

Variation to Approval of Wellington Airport as a Place of First Arrival (Notice No. MPI 1682)

Section 37 of the Biosecurity Act 1993

Under section 37B(1)(c) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I vary the approval, published in the [New Zealand Gazette, 24 January 2019, Notice No. 2019-go349](#) of **Wellington Airport** (located at Stewart Duff Drive, Wellington and operated by Wellington International Airport Limited CN: 396240) as a place of first arrival to receive the following craft and cargo types subject to the limitations specified:

Limitations:

Wellington Airport is able to receive the following craft:

- Commercial, Chartered or Private Aircraft (≤ 25 Seats)
- Commercial, Chartered or Private Aircraft (> 25 Seats)
- Freight Aircraft
- Defence Force Craft

that are able to discharge the following risk good types:

- Containers and General Cargo
- Fresh Produce (Bulk) (only that approved under an MPI Approved System)
- Passengers, Crew and their Personal Effects
