

**Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004—Cycle Give Way Traffic Signs**

Pursuant to sub-clause 4.4(4) of the Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004 and a delegation from the NZ Transport Agency, I, Glenn Bunting, Manager Network Safety, authorise the installation and maintenance of the traffic signs described in the Schedule to this notice.

<b>R2-2.5</b>	<b>Give way - supplementary - to cyclists</b>		
<i>Supplementary sign for R2-2. Reinforces requirement for drivers to give way to cyclists crossing the road on a priority controlled cycle path, in accordance with clause 4.1 of the Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004 and subclause 11.4(5) of the Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004.</i>			
<b>Shape and size</b>	Rectangle 900 × 300mm

**Example: Give way to cyclists supplementary sign**

<b>R2-2.6</b>	<b>Give way - supplementary - to cyclists and pedestrians</b>		
<i>Supplementary sign for R2-2. Reinforces requirement for drivers to give way to cyclists and pedestrians crossing the road on a priority controlled shared path, in accordance with clause 4.1 of the Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004 and subclause 11.4(5) of the Land Transport Rule: Traffic Control Devices 2004.</i>			
<b>Shape and size</b>	Rectangle 900 × 450mm

**Example: Give way to cyclists and pedestrians supplementary sign**

<b>R2-9.1</b>	<b>Turning traffic give way to cyclists</b>		
<i>Reinforces requirement to give way to cyclists on a cycle path when turning at a give way sign, stop sign or traffic signals, in accordance with clause 3.2 or 4.1 of the Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004. May supplement R2-1 or R2-2 signs or be installed on a pole supporting a traffic signal.</i>			
<b>Shape and size</b>	Rectangle 400 × 500mm

<b>Border</b>	Red (R) 15mm

**Example: Turning traffic give way to cyclists sign**

<b>R2-9.2</b>	<b>Straight ahead traffic give way to cyclists</b>		
<i>Reinforces requirement to give way to cyclists on a cycle path when proceeding straight ahead from a give way or stop sign, in accordance with clause 4.1 of the Land Transport (Road User) Rule 2004. May supplement R2-1 or R2-2 signs.</i>			
<b>Shape and size</b>	Rectangle 400 × 600mm

**Example: Straight ahead traffic give way to cyclists sign**

<b>R3-5.2</b>	<b>Supplementary - except cycles</b>		
<i>Supplementary sign for R3-1, R3-2, R3-3 or R3-4 signs excepting cycles from a ban on the relevant movement and for R3-8, R3-9, R3-10, R3-11 or R3-12 signs excepting cycles from the requirement to make the relevant movement.</i>			
<b>Shape and size</b>	Rectangle 400 × 250mm

Example: Except cycles sign

W16-10	40km/h advisory - cyclists on narrow bridge		
Advises drivers to slow to 40km/h when cyclists are on the narrow bridge			
Shape and size	Rectangle: 900 × 1500mm (speed limit < 80km/h) 1200 × 2000mm (speed limit ≥ 80km/h)		
Background	Yellow-green (RF)		
Border	Black: 20mm (< 80 km/h) 30mm (≥ 80 km/h)		
Legend	Description	Colour	Size
	“NARROW” “BRIDGE”, above	Black	120/21.6 (< 80km/h) 160/28.8 (≥ 80km/h)
	A horizontal line, above	Black	20mm (< 80km/h) 30mm (≥ 80km/h)
	“40”	Black	225/40.5 (< 80km/h) 300/54 (≥ 80km/h)

Advises cyclists to watch for traffic (typically where a cycle path or shared path crosses a road).			
Shape and size	Rectangle 400 × 600mm

<b>A43-8</b>	<b>Contra-flow cycle lane</b>		
<i>Advises road users that cyclists are permitted to travel in either direction in the adjacent cycle lane.</i>			
<b>Shape and size</b>	Rectangle 400 × 600mm		
<b>Background</b>	White (R)		
<b>Border</b>	Black 15mm		
<b>Legend</b>	<b>Description</b>	<b>Colour</b>	<b>Size</b>
	"[symbol of cycle]", above	Black	300 × 195mm
	"[Two arrows (type A) side by side, left arrow pointing up and right arrow pointing down]"	Black	Shaft 35mm



**Example: Contra-flow cycle lane sign**
