Notice

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This notice may be cited as the Psychologists (Fees) Notice 2018.
- (2) This notice comes into force on 15 February 2018.
- **2. Fees**—The Psychologists Board sets the following fees, payable to the board, specified in the attached Schedule.
- **3.** Tax—The fees are inclusive of goods and services tax.
- 4. Waiver—The Psychologists Board may provide for the waiver or transfer of any fee or part thereof.
- 5. No refund—Fees are not refundable when an application is declined.
- **6. Revocation**—This notice revokes all previous Psychologist (Fees) Notices.
