(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

3. Rates of Common Fund interest—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.

(2) The rate of Common Fund interest on each protection deposit associated with a particular private training establishment shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate dollar range of the total of those deposits.

(3) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 3 for the appropriate interest payment frequency, term and dollar range.

(4) Despite subparagraph (1), the rate of Common Fund interest payable on deposits made pursuant to an enactment shall be the rate (if any) specified in the enactment.

This notice, which is issued following amendments to section 139E and 307AB of the Education Act 1989 ("the Act"), identifies moneys paid under section 139E of the Act (TeachNZ Scholarships) as allowances to which section 307AB of the Act applies, and declares those allowances to be bonded scholarships.

Identification as an allowance under section 307AB of the Act allows the Ministry of Social Development to require institutions and private training establishments to supply information pursuant to sections 226A and 238B of the Act in order to verify any person's entitlement to that allowance and the amount to which they are entitled.

The effect of the declaration as a bonded scholarship is that section 2A of the Student Loan Scheme Act 1992 applies to enable the recovery of money in accordance with the terms of the scholarship.

Income Tax (Transitional Provisions) Programme

Pursuant to sections 5 and 124(1)(d) of the Social Security Act 1964, the Minister for Social Development and Employment establishes and approves the following welfare programme for special assistance.

Programme

1. Title—This programme is the Income Tax (Transitional Provisions) Programme.

2. Commencement—This programme comes into effect on 1 October 2008.

3. Purpose—The purpose of this programme is to provide for a transitional period for people in receipt of certain benefits under the Act, so that any reduction in those benefits during this period due to the impact of changes to income tax thresholds and family tax credits on 1 October 2008 takes place in the context of a review of their circumstances.

4. Interpretation—(1) In this programme, unless the context otherwise requires:

Act means the Social Security Act 1964

eligible person means a person to whom any of clauses 6 to 9 applies

transitional assistance or **assistance** means the special assistance under this programme

weekly compensation has the same meaning as in section 71A(3) of the Act.

(2) For the purposes of clause 11(c), the terms **chargeable income** and **standard costs** have the meanings given to them in the Direction in relation to Special Benefit given on 10 February 1999.

(3) For the purposes of clause 11(d), the terms **chargeable income** and **standard costs** have the meanings given to them by the Social Security (Temporary Additional Support) Regulations 2005.

(4) Expressions otherwise defined in section 3(1) of the Act have the same meanings in this programme.

5. Application of the Social Security Act—(1) Sections 3, 10A, 11, 12, 62, 63, 63A, 64, 66, 66A, 66B, 68, 68A, 70, 71, 73, 74, 74A, 74AA, 76, 77, 78, 80A, 81, 82, 82A, 83, 84 and 86J of the Act apply to and in respect of this programme and to an eligible person as if the special assistance authorised by this programme were a benefit.

(2) Nothing in subclause (1) limits or affects the application of any other provision of the Act.

6. Beneficiaries receiving accommodation supplement—This clause applies to a person who, immediately before 1 October 2008, was receiving an accommodation supplement granted under section 61EC of the Act.

7. Beneficiaries receiving income-tested benefits and weekly compensation—This clause applies to a person who, immediately before 1 October 2008, was receiving an income-tested benefit and—

- (a) was receiving weekly compensation in respect of the person or his or her spouse or partner or a dependent child; or
- (b) the person's spouse or partner was receiving weekly compensation.

8. Beneficiaries receiving special benefit—This clause applies to a person who, immediately before 1 October 2008, was receiving a special benefit continued under

section 23 of the Social Security (Working for Families) Amendment Act 2004.

9. Beneficiaries receiving temporary additional support—This clause applies to a person who, immediately before 1 October 2008, was receiving temporary additional support granted under section 61G of the Act.

10. Transitional assistance—The effect of this programme is to create an entitlement to transitional assistance for eligible persons in accordance with clauses 11 and 12.

11. Amount of assistance—The amount of transitional assistance granted to an eligible person:

- (a) to whom clause 6 applies is such difference between the amount of accommodation supplement that was payable to that person immediately before 1 October 2008 and the amount payable to the person immediately after that date as is attributable to:
 - (i) the increase to the annual rate of family tax credit payable in respect of an eldest, or first, dependent child under subparts ma to mf and mz of the Income Tax Act 2007; and
 - (ii) the increase to the person's New Zealand superannuation or veteran's pension arising from the change to the income tax deduction rates on 1 October 2008.
- (b) to whom clause 7 applies is such difference between the amount of weekly compensation that was deductible from the person's income-tested benefit immediately before 1 October 2008 and the amount deductible from the person's benefit after that date as is attributable to the changes to the income tax deduction rates that take effect on 1 October 2008.
- (c) to whom clause 8 applies is such difference between the amount of special benefit that was payable to the person immediately before 1 October 2008 and the amount payable to the person after that date as is attributable to the increases to the person's chargeable income and standard costs arising from:
 - (i) the increase to the person's rate of family tax credit payable under subparts ma to mf and mz of the Income Tax Act 2007; and
 - (ii) the increase to the person's income arising from the change to the income tax deduction rates on 1 October 2008.
- (d) to whom clause 9 applies is such difference between the amount of temporary additional support that was payable to the person immediately before 1 October 2008 and the amount payable to the person after that date as is attributable to the increases to the person's chargeable income and standard costs arising from:
 - (i) the increase to the person's rate of family tax credit payable under subparts ma to mf and mz of the Income Tax Act 2007; and
 - (ii) the increase to the person's income arising from the change to the income tax deduction rates on 1 October 2008.

