3. Every service provider for a licensed early childhood education and care service or certificated playgroup must implement the Curriculum Framework in accordance with the requirements (if any) prescribed in regulations made under Part 26 of the Education Act 1989.

4. Licensed early childhood education and care services and certificated playgroups must implement the Principles and the Strands, and can opt to use either the English or the te reo Māori versions set out in Part A or Part B of clause 6, or both. Kōhanga reo affiliated with Te Kōhanga Reo National Trust must implement Part C of clause 6.

5. The purpose of the Curriculum Framework is to provide the basis and context underpinning specific curriculum regulatory requirements in the Education (Early Childhood Services) Regulations 2008 or the Education (Playgroups) Regulations 2008 relating to the standards of education and care and to the associated curriculum criteria.

4. The DAA must immediately notify the Ministry in writing of any significant change to the DAA, including but not restricted to:
 - any change in ownership and/or control of the legal entity;
 - any change in management personnel;
 - any change to the Auditor Register (refer to condition 7);
 - any change in the status of any third party accreditation the DAA may hold including evidence of such accreditation and copies of any Third Party Accreditation Audit Reports or notifications in respect of their accreditation.

5. The DAA must conduct, as a minimum, at least one annual:
 - internal audit that focuses on the DAA's auditing activities undertaken pursuant to the Act, together with a compliance audit against the requirements of the DAA as set out in the Act; and
 - management review in respect of the DAA's programmes operated pursuant to the Act.

6. The DAA shall at all times operate an internal appeals system which is documented and conveyed in writing to all clients. Auditable records of the facts and outcomes of all client appeals shall be maintained by the DAA. The DAA must provide these records to the Ministry when requested in writing by the Ministry.

7. The DAA must provide in a timely manner when requested by the Ministry in writing the details of the name, auditing qualifications and experience, and if relevant, the area of clinical or service competency of each auditor or technical expert approved by the DAA to undertake audits pursuant to the Act.

This designation expires on 22 July 2011.

1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 24 July 2008.

(2) The determinations and revocation in this notice take effect from and including 16 July 2008.

2. Interpretation—(1) Unless the context otherwise requires:

"agency deposit" means a deposit (not being an investment deposit) held as agent or attorney;

"call deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit, a special deposit or a trust deposit) held in the ordinary course of administration, and determined by Public Trust to be held at call;

"deposit" means a sum of money held by Public Trust belonging to any estate, which money for the time being forms part of the Common Fund;

"investment deposit" means a deposit held at call or otherwise as an investment under section 51 of the Act;

"protection deposit" means a deposit, held at call, of tuition, boarding, accommodation or other fees by or on behalf of a student enrolled at a private training establishment within the meaning of Part 18 of the Education Act 1989;

"special deposit" means a deposit held other than at call on behalf of the Crown, or any local authority within the meaning of the Local Government Act 1974;

"trust deposit" means a deposit (not being an agency deposit, an investment deposit, a protection deposit or a special deposit) held on trust:

400for persons not of full age or capacity; or

(ii) for beneficiaries not entitled to payment at call; or

(iii) otherwise than at call.

(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

3. Rates of Common Fund interest—(1) The rate of Common Fund interest on deposits (other than investment deposits repayable at the end of fixed term or protection deposits) shall be that specified in Schedule 1 for the appropriate type of deposits.

(2) The rate of Common Fund interest on each protection deposit associated with a particular private training establishment shall be that specified in Schedule 2 for the appropriate dollar range of the total of those deposits.

(3) The rate of Common Fund interest payable on investment deposits repayable at the end of a fixed term shall be that specified in Schedule 3 for the appropriate interest payment frequency, term and dollar range.

(4) Despite subparagraph (1), the rate of Common Fund interest payable on deposits made pursuant to an enactment shall be the rate (if any) specified in the enactment.

(5) Despite subparagraphs (1), (2) and (3), in particular cases or classes of case, Public Trust and the depositor may agree on a rate of interest payable on investment deposits,

protection deposits or special deposits that is different from the rate specified in Schedules 1, 2, or 3 and the agreed rate then applies.

4. Revocation of notice and transitional provisions—

(1) The Public Trust Common Fund Interest Rates Notice 17 July 2008 is revoked.

