Early Childhood Services (Recognised Qualifications for Persons Responsible in a Playcentre) Notice

- 1. Pursuant to Schedule 1 of the Education (Early Childhood Services) Regulations 2008, the Secretary for Education gives notice that the following qualifications are recognised as qualifications required to be held by a person responsible at a Playcentre affiliated to the New Zealand Playcentre Federation.
- 2. A person responsible must hold:
 - a. New Zealand Certificate in Early Childhood Education and Care (Level 4); or
 - b. Playcentre Practice (course 4 of the Playcentre Diploma in Early Childhood and Adult Education); or
 - c. New Zealand Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care (Level 5); or
 - d. Playcentre in Context (course 5 of the Playcentre Diploma in Early Childhood and Adult Education); or
 - e. The Playcentre Diploma in Early Childhood and Adult Education; or
 - f. The New Zealand Diploma in Early Childhood Education and Care (Level 6); or
 - g. An Early Childhood Education teaching qualification approved by the Education Council of Aotearoa NZ.
- 3. Until 31 December 2020, the following qualifications are also recognised and deemed to be equivalent to the Playcentre qualifications listed in clause 2.
 - a. Playcentre Sessions (course 3 of the Playcentre Diploma in Early Childhood and Adult Education); or
 - b. National Playcentre Certificate; or
 - c. Playcentre Federation Association Certificate; or
 - d. New Zealand Playcentre Federation Inc. Certificate.
- 4. This notice revokes the following notice titled Early Childhood Centres (Recognised Qualifications for Playcentres) Notice 2001, published in the *New Zealand Gazette*, 9 August 2001, No. 84, page 2161.
- 5. This notice comes into effect on 17 May 2018.
