

Decisions on the Ōtākaro Avon River Corridor Regeneration Plan and Partial Revocation of the Christchurch Central Recovery Plan

The Minister for Greater Christchurch Regeneration gives the following two notices:

First, pursuant to section 38(3) of the Greater Christchurch Regeneration Act 2016, notice that the Ōtākaro Avon River Corridor Regeneration Plan developed by Regenerate Christchurch has been approved under section 38 of the Greater Christchurch Regeneration Act 2016.

The Ōtākaro Avon River Corridor Regeneration Plan comes into effect on **30 August 2019**.

Second, pursuant to section 58(3) of the Greater Christchurch Regeneration Act 2016, notice that the Partial Revocation of the Christchurch Central Recovery Plan developed by Regenerate Christchurch has been approved under section 58 of the Greater Christchurch Regeneration Act 2016.

The Partial Revocation of the Christchurch Central Recovery Plan comes into effect on **30 August 2019**.
