Pursuant to sections 44, 45, 59, 60, 61, 77, 79, 80, 82, 85, 94 and 123 of theWhakatōhea Claims Settlement Act 2024 ("Settlement Act 2024"), the New Zealand Geographic Board Ngā Pou Taunaha o Aotearoa ("Board") gives notice of three new and altered geographic names, one altered Crown protected area ("CPA") name and eight discontinued CPA names as described in the Schedules below.
