1. This notice may be cited as Te Wharekura o Tauranga Moana, Tauranga, Establishment.
2. This notice shall come into force the day after its publication in the *New Zealand Gazette*.
3. I hereby establish in Tauranga, a Years 7–13 co-educational secondary school called Te Wharekura o Tauranga Moana and designate the school as a designated character school.
4. Te Wharekura o Tauranga Moana will operate with the following aims, purposes and objectives which will together constitute its designated character:
 - (i) Te Wharekura o Tauranga Moana will provide a unique educational opportunity for its rohe encompassing the iwi of Tauranga Moana in all aspects of its operation. To this end it will require all staff and curriculum of the school to implement the aims, purposes and objectives set out in the school's charter.
 - (ii) The kaupapa of the school will stem from the iwi belonging to Tauranga Moana. Principles of kaupapa Māori will permeate all aspects of the school, impacting on how the school's governing body will operate, the way in which teaching programmes will be designed and implemented, and how the students will be treated.
 - (iii) Te Wharekura o Tauranga Moana will offer an education that is based on whanaungatanga principles, with bilingual and bicultural staff that have relevant expertise, qualifications and experience and are knowledgeable about Māoritanga and can incorporate it into their work.
 - (iv) The history and tikanga of Tauranga Moana will be integrated into the educational programmes.
 - (v) Children with tribal affiliations outside Tauranga Moana will be welcomed and encouraged into the school. The kawa and tikanga of other tribal groups will be respected.
 - (vi) The school will have a Māori language immersion programme operating from Year 7 to Year 13. There may be English medium programmes in addition to ensure that students are well prepared for the English language environment they may move into on leaving school.
 - (vii) Kaupapa Māori governing principles and values will operate in the wharekura. These principles and values are manaakitanga (caring), wairuatanga (spirituality), mātauranga (knowledge acquisition), hauora (physical wellbeing), mana (respect and dignity) and te reo Māori. Te reo Māori will be considered to be one of the most important principles because it forms the basis (pūtaketanga) of the Māori culture.

Constitution of the Establishment Board of Trustees

5. The Board of Trustees of Te Wharekura o Tauranga Moana shall be comprised of:

- (a) five people appointed by the Minister of Education;
- (b) the principal or principal designate; and
- (c) not more than four people co-opted by the board.

(2) Expressions defined in the Act have the same meaning in this notice as they do in the Act.

This notice of a recommendation and assessment for gas governance regulations is issued by Gas Industry Company Limited ("Gas Industry Co") approved as the industry body by Order in Council under section 43ZL of the Gas Act 1992 ("the Act").

Section 43O of the Act provides that, no later than 10 working days after making a recommendation for a gas governance regulation to the Minister of Energy, Gas Industry Co must publicise the recommendation and the assessment completed under section 43N of the Act.

Recommendation

On 30 June 2008, Gas Industry Co made a recommendation to the Minister of Energy, under sections 43F(2)(a)(vi) and 43S of the Act, for approval of the Gas Governance (Critical Contingency Management) Regulations to provide for the establishment of a critical contingency management regime.

The purpose of the regulations is to:

- identify the onset of a critical contingency;
- establish procedures for effective management of a critical contingency;
- provide for the appointment of a critical contingency operator (CCO) whose primary role is to restore the supply/demand balance by targeted curtailment of load; and
- establish a price which is used to settle inadvertent trading between those parties whose supplies have failed and those parties who have access to supplies but whose customers have been curtailed.

A recommendation for amended regulations providing for compliance with, and enforcement of, the Gas Governance (Critical Contingency Management) Regulations was made in conjunction with this recommendation.

Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003

Notice Replacing Prescribed Scopes of Practice and Related Qualifications

Pursuant to sections 11 and 12 of the Health Practitioners Competence Assurance Act 2003 ("the Act"), the following notice is given.

This notice replaces the notice of the Medical Radiation Technologists Board ("the board") dated the 24th day of March 2005 and published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 24 March 2005, No. 56, page 1454.

Scopes of Practice

Pursuant to section 11(1) of the Act, the board specifies eight scopes of practice within the profession of medical radiation technology as follows:

1. Scope of Practice – Diagnostic Imaging – General

Practises Diagnostic Imaging – General:

Involves the use of ionising radiation to gain a diagnostic image for evaluation.

2. Scope of Practice – Radiation Therapist

Practises Radiation Therapy:

Involves the use of treatment planning systems, ionising radiation and radionuclides for radiation treatment planning and delivery.

3. Scope of Practice – Nuclear Medicine Technologist

Practises Diagnostic Imaging – Nuclear Medicine:

Involves the use of radionuclides to gain a diagnostic image for evaluation.

4. Scope of Practice – Sonographer

Practises Diagnostic Imaging – Ultrasound:

Involves the use of ultrasound waves to gain a diagnostic image for evaluation.

5. Scope of Practice – Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technologist

Practises Diagnostic Imaging – Magnetic Resonance Imaging:

Involves the use of magnetic resonance to gain a diagnostic image for evaluation.

6. Scope of Practice – Trainee Nuclear Medicine Technologist

Undertaking training in an approved medical radiation technology programme in nuclear medicine imaging.

7. Scope of Practice – Trainee Sonographer

Undertaking postgraduate training in an approved medical radiation technology programme in ultrasound.

8. Scope of Practice – Trainee Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technologist

Undertaking postgraduate training in an approved medical radiation technology programme in magnetic resonance imaging.

Qualifications Prescribed for Registration

Pursuant to section 12 of the Act, the following qualifications are prescribed for registration as a medical radiation technologist:

1. Diagnostic Imaging – General

A New Zealand degree in medical diagnostic imaging approved by the board, or a course of training, examinations and work experience that in the opinion of the board is sufficient for registration in diagnostic imaging – general.

2. Radiation Therapy

A New Zealand degree in radiation therapy approved by the board, or a course of training, examinations and work experience that in the opinion of the board is sufficient for registration as a radiation therapist.

3. Diagnostic Imaging – Nuclear Medicine

A degree in nuclear medicine approved by the board and 3360 hours of clinical experience in nuclear medicine, or a course of training, examinations and work experience that in the opinion of the board

is sufficient for registration as a nuclear medicine technologist.

4. Diagnostic Imaging – Ultrasound

A degree in diagnostic imaging or health science approved by the board and a postgraduate qualification in ultrasound approved by the board and 3360 hours of clinical experience in ultrasound, or a course of training, examinations and work experience that in the opinion of the board is sufficient for registration as a sonographer.

5. Diagnostic Imaging – Magnetic Resonance Imaging

A degree in diagnostic imaging approved by the board and a postgraduate qualification in magnetic resonance imaging approved by the board and 3360 hours of clinical experience in magnetic resonance imaging, or a course of training, examinations and relevant work experience that in the opinion of the board is sufficient for registration as a magnetic resonance imaging technologist.

Pursuant to section 12 of the Act, the following qualifications are prescribed for registration as a trainee medical radiation technologist:

6. Trainee Nuclear Medicine Technologist

7. Trainee Sonographer

8. Trainee Magnetic Resonance Imaging Technologist

A degree in diagnostic imaging approved by the board and enrolment in an approved course of training in nuclear medicine, ultrasound or medical resonance imaging, or a degree in health sciences that in the opinion of the board is sufficient for registration in a training scope of practice, and enrolment in an approved course of training in nuclear medicine, ultrasound or medical resonance imaging.
