

Land to be Declared Walkways—Arrowtown, Queenstown-Lakes District

Under section 31 of the Walking Access Act 2008, I declare that the land described in the Schedule below to be walkways, subject to the provisions of that Act, and I further declare that each walkway shall be assigned the name recorded above each land description in the Schedule.

I have appointed the Queen Elizabeth II National Trust to be the controlling authority for the walkways named in the Schedule below.

The area marked “A” on DP 518353 (Record of Title 727254).

Advance Peak Track

The area marked “MA”, “MB”, “MC”, “MD”, and “ME” on DP 528850 (Record of Title OTA2/1228).
