interest in a specified futures contract to another person and, if so, whether in the opinion of the Company there is an established market for such sales;
- (o) a description of the treatment of client money or property received, held or otherwise dealt with in connection with dealing in specified futures contracts, other than as described in paragraph (e);
- (p) the names or descriptions, and the addresses and business telephone numbers, of officers, employees, or agents of the Company to whom enquiries about the specified futures contracts can be made, and to whom complaints about the specified futures contracts can be made;
- (q) a statement to the effect that other information about the Company is contained or referred to in financial statements of, or relating to, the Company and where a copy of the latest financial statements may be obtained from;
- (r) a statement of the type of information that is required to be, or otherwise will be, given to clients periodically;
- (s) a statement describing the type of information that is required to be, or otherwise will be, available on request from the Company, and a statement explaining how a request for this information should be made;
- (t) a statement whether any charge may be made for the information referred to in paragraph (s) and the amount of any charge; and
- (u) any other material matters applicable to that class or those classes of specified futures contracts.
- 4(6) If a matter specified in clause 4(5) is not applicable to the class or classes of specified futures contracts to which a disclosure document relates, the disclosure document is not required to refer to that matter, and is not required to state that the matter is not applicable.
- 4(7) Nothing in clause 4(5) limits the information, statements or other matters that may be contained in a disclosure document.

Clause 5: Capital adequacy requirements

- 5(1) The Company must at all times be able to pay its debts as they become due in the normal course of business.
- 5(2) The Company must ensure that its Surplus Liquid Funds exceeds at all times its Prescribed Liquid Funds Amount.
- 5(3) The Company's Prescribed Liquid Funds Amount is \$1,000,000.00.
- 5(4) The Company's Surplus Liquid Funds is the aggregate of all of its Liquid Assets, less any risk based reductions to its Liquid Assets, less its Gross External Liabilities.
- 5(5) The Company's Liquid Assets are:
 - (a) cash;
 - (b) cash equivalents (as defined by NZ IAS 7);
 - (c) trade receivables realisable within the next 3 months; and

 - (a) any client funds held by the Company;
 - (b) the value of any asset encumbered as a security against another person's liability;
 - (c) the assets of any trust of which the Company is a trustee;
 - (d) loans and advances to, or amounts owing by, any related party or associate; and
 - (e) any asset that directly or indirectly funds an investment in or loan to the Company itself.
- 5(7) The Company must apply the following risk based reductions to the calculation of its Liquid Assets:
 - (a) For a futures contract entered into where the client has not paid to the futures dealer any margin due in respect of that futures contract by the 2nd business day following the date the liability to make that margin payment arose, a reduction of 120% on that uncollected margin;
 - (b) for equity securities held or receivable by that dealer including short positions:
 - (i) for leading equities (meaning NZSX listed equities or equities listed on the main board of an overseas exchange):
 - A. 10% for an equity ranked 1 to 50 in the leading index of the relevant exchange; or
 - B. 15% for all other equities quoted on the main board; and
 - (ii) for rights, the lesser of:
 - A. 100%, or
 - B. 10% of the combined value of rights and application monies; and
 - (iii) for other equity securities (including partly paid shares), 100%;
 - (c) for Liquid Assets comprising debt securities in New Zealand dollars:

- 5(8) The Company's Gross External liabilities include its current, long-term and contingent liabilities, whether or not those contingent liabilities appear on the Company's statements of financial position.
- 5(9) In calculating the Company's Gross External Liabilities, that calculation excludes:

 - (b) the liabilities of any trust of which the Company is a trustee.

Clause 6: Reporting requirements

- 6(1) The Company must:
 - (a) appoint an Auditor;
 - (b) appoint a compliance officer with responsibility for ensuring compliance with this Authorisation Notice;
 - (c) make available to the Auditor any information the Auditor requests to satisfy itself that the Company has complied with the capital adequacy requirements in clause 5.
- 6(2) The Company must enter into agreed-upon procedures with the Auditor, a copy of which must be filed with the Commission before the agreed-upon procedures are executed, which provide for (without limitation):
 - (a) the Auditor to receive the monthly reports referred to in clause 6(3) and semi-annual prospective financial statements referred to in clause 6(8) from the Company;