12. Commencement of assistance—Assistance under clause 10 commences on 1 October 2008.

13. Ending and suspension of assistance—(1) Assistance under clause 10 ends if the benefit in respect of which it was granted ends, and is suspended while the benefit in respect of which it was granted is suspended.

(2) If it has not ended earlier, assistance under clause 10 ends not later than the date the eligible person dies, or any of the following earlier applies:

- (a) in the case of any assistance, the person's benefit is reviewed under section 81 of the Act as a result of a change of circumstances or otherwise;
- (b) in the case of any assistance granted to a person to whom clause 9 applies, the 13-week period for which his or her temporary additional support was granted ends, whether or not that benefit is re-granted.

14. Expiry—This programme expires with the close of 31 March 2009.

15. Consequential amendment—Clause 2.1 of the Direction in relation to Special Benefit given on 10 February 1999* is amended by inserting in paragraph (f)(i)† of the definition of chargeable income “the Income Tax (Transitional Provisions) Programme” after “the care supplement programme”.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the programme, but is intended to explain its general effect.

This programme, which comes into effect on 1 October 2008, provides for transitional assistance to ensure that people receiving certain social security benefits, who would be adversely affected by the impact of the reduction in income tax rates or increases in the family tax credit rates that take effect on 1 October 2008, are not affected until their benefits are next reviewed for whatever reason or, in the case of temporary additional support, the period for which the benefit is granted ends, whichever is earlier.

- 1. Title**—This amendment is the Special Needs Grants Amendment (No. 4) 2008.
- 2. Commencement**—This amendment comes into effect on 15 September 2008.
- 3. Programme amended**—This amendment amends the Special Needs Grants Programme.
- 4. Other Emergency Grants**—Clause 14 is amended by adding the following clauses:

“14.5 This clause applies where an applicant seeks a grant under clause 14.1—

- (a) for the purpose of paying an application fee for a New Zealand birth certificate that is required by the chief executive as supporting evidence under section 11D(2)(b) of the Act; or
- (b) for the purpose of paying an application or any other fee for a document of identification that is required by the chief executive as supporting evidence under section 11D(2)(b) of the Act.

14.6 Where clause 14.5 applies, clause 4.1 of the programme applies to clause 14.1 as if it did not include reference to section 76 of the Act.

14.7 The chief executive must not make a grant under clause 14.1 for the purpose set out in clause 14.5(b) unless the applicant's birth is not registered in New Zealand.”

5. Grants to Farmers, Orchardists, etc.†—(1) Clause 18.2 is amended by revoking paragraph (c).

(2) Clause 18.3A is amended by revoking paragraph (c).

(3) The table in clause 18.8 is amended by omitting “75 percent of” in each place it appears.

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the programme, but is intended to explain its general effect.

This amendment to the Special Needs Grants Programme, which comes into effect on 15 September 2008, allows an applicant to be granted a special needs grant for the purpose of paying the application fee for a New Zealand birth certificate or a document of identification as supporting evidence for an application for a benefit under the Act, before that person is released from prison. A grant for the purpose of paying the application fee for an identification document other than a New Zealand birth certificate is only available where the applicant's birth is not registered in New Zealand.

This instrument also makes amendments to the Part of the programme that provides for Special Assistance to the Rural Sector. Criteria that a farmer has made a decision to sell their land-based industry at a price the chief executive considers to be realistic, or is in the process of actively evaluating the ongoing viability of the land based industry before assistance can be granted, are omitted from the programme. The maximum amount of assistance available is also raised from 75 percent to 100 percent of the applicable rate of unemployment benefit and sickness benefit.

Crown Entities Act 2004

Whole of Government Direction Regarding All-Of-Government Shared Authentication Services, Given to Crown Agents by the Minister of State Services and the Minister of Finance Under Section 107 of the Crown Entities Act 2004

The following direction has come into force under section 109 of the Crown Entities Act 2004.

Under that section, a whole-of-government direction given under section 107 comes into force 15 sitting days after it is presented to the House of Representatives unless the House resolves, in that period, to disapply the direction.

