

COVID-19 Public Health Response (Air Border) Order 2021—Specified Airport of Arrival

Pursuant to clauses 50 of the COVID-19 Public Health Response (Air Border) Order 2021 (“Order”), I, Dr Ashley Bloomfield, Director-General of Health, hereby designate the following airports to be specified airports for the purposes of clause 50 of the Order:

1. Auckland Airport (as defined as **airport** in section 2 of the Auckland Airport Act 1987)
2. Wellington Airport (as defined as **airport** in section 2 of the Wellington Airport Act 1990)
3. Christchurch Airport (as per section 3 of the Airport Authorities Act 1966 and Airport Authorities (Christchurch International Airport Limited) Order 1988).
4. Queenstown Airport (as per section 3 of the Airport Authorities Act 1966 and Airport Authorities (Queenstown Airport Corporation Limited) Order 1989) except for aircraft that are not operated as part of a scheduled international air service.

This notice will come into force at 11.59pm on 27 February 2022.
