Fisheries (High Seas Fishing Notifications—Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission) Notice 2025

Pursuant to section 113C of the Fisheries Act 1996, the Secretary of Foreign Affairs and Trade gives the following notice.

Notice

1. Title

This notice is the Fisheries (High Seas Fishing Notifications—Western and Central Pacific Fisheries Commission) Notice 2025.

2. Commencement

This notice comes into force on the day after the date of its notification in the New Zealand Gazette.

3. Notification of Global, Regional, or Sub-regional Fisheries Organisation or Arrangement