Direction regarding all-of-government shared authentication services

1. The Minister of State Services and the Minister of Finance, pursuant to section 107 of the Crown Entities Act 2004, direct all Crown agents as follows:
 - (1) before developing a proposal to invest in or build online credential management or identity verification capability as an alternative to using all-of-government shared authentication services (known upon the giving of this direction as the

Government Logon Service and the Identity Verification Service), whether the proposal is to be funded from retained depreciation funding or from new funding, to consult with the State Services Commission; and

(2) if, after such consultation:

- (i) the Crown agent still intends to invest in or build alternative online credential management or identity verification capability; and
- (ii) the State Services Commission has not agreed, either in the individual case or by reference to a generic class consent, to the Crown agent investing in or building alternative online credential management or identity verification capability,

the Crown agent must obtain the approval of its responsible Minister and the Minister of State Services before taking action to implement the proposal,

unless any requirement in this clause 1 would be inconsistent with section 113 of the Crown Entities Act 2004.

2. For the purposes of this direction:

- (1) “online credential management” means the use of logons, such as (but not limited to) passwords or two-factor authentication, for ongoing confirmation of identity when accessing a secure online service, whether the service is made available to audiences external to the Crown agent or is only accessible to audiences within or serving the Crown agent itself;
- (2) “identity verification” means the establishment and re-confirmation of the identity and identity attributes of a person; and
- (3) “generic class consent” means a decision, made by the State Services Commission, to grant consent to a particular class of online service, application or use-case for the purposes of clause 1(2)(ii) of this direction without the need to consider the individual circumstances of individual proposals falling within that class.

Electricity Commission

Electricity Act 1992

Notice of Making of Electricity Governance Amendment Rules (No. 65) 2008 and Notice of Reasons for Decision

1. Pursuant to section 172I of the Electricity Act 1992 ("Act"), I notify the amendment of the Electricity Governance Rules 2003 ("Rules") under section 172H of the Act.
2. The empowering provision for the Electricity Governance Regulations in relation to which the Rules are amended is section 172D(1)(1)(b) of the Act.
3. The amendment is to insert a new Rule 11.4.9 into Part J of the Rules, to put in place a new process for reconciling non half hour submission information for the period for which transitional revisions are required, to ensure that the financial disadvantage to incumbent retailers that results from the change from reconciliation on the basis of differencing, to global reconciliation, is minimised.
4. The amendment is made under urgency in reliance on section 172E(3) of the Act.
5. Pursuant to section 172Z(4) of the Act, the reason for my decision to amend the Rules is that the insertion of Rule

11.4.9 in Part J of the Rules resolves an issue that has arisen in relation to the seasonal adjustment shapes required to be calculated and published under the Rules. The issue is a consequence of the transition from reconciliation on the basis of differencing, to global reconciliation. If the reconciliation process, otherwise set out in the Rules, were allowed to operate, it would:

- (a) result in the inaccurate allocation of electricity volume between participants; and

Veterinarians Act 2005

Minimum Standards for Practising as a Veterinarian: Amendment Notice 2008 (No. 1)

Pursuant to section 75(i) of the Veterinarians Act 2005, the Veterinary Council of New Zealand sets out in this notice* the following prescribed minimum standards for practising as a veterinarian:

1. Fitness to Practise

A veterinarian must be fit in order to maintain his or her practising certificate and to practise as a veterinarian in New Zealand.

Matters that may bring a person’s fitness to practise into question can include:

- the contracting of any addictive, mental or physical condition;
- any addictive or inappropriate taking of drugs or alcohol;
- a formal competence enquiry from an employer;
- an adverse finding in any disciplinary action by an employer or licensing or professional body; and

- a guilty finding in any criminal proceeding (including traffic offences involving alcohol or drugs for which the maximum penalty is not less than three months’ imprisonment).

All persons are required to provide the council with a statement about their fitness to practise when they apply for registration or for a practising certificate.

The council may also examine a person (section 25(a)), require statutory declarations (section 25(b)), require other information (section 25(c)) and take various actions under specific, relevant sections of the Act.

2. Competence to Practise

(a) Competency Standards

Pursuant to section 88(3) of the Veterinarians Act 2005, the council refers persons to the document “Competency Standards and Performance Indicators for Veterinarians” available on the council’s website

www.vetcouncil.org.nz

and from the council’s office on request. This document sets out the competency standards council expects veterinarians to meet, at the point of initial registration, and on an ongoing basis, and provides criteria against which an individual veterinarian’s performance may be measured.

(b) Recency of Practice

For any person who has not worked as a veterinarian for five consecutive years, or has not worked as a veterinarian for five consecutive years in the area in which they intend to practise, the council may examine the person (sections 11(a) and 25(a)) and may if it is necessary place conditions upon the person’s practising certificate (section 26(3)(c)).

(c) Continuing Professional Development

The council requires veterinarians to record and report their professional development.

Under section 25, when considering an application for a practising certificate, the council may require the applicant to provide any document or information that the council considers, on reasonable grounds, is necessary to assess his or her application.

The council may use this section and section 26 where veterinarians have not reported on their professional development for more than two consecutive years.