Cosmetic Products Group Standard (Amendment) Notice 2008

Pursuant to section 96B of the Hazardous Substances and New Organisms Act 1996 ("the Act"), the Environmental Risk Management Authority ("Authority") issues the following notice.

Notice

1. Title—(1) This notice is the Cosmetic Products Group Standard (Amendment) Notice 2008 and is part of the principal notice.

(2) In this notice, "principal notice" means the Hazardous Substances (Group Standards) Notice 2006 (Supplement to the *New Zealand Gazette*, 30 June 2006, No. 74, page 1889), Part 10, Cosmetic Products Group Standard (at page 2069)¹.

2. Commencement—This notice comes into force 28 days after the date of notification in the *New Zealand Gazette*.

3. Amendments to principal notice—

3.1 Insert into Schedule 1, Part 1, clause 2 of the notice the following clauses:

"(2A) Labels complying with clause 2(2)(a) must also contain a list of ingredients in accordance with the following priority:

400a list of the ingredients in the product (except colour additives) in concentrations of 1% or more in descending order by volume or mass; and

(ii) a list of the ingredients in the product (except colour additives) in concentrations of less than 1% in any order; and

(iii) colour additives in any order; and

(iv) flavour or flavours, which must be described in the list of ingredients by:

(a) the words, "flavour" or "flavours" or "aroma" or "aromas"; or

(b) the ingredients in the flavour or flavours; and

(v) fragrance or fragrances, which must be described in the list of ingredients by:

(a) the words, "fragrance" or "fragrances" or "parfum" or "parfums"; or

(b) the ingredients in the fragrance or fragrances."

"(4A) Despite clause (2)(4) a primary sunscreen may be labelled in accordance with the requirements of the 'Therapeutic Goods Order No. 69 General Requirements for Labels for Medicines, published by Australian GPO, Commonwealth of Australia, 2001'."

"(4B) Despite clause (2)(4) a cosmetic product containing a component at reference numbers 67–92 of Schedule 5 may not be labelled with the name of that component, provided the label lists the fragrance or fragrances, which must be described by the words, 'fragrance' or 'fragrances' or 'parfum' or 'parfums'; or the ingredients in the fragrance or fragrances."

3.2 Insert a new Schedule 2A "Transitional Provisions – Amendments 2008"

(1) For a period of 12 months from the date this notice is notified in the *New Zealand Gazette* persons dealing with substances covered by the principal notice may either comply with:

(a) the principal notice; or

(b) the principal notice, as amended by this notice.

(2) Clause (1) does not apply to:

(a) a substance that was not lawfully used in New Zealand immediately before this notice comes into force; or

(b) an oral hygiene product which does not comply with the requirements of Schedule 5, Table 2, reference No. 1 of this notice.

3.3 Insert the following definition in Schedule 3 of the principal notice:

"**ingredients** means the components present in a cosmetic product, but does not include:

- impurities in the raw materials used;
- subsidiary technical materials used in the preparation of the product but not present in the final product;
- materials used in strictly necessary quantities as solvents or as carriers for perfume and aromatic compositions".

3.4 Omit Schedule 4 of the principal notice and substitute new Schedule 4: "Components cosmetic products must not contain."

3.5 Omit the table in Schedule 5 of the principal notice and insert new tables:

(a) Table 1: "Components Cosmetic Products may contain with restrictions".

(b) Table 2: "Components Cosmetic Products may contain with restrictions in New Zealand"; and

(c) Table 3: "Components Cosmetic Products may contain provisionally with restrictions".

3.6 Omit Schedule 6 of the principal notice and substitute new Schedule 6: "Colouring agents cosmetic products may contain with restrictions".

3.7 Omit Schedule 7 of the principal notice and substitute new Schedule 7: "Preservatives cosmetic products may contain with restrictions".

Explanatory Note

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

*This notice, which comes into force 28 days after the date of notification in the **New Zealand Gazette**, amends the Cosmetic Products Group Standard 2006 to incorporate changes made to the EU Cosmetic Directive into the Group Standard.*

This notice also adds a restriction on the use of diethylene glycol in oral hygiene products including toothpaste to address safety concerns and modifies labelling requirements for primary sunscreens.

The Authority has also amended the Explanatory Note of the principal notice to indicate that face and body paints and toy cosmetic products are within the scope of the Group Standard.
