

Declaration by Electoral Commission That Agnes Loreta Loheni is Elected a Member of Parliament

WHEREAS—

- A. The Electoral Commission has received a warrant from Her Excellency the Governor General to supply a member of Parliament to fill a vacancy created by the resignation of Christopher Francis Finlayson pursuant to section 55(1)(f) of the Electoral Act 1993;
- B. Under section 137(2) of the Electoral Act 1993, the Electoral Commission has determined that, of the unelected candidates on the party list of The New Zealand National Party, Agnes Loreta Loheni stood highest in the order of preference on that list;
- C. Under section 137(3) of that Act, the Electoral Commission has asked the party secretary of The New Zealand National Party whether Agnes Loreta Loheni remains a member of that party and the Commission has been informed that she remains a member of that party;
- D. Under section 137(4) of that Act, the Electoral Commission has asked Agnes Loreta Loheni whether she is willing to be a member of Parliament and she has indicated her willingness to be a member of Parliament.

THEREFORE, pursuant to section 137(4) of that Act, the Electoral Commission declares that

Agnes Loreta Loheni

is elected as a member of Parliament by publication of this declaration in the *New Zealand Gazette*.
