

## Variation to Approval of Napier Port as a Place of First Arrival (Notice No. MPI 1666)

### Section 37 of the Biosecurity Act 1993

Under section 37B(1)(c) of the Biosecurity Act 1993, I vary the approval, published in the [New Zealand Gazette, 23 January 2020, Notice No. 2020-go285](#), of Napier Port (located at Breakwater Road, Napier and operated by Port of Napier Limited CN: 397567) as a place of first arrival to receive the following craft and cargo types subject to the limitations specified:

#### Limitations:

Napier Port is able to receive the following craft:

- Commercial Vessels
- Commercial Passenger Vessels
- Defence Force Craft

that are able to discharge the following risk good types:

- Container and General Cargo
- Bulk Cargo (Non-Approved systems)
- Vehicles and Machinery
- Passengers, Crew and their Personal Effects
